Jeremiah was born in Toledo, Ohio in 1941 to Ethel Rayburn Jeremiah and James T. Jeremiah, a Baptist pastor and former president of Cedarville University.[1]

Dallas Theological Seminary (1967). Cedarville presented him with an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree in 1981.[2]

Jeremiah earned a bachelor's degree from Cedarville University (1963) and a master's degree from

Jeremiah succeeded Tim LaHaye as Shadow Mountain's senior pastor in 1981. Jeremiah's leadership of the church has led it to become affiliated with the Southern Baptist Convention.

Jeremiah broadcasts a daily evangelical radio program on stations worldwide through his Turning Point Ministries, which he founded in 1982. The broadcast can also be heard online. He is the author of numerous books on Christian theology and morality.

In 1994 and again in 1998, Jeremiah was diagnosed with lymphoma. In 1999, a nodule was surgically removed from his neck and he underwent stem cell transplant therapy.

On January 31, 2010, his Turning Point for God organization withdrew from the Evangelical Council for Financial Accountability.

John 1:1-2 - Observations




1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God.

- In the Beginning was the Word
 - The Word was before the Beginning
 - ✓ Attests to the pre-existence of Jesus
 - Before the creation of time and space
 - Jesus existed in eternity past (not created)
 - The Word was with God
 - ✓ Attests to Jesus as distinct from God
 - Mystery of the Trinity infinite concept
 - The Word was God
 - ✓ Attest to the divinity of Jesus
 - Mystery of the Trinity infinite concept
 - He was in the beginning with God
 - ✓ Attests to the personal nature of God/Jesus
 - Note the personal pronoun He
 - » God is a personal God ... God is not some impersonal force be it wisdom, nature
 - » Jesus is Eternal ... the Eternal Word




Profile: Greek Word Logos... Word ... Wikipedia









- A technical term in philosophy, beginning with Heraclitus (ca. 535-475 BC), who used the term for a principle of order and knowledge.
- Ancient philosophers used the term in different ways. The sophists used the term to mean discourse, and Aristotle applied the term to refer to "reasoned discourse" or "the argument" in the field of rhetoric.
- The Stoic philosophers identified the term with the divine animating principle pervading the Universe.
- Under Hellenistic Judaism, Philo (ca. 20 BC AD 50) adopted the term into Jewish philosophy
- The Gospel of John identifies the Logos, through which all things are made, as divine (theos), and further identifies Jesus as the incarnate Logos.

 - Reminiscent of Genesis 1:1-2
 - Creation
 - √ How many days did it take?

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. — Genesis 1:1-2 ... NKJV

- ✓ How many "goods" were declared by God?
 - 6- goods ... 1 very good
 - » Day 1 ... one good
 - » Day 2 ... zero goods
 - » Day 3 ... two goods
 - » Day 4 ... one good
 - » Day 5 ... one good
 - » Day 6 ... one good
 - » End of creation ... one very good



JESUS IS "HIM"

³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

- All things were made through Him
 - Without Him nothing was made that was made
 - ✓ The "Him" here is the Word
 - Him = Word = Jesus
 - ✓ Everything God creates ex nihlo
 - Hebrews 11:3 -
 - Visible Physical world
 - Invisible .. Spiritual world
- ³ By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible. Hebrews 11:3 ... NKJV
- John is linking Genesis with Stoic Greek thought
 - ✓ God of Genesis and the Word (logos) are the same
 - They are eternal
 - ✓ Unlike the Stoic Greeks however
 - Logos is personal
 - Not just a principle



John 1:4 - Observations



⁴ In Him was life, and the life was the light of men.

- Life and Light
 - In Him was life
 - √ Jesus (the Word) is the source of all life
 - √ John 14:6 -

⁶ Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, **and the life**. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

John 14:6 ... NKJV

- All life exists by the perfect will of "the Word"
- The life was the light of men
 - ✓ "the life" this particular life ... is the Light of all mankind
 - ✓ Light
 - The very essence of the Word
 - Expression that all of mankind has been made in the image of God
 - Tripartite nature of man
 - » Body
 - » Soul
 - » Spirit the essence of God
 - » John 4:24

²⁴ God *is* Spirit, and those who worship Him **must** worship in spirit and truth." – John 4:24 ... NKJV

John 1:5 - Observations



⁵ And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

- Light shines in the darkness
 - Contrasts LIGHT and DARKNESS
 - ✓ Understanding (LIGHT) vs Ignorance (DARKNESS)
 - ✓ Good (LIGHT) vs Evil (DARKNESS)
 - √ Jesus (Light) vs Satan (DARKNESS)
- The darkness did not comprehend it
 - other translations ... "apprehend it"
 - LIGHT trumps DARKNESS
 - Heavens and Earth created in darkness ... Genesis 1:3-5
 - Evil hates the light ... John 3:19-21-

¹⁸ "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. ¹⁹ And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. ²⁰ For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. ²¹ But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God."—John 3:18-21 ... NKJV

³ Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. ⁴ And God saw the light, that *it was* good; and God divided the light from the darkness. ⁵ God **called** the light Day, and the darkness He **called** Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day. – Genesis 1:3-5 ... NKJV

John 1:6-7 - Observations



⁶ There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. ⁷ This man came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all through him might believe.

