


Lesson Preview - Introduction



Preview ... Working Hope: Part II

Paul encourages the Thessalonian believers to endure in the face of their persecution. He reminds them that God's wrath will come to their oppressors. Paul then expresses his longing to minister to them again and that he takes great joy in the hope/confidence that they will be in the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ at His coming.

Review ... True Conversion

In the first chapter of the epistle, Paul tells of the "TRUE CONVERSION" of the Thessalonian believers.

THREE TENSES OF SALVATION				
TENSE	TERM	SAVED FROM	THESSALONIANS	
Past	JUSTIFICATION	The PENALTY of Sin	Turn to God	
Present	SANCTIFICATION	The POWER of Sin	SERVE God	
Future	GLORIFICATION	The PRESENCE of Sin	WAIT for His Son	

TIME has **3** Tenses.

SPACE has **3** Dimensions.

MAN is **tri**partite.

What do all three of these have in common?

Second Coming Reference

⁹ For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you TURNED to God from idols to SERVE the living and true God, ¹⁰ and to WAIT for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, *even* Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come



Receiving the Word of God - 1 Thessalonians 2:13 - OBSERVATIONS



also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe.

--- 1 Thessalonians 2:13 ... NKJV

It's all in how you receive God's word!

Matthew 13
Parable of the Soils

WHAT TYPE OF SOIL ARE YOU?

- The Word of God Hearing, Receiving and Doing
 - For this reason What REASON?
 - Their "proper" reception of the Word of God
 - 1) HEAR ... you heard from us
 - 2) RECEIVE AND WELCOME ... you received ... welcomed it
 - 3) ACT ... effectively works in you
 - The Thessalonians recognized the message they heard was the Word of God and NOT the words of men

Paul's preaching was anointed by God.

"That you have not perceived spiritual things is true; but it is no proof that there are none to perceive. The whole case is like that of the Irishman who tried to upset evidence by non-evidence. Four witnesses saw him commit a murder. He pleaded that he was not guilty, and wished to establish his innocence by producing forty persons who did not see him do it. Of what use would that have been? So, if forty people declare that there is no power of the Holy Ghost going with the word, this only proves that the forty people do not know what others do know."

¹⁴ For you, brethren, became imitators of the churches of God which are in Judea in Christ Jesus. For you also suffered the same things from your own countrymen, just as they did from the Judeans, 15 who killed both the Lord Jesus and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they do not please God and are contrary to all men,

- Imitators Of the Churches of God
 - The Thessalonian believers became imitators
 - Because of their reception of the word of God and their acting upon what they heard
 - IMITATORS (mimētēs): followers

FOLLOWERS OF WHOM?

- The churches of God
- Which are in Judea
- Which are in Christ Jesus

WHY NOT FOLLOWERS OF CHRIST?

- The context for the Following / Imitating here is...
 - In the suffering experienced by the churches in Judea
 - This does not preclude their following of Christ which they most certainly did as "brethren" or saints of God.
 - The Thessalonians had suffered from the hands of their own countrymen
 - Just as the Judeans had suffered from the hands of their own countrymen

Receiving the Word of God - 1 Thessalonians 2:15 - OBSERVATIONS



14 For you, brethren, became imitators of the churches of God which are in Judea in Christ Jesus. For you also suffered the same things from your own countrymen, just as they did from the Judeans, 15 who killed both the Lord Jesus and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they do not please God and are contrary to all men,

-- 1 Thessalonians 2:14-15 ... NKJV

Who Killed Jesus - And the Prophets

Now Paul takes it to another level

He states that the Jews (Judeans) HAD ...

Killed the Lord Jesus

Killed their own prophets

Persecuted us (Paul and his missionary teams)

The Jews ARE ...

Not pleasing God -- an understatement for emphasis

Contrary to all men

PRESENT

PAST

WHO KILLED JESUS?

The Jews had their part.

The Gentiles (Rome) had their part.


The truth is... I killed Jesus - it was my sins that led Him to Calvary's cross - it was out of His great love for me.

