## Truths & Principles

- ✓ The judgments of God against the world are determined by His schedule.
- ✓ In a special way God will protect His end-time servants who go through the Great Tribulation.
- ✓ The only humans that have a place in heaven are those who have been cleansed from their sins through the death of Jesus.
- ✓ A great multitude of redeemed persons will be in heaven.

## Preview

Two great hosts of people appear on the prophetic horizon. The first are 144,000 Jewish converts. The second are a “great multitude” of Gentiles from every nation. Together they make up the redeemed saints of the Tribulation period, who have given their lives for the cause of Christ.



## Applications

- ✓ Expect tribulation in this lifetime.
- ✓ Expect to come out of tribulation victorious.
- ✓ Know that the blood of Jesus redeems you from your sin so that you do not have to face eternal tribulation.
- ✓ Praise God in worship that you have been redeemed.