- John was sent by God
 - What John are we talking about here?
 - √ John the Baptist
 - For what purpose was John sent by God?
 - ✓ To bear witness of the Eternal Light
 - The Light is Jesus the Word
 - √ That all through him might believe
 - Through John's testimony regarding Jesus
 - All have the opportunity to believe
 - » "might believe" ... Not all will believe
 - » God would have all believe (2 Peter 3:9)
 - » Man has a "free will" to choose his eternity

⁹ The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.

- 2 Peter 3:9 ... NKJV

Profile - John the Baptist

- John the Baptist ... (Luke 1, 7)
 - Birth
 - ✓ Foretold by Gabriel the angel
 - ✓ Filled with the Holy Spirit
 - In his mother's womb
 - ✓ MOTHER: Elizabeth
 - ✓ FATHER: Zachariah
 - ✓ Cousin of Jesus .. 6 months older than Jesus
 - Forerunner of Jesus Prepare
 - ✓ Challenged the people
 - Prepare for the coming Messiah
 - Turn from sin and be baptized
 - Symbol of repentance
 - Baptized Jesus in the Jordan River
 - ✓ Jesus did not need to be Baptized
 - ✓ None born of woman greater than John (Luke7:28)
 - Beheaded
 - √ In ~29 AD by Herod Antipas
 - ✓ Plot devised by Herodias & daughter Salome
 - Illegal wife of Herod
 - Ex-wife of Herod's brother Philip

- John was not the Light
 - John was not ...
 - ✓ The true Light
 - John was sent to ...
 - ✓ Bear witness of that Light
 - True Light
 - √ The Eternal Light (Jesus) ... John 1:29-31
 - Gives light to all in the world
 - » A reference to Jesus' birth
 - » A reference to Common Grace to all man
 - ✓ True Light is the Creator
 - Source of all Light and Life
 - ✓ Is there a "false" light?
 - 2 Corinthians 11:14

²⁹ The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world! ³⁰ This is He of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.' ³¹ I did not know Him; but that He should be revealed to Israel, therefore I came baptizing with water." – John 1:29-31 ... ¹⁰ He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him.

- Jesus was In, and Rejected, by the World He Made
 - He was in the world
 - ✓ Jesus the Eternal Light was in the world he created
 - Manifestation of Light was the first act of creation
 - » The first "Let there be ..."
 - The world was made through Him
 - √ Jesus is the source of everything
 - The world did not know Him.
 - √ Jesus' power & glory are evident throughout creation
 - ✓ Man is without excuse ... Romans 1:20
 - ✓ Men choose darkness ... John 3:20-21

²⁰ For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. ²¹ But he who does the truth comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God." – John 3:20-21 ... NKJV

John 1:11-12 - Observations



¹¹ He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. ¹² But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name:

- He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him
 - Who are "His own"?
 - √ Two possibilities
 - 1. The chosen people of God
 - » Some translations have "His own people"
 - » The Jews ... Deuteronomy 14:2
 - All mankind
 - ✓ Both possibilities are in view
 - But as many as received Him
 - ✓ He gave the right
 - God is the one giving
 - ✓ To become children of God
 - Son's of God
 - Who are the Sons of God?

² For you *are* a holy people to the LORD your God, and the LORD has chosen you to be a people for Himself, a special treasure above all the peoples who *are* on the face of the earth. – Deuteronomy 14:2 ... NKJV

Sons of God

Angels – Created beings.

Adam – Pinnacle of God's creation.

Jesus - Only begotten Son ... John 3:16

Born-again Believers ... John 1:10-13

John 1:13 - Observations



¹³ who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

- Who were born of God
 - Those who receive Him and believe in His name
 - ✓ ARE: Born of God Spirit
 - ✓ ARE NOT: Born of ...
 - Blood Hereditary qualification (like Aaronic priesthood)
 - The will of the flesh ... External works ... any outward acts of man
 - The will of man Internal works ... any thoughts or emotions of man
 - Jesus is the ONLY begotten son
 - √ Physical Father was the Holy Spirit
 - Luke 1:35 "... the Holy Spirit will come upon you..."
 - Born-Again Believers
 - ✓ Spiritual Born of the Holy Spirit
 - John 3:3-6; John 14:15-18; John 15:26; John 16:12-15
 - Acts 1:8 -- "... the Holy Spirit has come upon you..."
 - 1 John 4:1-3

- The Word became flesh
 - The Word
 - √ Became flesh
 - The Holy Birth of Jesus
 - Galatians 4:4-5
 - ✓ Dwelt among us
 - The incarnation
 - » God in the flesh
 - » 100% God ... 100% Man
 - Lived a sinless life
 - Died on a cross for the sins of man
 - Buried and raised from the grave
 - Lives forevermore

JESUS IS THE WORD BECOME FLESH

- ⁴ But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.

¹⁴ And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.

- We beheld His glory
 - ✓ Who are the "we" here?
 - The Apostles, the disciples (followers of Christ) Eyewitnesses
 - ✓ Glory of God the Father
 - Glory as of the only begotten of the Father
 - » Jesus the Son of God's glory is the same as the Father's glory
 - Full of Grace and Truth
 - » Characteristic of God's glory same as Jesus the Son's glory
 - » Only way to worship God is in spirit and in truth (John 4:24)
 - » The Glory of God is only completely shone in Jesus His son (John 17:1-5)

17 Jesus spoke these words, lifted up His eyes to heaven, and said: "Father, the hour has come. Glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You, ² as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him. ³ And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent. ⁴ I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do. ⁵ And now, O Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was.
