## ■ Daniel's Prayer is Interrupted

- Transition from Praying to Narrating
- Daniel Characterizes his Prayer and Supplications as...
  - ✓ Speaking ..... communicating with God
  - ✓ Praying ..... seeking God's face
  - ✓ Confessing ..... confessing his own sin and the sin of his people
    - Who are Daniel's people?
      - » The Israelites
  - ✓ Supplications ..... before God - for the Holy mountain of God
    - Where is the Holy mountain of God?
      - » Jerusalem

# Profile - Prayer and Supplication

## ■ Prayer

- ✓ Defined as sincere thanksgiving or requests made to God.
- ✓ There may be no requests, but only praise showered on God.
- ✓ A person can praise the power and qualities of God.

Tribute Poured Out On God



## ■ Supplication

- ✓ A form of prayer in which someone makes a humble petition.
- ✓ There is always a request in supplication.
- ✓ One asks for or desires something from God.

# Daniel 9:21 - Observations

## ■ Daniel's Prayer Interrupted by Gabriel

- The man Gabriel
  - ✓ Word for man is "*ish*" ....
    - meaning man or servant
  - ✓ Always Messiah-mission oriented
- Seen in the vision at the beginning
  - ✓ Daniel 8:15-16 .....
- About the time of the evening offering
  - ✓ Jerusalem in ruins
    - Anachronism .....
  - ✓ ~400 miles to the west of Daniel
    - Daniel is in Persia
  - ✓ No evening offering for ~70 years
    - Daniel childhood memories
  - ✓ Insight to how Daniel thoughts are God-centered

<sup>15</sup> Then it happened, when I, Daniel, had seen the vision and was seeking the meaning, that suddenly there stood before me one having the appearance of a man. <sup>16</sup> And I heard a man's voice between *the banks of* the Ulai, who called, and said, "**Gabriel**, make this *man* understand the vision."

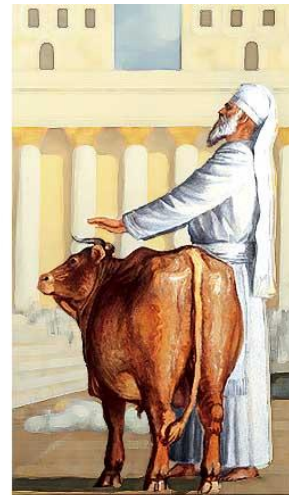

- Gabriel addresses Daniel by name ... O Daniel
- **PURPOSE:**
  - ✓ To Give Daniel Skill to Understand
    - This is an answer to Daniel's prayer
    - This is what he was seeking

