




### Big Picture


 When we compare Revelation with other biblical prophecies, certain basic patterns emerge

#	Pattern	Description
1	The Church will continue to grow	Jesus promised to continue to build His church, and empower it to attack the gates of Hell Matthew 16:18
2	Satanic opposition will intensify	Things will get worse as we get closer to the time of the end.
		Difficult times will come (2 Timothy 3:1-5).
		Scoffers will mock the idea of Christ's 2 <sup>nd</sup> coming (2 Peter 3:3-4, Jude 17-18).
		False prophets will increase and apostate religion will rival the true Church (1 Timothy 4:1; 2 Peter 2:1-3; 2 Corinthians 11:13-14).






#	Pattern	Description
3	Israel will return to the Promise Land	The great end-times regathering has already begun (1948).
		Israel is once again a nation in her own land (Ezekiel 20:34; 37:12-21; Isaiah 43:5-6).
		But her return will touch off a storm of protest and conflict in the Middle East (Joel 3:2-14; Ezekiel 38:1-6).
4	The Church will be raptured up to heaven	When our Lord departed to heaven, He promised His disciples He would return to take them home with Him (John 14:3).
		The apostle Paul predicted that the dead in Christ shall rise first, and we that are alive and remain shall be caught up into heaven (1 Thessalonians 4:16-17; 1 Corinthians 15:51-52).






#	Pattern	Description
5	Judgments of the tribulation period will follow	The great judgments of the End Times vividly described in Revelation are called "the hour of testing" (Revelation 3:10), "the great day of their wrath" (Revelation 6:17), or "great tribulation" (Revelation 7:14).
		These judgments relate to the seals, trumpets, and bowls of the Apocalypse.
6	Marriage of Christ and the Church	The Church's absence from chapter 4 through chapter 18 is best explained by the fact that she has already been raptured to heaven to participate in the marriage supper of the lamb (Revelation 19:7-9). Here she receives her rewards, crowns, and robes of righteousness prior to her procession back to earth with the Savior.






#	Pattern	Description
7	Triumphal return of Christ	The climax of the Apocalypse comes in Revelation 19:11-21, when the glorified Christ returns as King of Kings and Lord of Lords with His Bride, the Church, at His side.
		He returns to conquer all opposition to His reign, and to establish His Millennial Kingdom on earth (Revelation 19:19-20:1).
8	Millennial Kingdom	Jesus Christ will reign upon the earth for one thousand years while Satan is bound in the "abyss".
		During this time, God's promises to Israel will be fulfilled.
		The Messiah shall reign from Jerusalem over all the earth in peace, blessing, and prosperity (Revelation 20:1-6; Isaiah 2:2-4; 9:6-7).





#	Pattern	Description
9	Final triumph	Even after one thousand years of earthly blessing, Satan will once again attempt to destroy the kingdom of God by one final act of rebellion.
		This time his defeat is final, and he is cast into the lake of fire (Revelation 20:7-10).
		The Great White Throne Judgment follows, when even death and hell are cast into the lake of fire (Revelation 20:11-15).
10	Eternal state	The Revelation describes eternity as "a new heaven and a new earth" (Revelation 21:1).
		It also emphasizes the significance of the New Jerusalem in the celestial state (Revelation 21:2).
		God is pictured dwelling with His people in an eternity of peace and blessing.
		Suffering and death are no more and every tear is wiped away.
		Paradise is truly restored, and the saved have access to the tree of life (Revelation 21:3-22:5).




### Interpretation - What are the Four Views?



### Four Schools of Interpretation

#	View	Description
1	Preterist	The book of Revelation is prophecy that was fulfilled primarily in the first century AD.  "Partial Preterism" views most of Revelation as prophecy fulfilled in the 1 <sup>st</sup> Century AD, though final chapters of Revelation describe future events to occur at the end of time.  "Full Preterists" contend that the return of Jesus described in Revelation 19 was spiritual and occurred in AD 70.  Preterists are typically Amillennialists or Postmillennialists, though some Historical Premillennialists might fit in this category.
2	Historicist	The book of Revelation is prophecy about church history from the time of John to the end of the world.  Historicists view the events in Revelation as symbolic descriptions of historical events throughout church history.




	#	View	Description

Dispensational Premillennialists as well as some Historical Premillennialists interpret
	4	Idealist	The book of Revelation is a non-historical and non-prophetic drama about spiritual realities.  This perspective seems to have originated among ancient Alexandrian theologians, which frequently spiritualized and allegorized biblical texts, but this view also has contemporary followers.




#### Symbols

- The basic structure of the book is woven around a series of threes and sevens.
- The overarching triplet reveals past, present, and future.