Receiving the Word of God - 1 Thessalonians 2:16 - OBSERVATIONS



speak to the Gentiles that they may be saved, so as always to fill up the measure of their sins; but wrath has come upon them to the uttermost.

--- 1 Thessalonians 2:16 ... NKJV



- Forbidden to Speak To Prevent Salvation
 - Paul continues on with his indictment of the Jews who were persecuting him and his teams.
 - The Jews ARE ...
 - Forbidding us to speak to the Gentiles
 - Preventing the Gentiles from becoming saved
 - Filling up their measure of sin measuring cup
 - Resulting in the wrath of God on them
 - To the uttermost without mercy.

PRESENT

THE "REPLACEMENT" BY GOD.

[-- REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY IS A HERESY --]






The Hope and the Hindrance - 1 Thessalonians 2:17 - OBSERVATIONS



¹⁷ But we, brethren, having been taken away from you for a short time in presence, not in heart, endeavored more eagerly to see your face with great desire. 18 Therefore we wanted to come to you—even I, Paul, time and again—but Satan hindered us.

-- 1 Thessalonians 1:17-18 ... NKJV

- Absence Make the Heart Grow Fonder
 - Paul expresses his eagerness and great desire to see the Thessalonians believers "FACE-TO-FACE"
 - Paul shares that his team were taken away from them for a short time - in presence but not in heart
 - "TAKEN AWAY": "to be ORPHANED; deprived of parents"
 - Even though Paul had not spent much time in Thessalonica, he had developed deep relationships with the brethren - his love for them is evident.

¹⁷ But we, brethren, having been taken away from you for a short time in presence, not in heart, endeavored more eagerly to see your face with great desire. 18 Therefore we wanted to come to you—even I, Paul, time and again—but Satan hindered us.

-- 1 Thessalonians 1:17-18 ... NKJV

- Hindered By Satan
 - Because of this great desire to be with the Thessalonian brethren, Paul and his team wanted to be there with them in person.
 - Paul then lets us know that he had attempted to travel to Thessalonica several times
 - Paul and his team were hindered by Satan.
 - HINDER: "to break up the road; make IMPASSABLE"

• Hindered - By Satan



- SATAN is real
 - Not a character in a red-suit and pitchfork
 - A powerful "fallen" Archangel (Isaiah 14; Ezekiel 28)
 - Pride was root-cause of Lucifer's fall God hates pride.
 - An enemy of your soul (1 Peter 5:8)

⁸ Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

--- 1 Peter 5:8 ... NKJV



The Joy of Christ's Coming - 1 Thessalonians 2:19 - OBSERVATIONS



19 For what *is* our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? *Is it* not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming?
20 For you are our glory and joy.

-- 1 Thessalonians 1:19-20 ... NKJV

• The Joy - Of Christ's Coming

Paul then poses a question ...

What is our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing?

- HOPE: elpis expectation, confidence
- JOY: chara gladness, rejoicing
- CROWN: stephanos victor's crown
- REJOICING: kauchēsis boasting, pride
- The answer is ...

Knowing the Thessalonians will be...

- In the presence of Christ
- At His coming
- Paul had a heart for people to receive the gospel!
- Paul had a heart for believers who accept the gospel!
- Paul had pure motives for ministering the gospel!

OUR RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD, AND WITH OTHERS, NEEDS TO BE ROOTED IN THE GOSPEL OF JESUS CHRIST.



The Joy of Christ's Coming - 1 Thessalonians 2:20 - OBSERVATIONS




19 For what *is* our hope, or joy, or crown of rejoicing? *Is it* not even you in the presence of our Lord Jesus Christ at His coming?

20 For you are our glory and joy.



- The Joy Of Christ's Coming
 - Paul emphasizes the source of his (also Silas and Timothy - "our") glory and joy were the Thessalonian believers.
 - GLORY: doxa pride, ornament
 - JOY: chara gladness, rejoicing