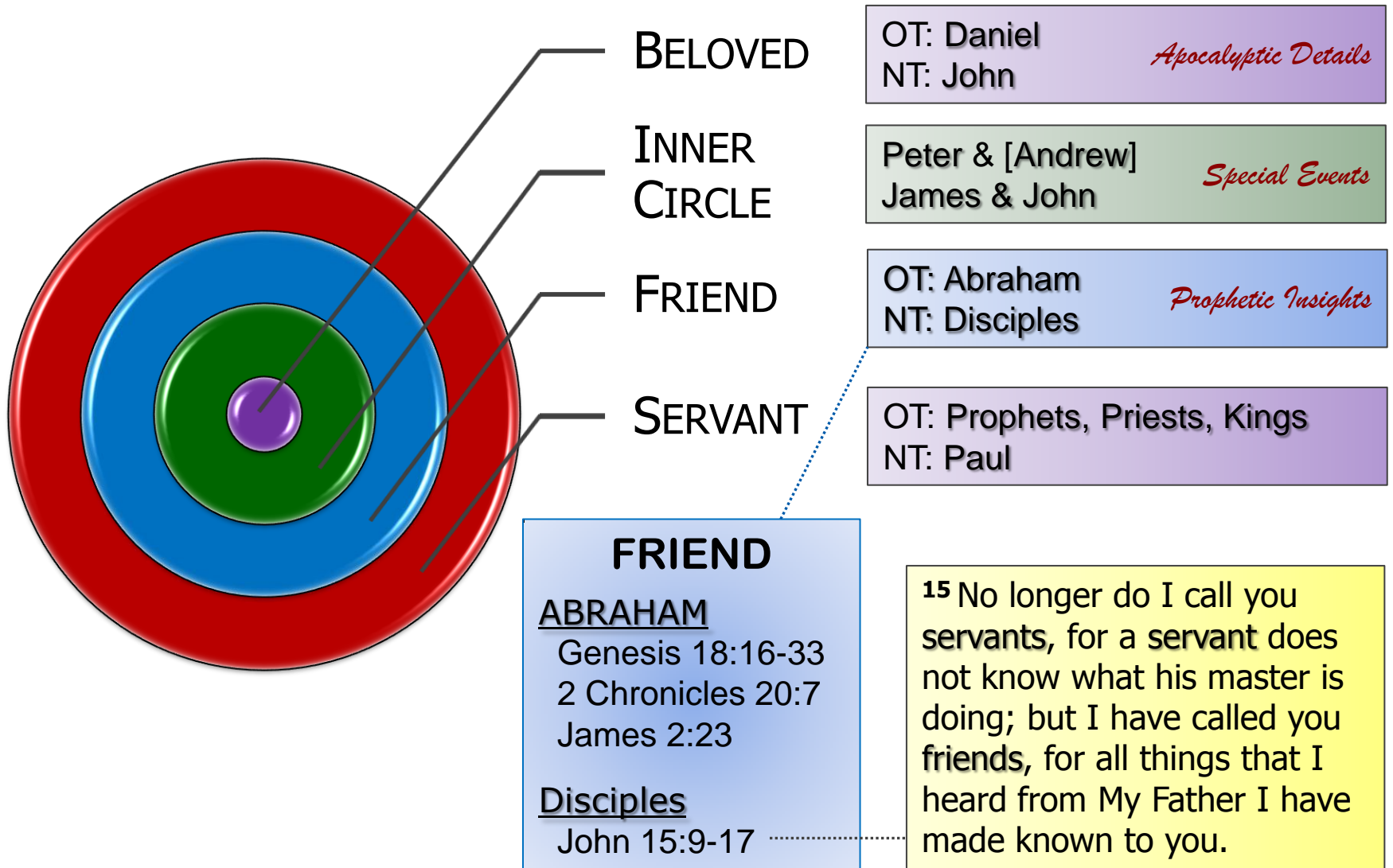

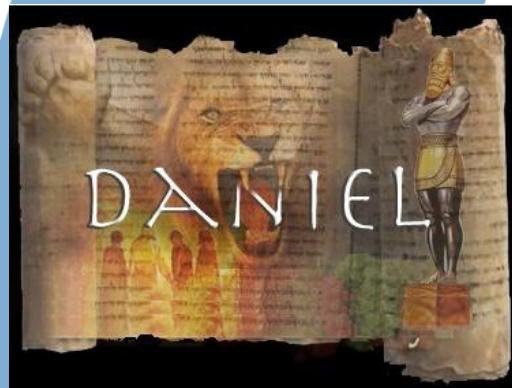

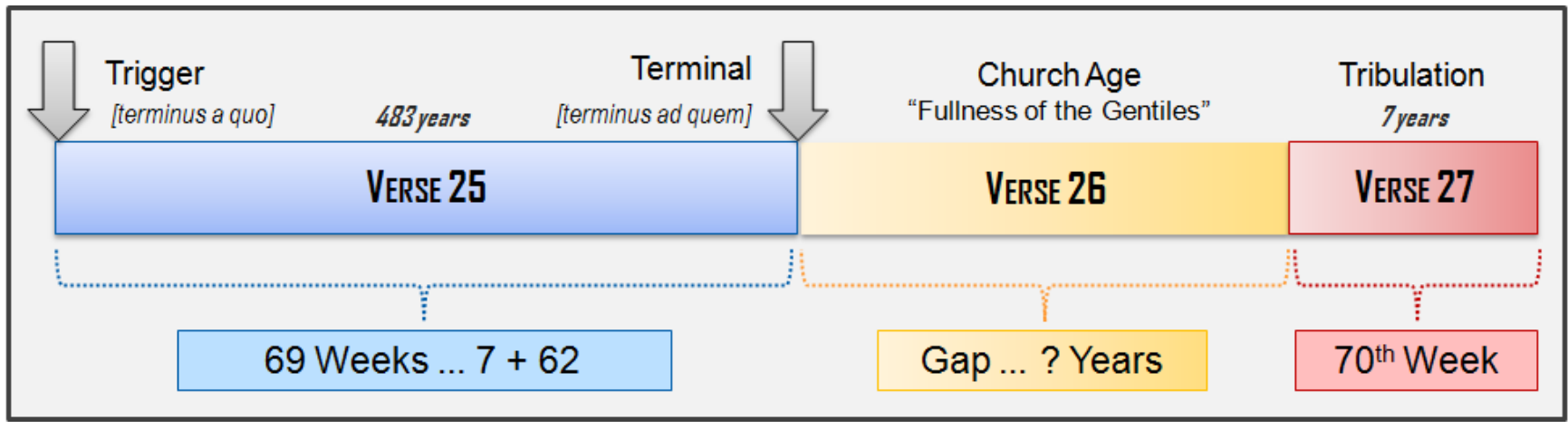

- ✓ Weeks ..... Feast of weeks [Leviticus 23:15-16]
- ✓ Months ..... Nisan to Tishri [Exodus 12:2; Leviticus 23:24]
- ➡ ✓ Years ..... Sabbatical Years for the Lord  
[Leviticus 25:1-22; 26:33-35; Deuteronomy 15;  
Exodus 23:-10-11; 2 Chronicles 36:19-21]