1.	Past: "the things which you have seen"	Chapter 1
2.	Present: "the things which are"	Chapters 2-3

- 3. Future: "the things which shall take place after this" ... Chapters 4-22
- The seven visions are...

1.	<b>Seven churches</b> 1:9 - 3:33
2.	<b>Seven seals</b> 4:1 - 8:1
3.	<b>Seven trumpets</b> 8:2 - 11:19
4.	Seven symbolic figures12:1 - 14:20
5.	<b>Seven bowls</b> 15:1 - 16:21
6.	<b>Seven judgments</b> 17:1 - 19:10
7.	<b>Seven triumphs</b> 19:11 - 22:5






#### Symbols

 The term "hour" is used ten times in Revelation, always referring to a brief period of time

```
3:3,10; 9:15; 11:13; 14:7,15; 17:2; 18:10,17,19
```

- Three is the symbolic number of the Trinity. It is one of John's favorite numbers.
- Four is a number generally related to the earth
  - Four regions ... North, South, East, West
  - Four seasons ... Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter
- Six is the number of man
  - Created on the sixth day
  - Number of Antichrist is 666






- Seven beatitudes in Revelation
- 1. Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it; for the time is near.... (1:3).
- 2. Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on.... (14:13).
- 3. Blessed is he who watches, and keeps his garments, lest he walk naked and they see his shame...(16:15).
- **4. Blessed** *are* those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!... (19:9).
- 5. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection...(20:6).
- 6. Blessed *is* he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book... (22:7)
- 7. Blessed are those who do His commandments... (22:14).





### Symbols


- Twelve is the number of completeness
  - 12 Tribes of Israel
  - 12 Apostles of Christ
  - 24 Elders (2x12)
  - Tree of Life has 12 types of fruit (22:2)
  - New Jerusalem has 12 gates guarded by 12 angels (21:12)
  - The city has 12 foundations (21:14)
  - 12 precious stones adorning the foundation stones (21:19-21)
  - 12 pearls (21:19-21)
  - 12 tribes containing 12,000 people = 144,000 (4:4-8)
  - Wall measures 144 cubits (12 x 12) (21:17)





### Symbols - Colors

- White ..... is a sign of purity
- Emerald Green ... is a sign of life
- Pale Green ...... is a sign of death
- Gold ..... is a sign of value
- Red ..... is a sign of sin
- Black .....is a sign of famine

#### Revelation Themes

- To keep from getting lost in the trees, we'll look at the forest.
  - To accomplish this I'll present six major themes of Revelation

#	Theme	Description
1	God is Sovereign	God rules over all with absolute authority and power. God's control over His creation is called His Sovereignty Revelation 11:16-17.
		God's sovereignty means nothing occurs outside of His knowledge, His control, or His will.
		Revelation shows the incomparable power and incomprehensible love of God, who is directing history for the sake of those who put their trust in Him.
		We can trust God's sovereignty for the future and take comfort in it now.
2	Jesus is Lord	Revelation shows the absolute worthiness of our Lord and Savior. He is the one we will worship forever in heaven, and He is the one we can worship now Revelation 5:12.

#### Revelation Themes

#	Theme	Description
		While He was on the earth, Jesus told His disciples that He was going to heaven to prepare a place for them. Then He told them He would return John 14:3.
3	Jesus is Coming Back	Christ's return is a major theme of Revelation Revelation 22:12-13.
		We don't need to wonder if Jesus is ever going to return. We can be sure that God's timing is perfect. Jesus will come back to earth at just the right moment.
4	God's People will Persevere	If you are a child of God, you will persevere to the end. Nothing can take your salvation away. At the same time you must be faithful to God no matter what.  Some day your perseverance will pay off Revelation 21:3-4.





#### Revelation Themes

#	Theme	Description
	Judgment Day is Coming	According to the old saying, "Nothing is certain except death and taxes". We can add judgment to the list.
5		Those who have accepted the sacrifice of Christ to take away their sins will be rewarded with eternal life. Those who have rejected Christ will face eternal punishment Revelation 11:18.
		Believers can take comfort right now in the fact that they will avoid God's wrath against evil because of Christ.
		We can trust God that He will deal with sin and evil. They will not last forever.
	We Have Hope	Imagine what life was like for those 1st century Christians who were confronted with threat and persecution. We may not face that kind of harassment, but in many parts of our world, people do.
		How do you deal with your own pan and grief? The answer is HOPE!
6		Regardless of our present troubles, we can look ahead with hope to a time when all who trust God will live in absolute peace.
		The message of Revelation must have been a great source of comfort to the believers in the 1st century, and it offers just as much hope for us today Revelation 22:20.