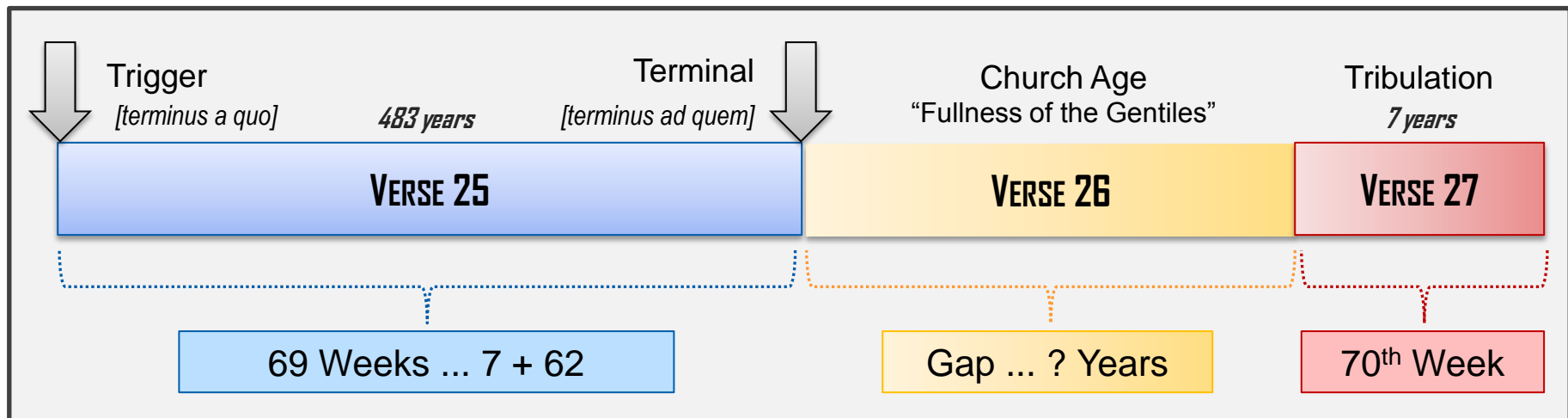

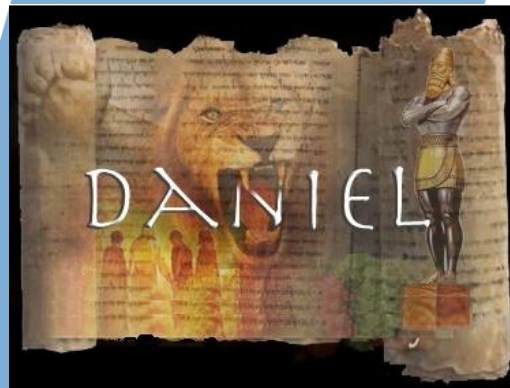

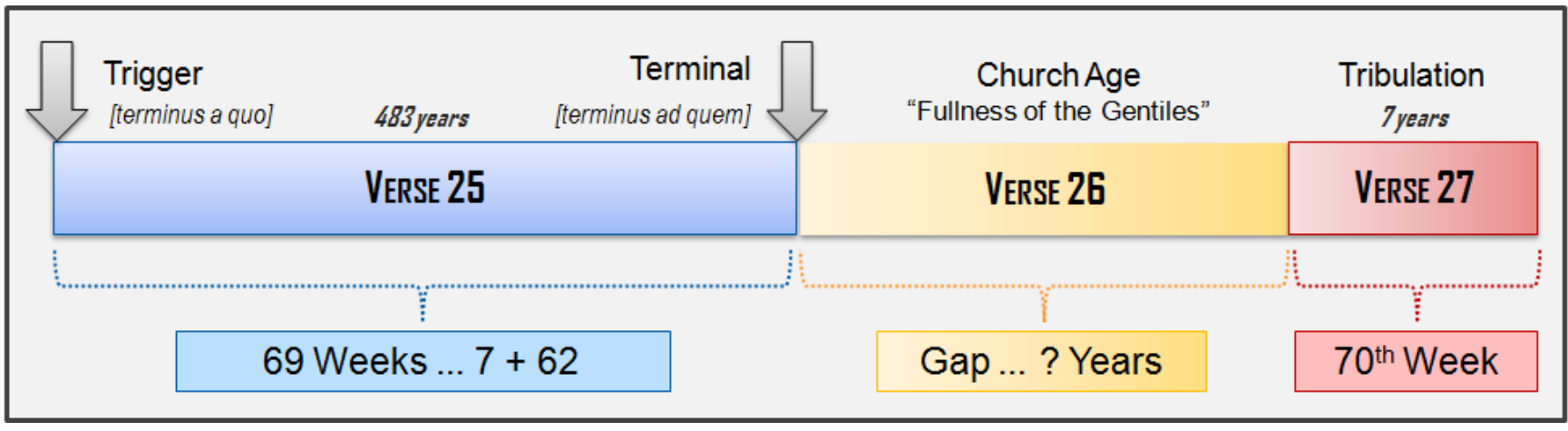

## ■ Know Therefore and Understand

### • Trigger

✓ From the going forth of the command

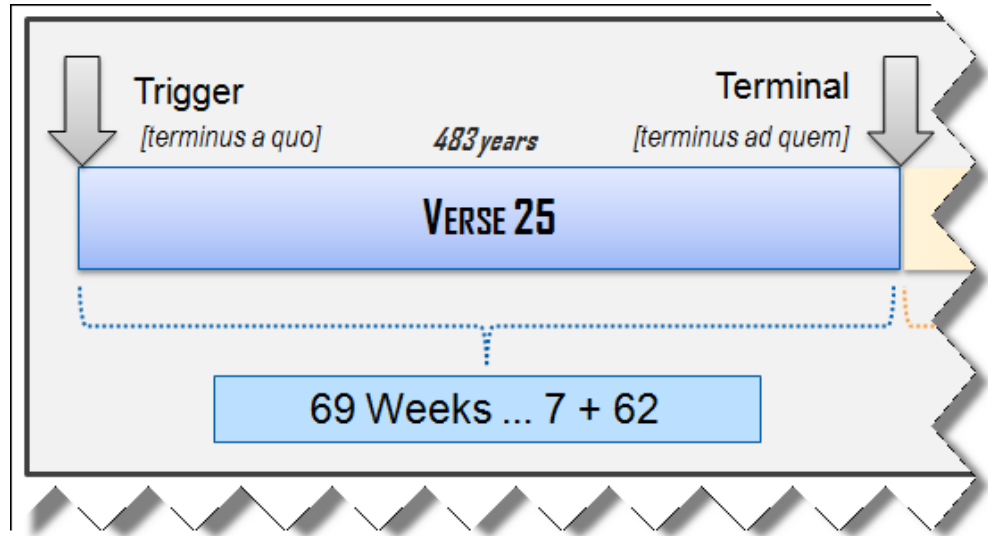
- To Restore Jerusalem
- To Build Jerusalem

### • Time Interval

- ✓  $7 + 62 \text{ weeks} = 69 \text{ weeks}$
- ✓  $69 * 7 \text{ years} = 483 \text{ years}$

### • Terminal

- ✓ Until **Messiah the Prince**
- ✓ The *street* shall be *built again*
- ✓ The *wall* shall be *built again*

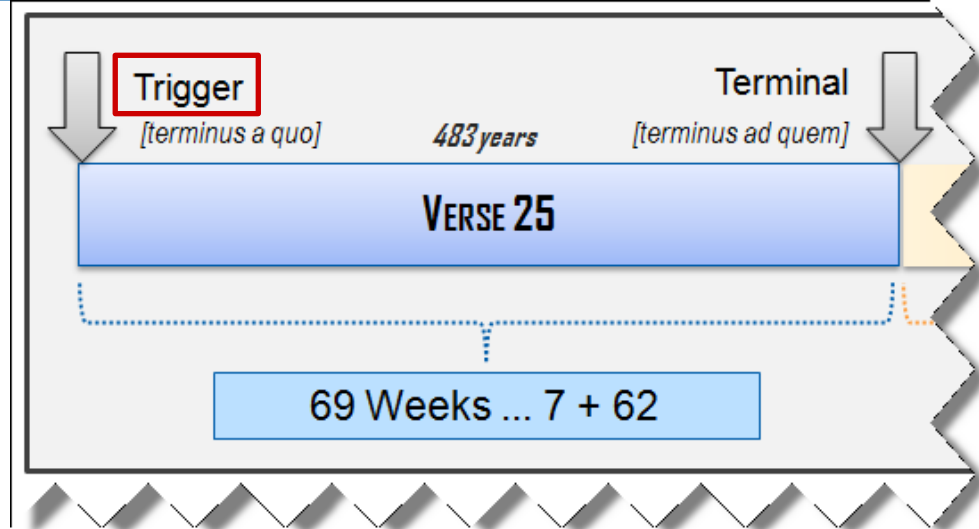

## ■ Trigger

- Commands to Rebuild

Ruler	Year	Scripture
Cyrus	537 BC	Ezra 1:1-4
Darius	520 BC	Ezra 6:1-12
Artaxerxes	458 BC	Ezra 7:11-26
Artaxerxes	445 BC	Nehemiah 2:5-18

- 1<sup>st</sup> three were to rebuild the **Temple**
- Last one to rebuild the **city** and the **walls**



# Daniel 9:25 - Observations

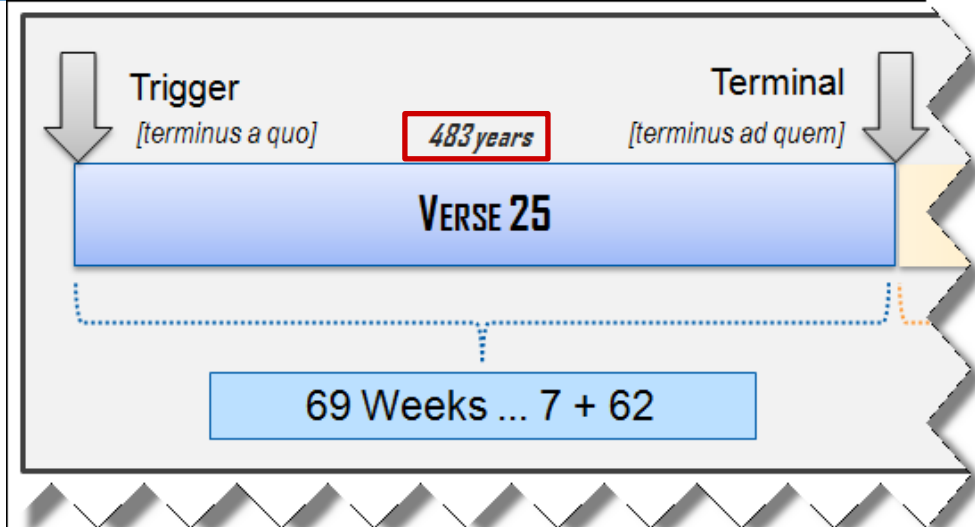
<sup>25</sup> "Know therefore and understand, *That* from the going forth of the command To restore and build Jerusalem Until Messiah the Prince, *There shall be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks*; The street shall be built again, and the wall, Even in troublesome times.

## ■ Time Interval

- $7 + 62 = 69$  weeks
- $69 * 7 = 483$  years
- $483 * \boxed{360} = \underline{173,880 \text{ days}}$

Bible Uses 360-day Years

➤ 12 Thirty-Day Months

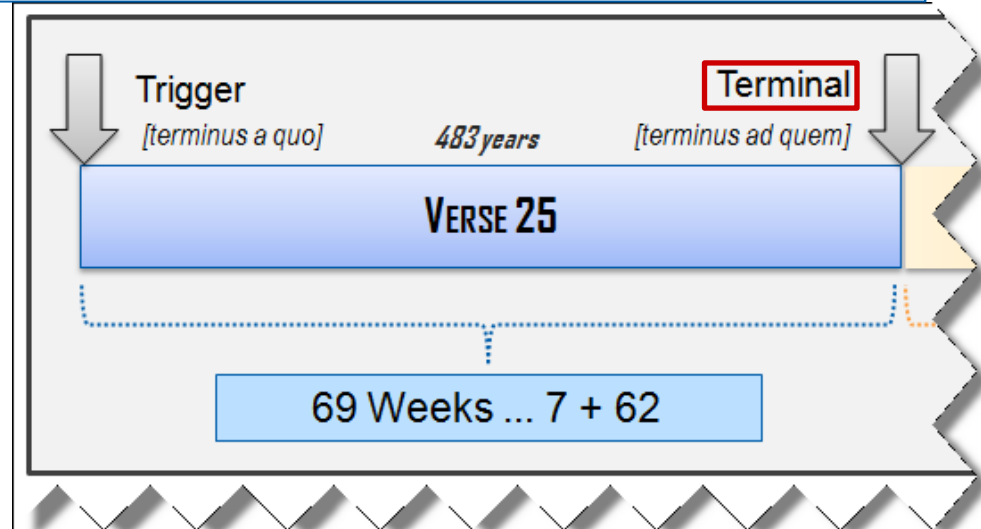

  - the *Messiah*
  - the *Prince*

### • The **Meshiach Nagid**

- ✓ "The **Messiah** the **King**"
- ✓ *Nagid* - 1<sup>st</sup> used for **King** Saul

### • Fulfilled in **Triumphal Entry**

- ✓ John's Gospel records several attempts to make Jesus King ... by force
  - John 6:15; 7:30, 44



# Zechariah 9:9 - Observations

<sup>9</sup> "Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion! Shout, O daughter of Jerusalem! Behold, your King is coming to you; He *is* just and having salvation, Lowly and riding on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.

## ■ The Triumphal Entry

- On one occasion Jesus ... Matthew 21:1-9; Mark 11:1-10; Luke 19:29-39; John 12:12-16

- ✓ Allows the people to proclaim Him King

- Luke 19:38

- Quoting Psalm 118:26

- ✓ He actually arranges for it

- ✓ Pharisees come un-glued

- This Psalm, in this context

- Amounted to...

- » Proclaiming Jesus as King

<sup>38</sup> saying: " 'Blessed *is* the King who comes in the name of the LORD!' Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!"

<sup>39</sup> And some of the Pharisees called to Him from the crowd, "Teacher, rebuke Your disciples."

<sup>40</sup> But He answered and said to them, "I tell you that if these should keep silent, the stones would immediately cry out."

- This Your Day

- ✓ Luke 19:41-42

- ✓ Why is Jesus weeping?

<sup>41</sup> Now as He drew near, He saw the city and wept over it, <sup>42</sup> saying, "If you had known, even you, especially in this your day, the things *that make* for your peace! But now they are hidden from your eyes.

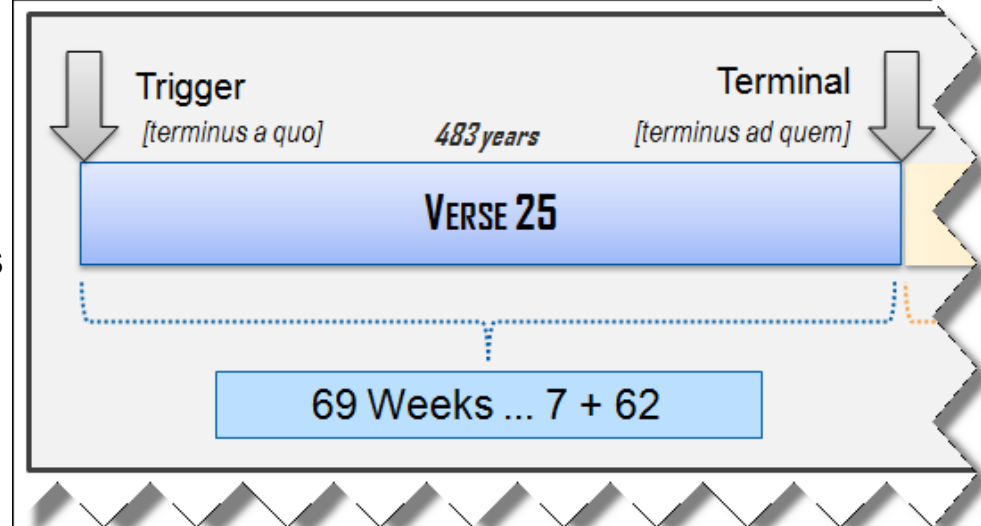
## ■ Trigger to Terminal

- Trigger
  - ✓ **Command** to **Restore Jerusalem**
  - ✓ Decree of Artaxerxes Longimanus
  - ✓ March 14, 445 BC
- Terminal
  - ✓ The **Messiah** the **King**
  - ✓ The Triumphal Entry of Jesus
  - ✓ April 6, AD 32
- Vision Time Interval - 69 weeks
  - ✓  $69 * 7 * 360 =$  **173,880 days** ✓

Gabriel's vision is accurate to the day!!!

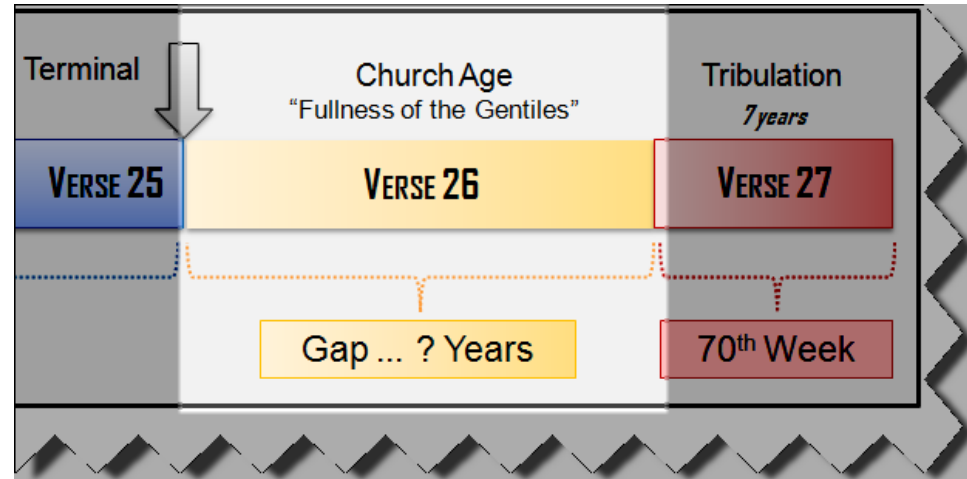

The end of it *shall be* with a flood, And till the end of the war desolations are determined.

## ■ Messiah Shall be Cut Off

- After the **sixty-two** weeks
  - ✓ 7 weeks first
  - ✓ Then the 62 weeks
  - ✓ So, actually after the 69<sup>th</sup> week
  - ✓ Cut-off
    - Hebrew - *karat*
    - To cut off, eliminate, kill, execute



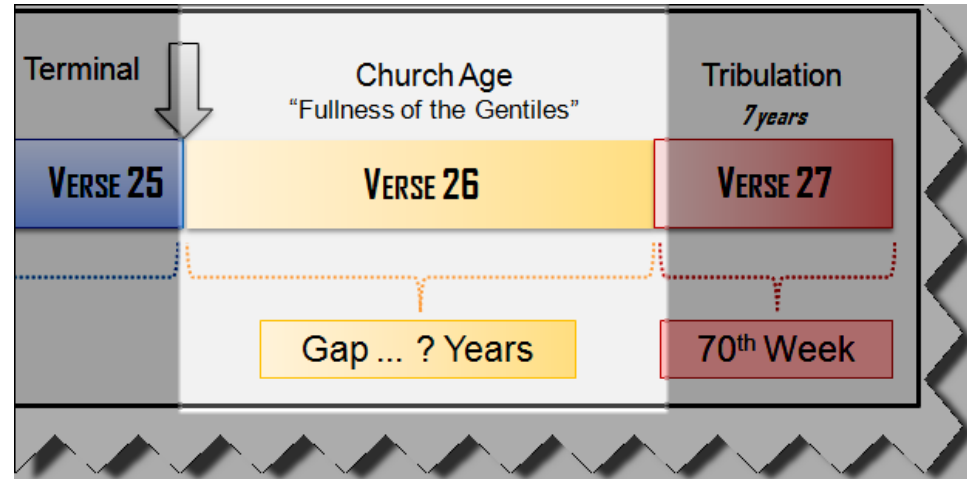

## ■ People of the Prince

- Historically identified as
  - ✓ The Romans
- Prince from Roman Empire
  - ✓ Western Leg
    - Most scholars fixate here
  - ✓ Eastern Leg
    - Byzantines out lasted Western Leg by over 1000 years



## • Shall destroy the city and the sanctuary

- ✓ Jerusalem destroyed in AD 70
- ✓ Titus Vespasian
- ✓ Temple burned to the ground
- ✓ Matthew 24:1-2

## Olivet Discourse

**24** Then Jesus went out and departed from the temple, and His disciples came up to show Him the buildings of the temple. <sup>2</sup> And Jesus said to them, "Do you not see all these things? Assuredly, I say to you, not *one* stone shall be left here upon another, that shall not be thrown down."

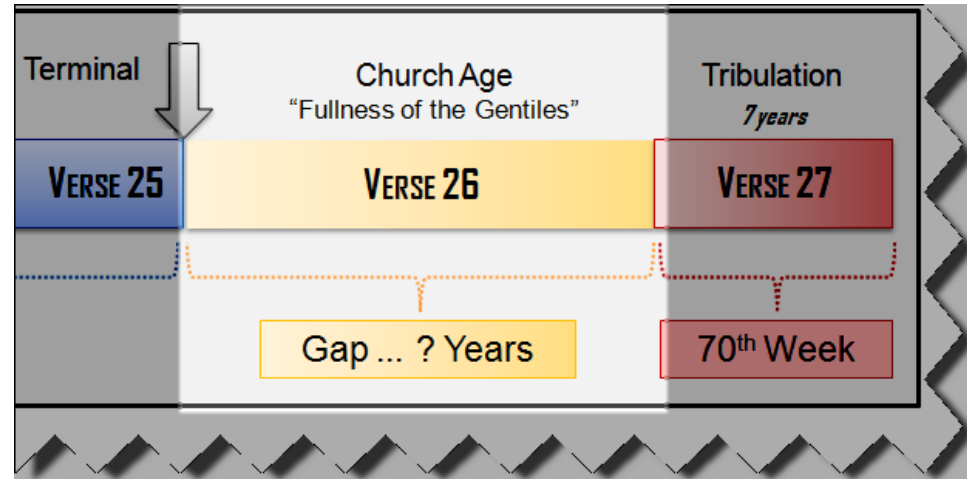

## ■ The end of it shall be with a flood

- After the destruction
- Flood : *Diaspora*
- 38 years after *Triumphal Entry*

## ■ Israel and the Church

- Two separate entities
  - ✓ Different
    - Origins
    - Missions
    - Destinies
- God deals with each
  - ✓ Mutually exclusively



## REPLACEMENT THEOLOGY

- Denies Israel her place in God's program (Romans 9-11)
- Makes God a liar
- Laid the basis for Christian Anti-Semitism
- “*I would consider it heresy.*”



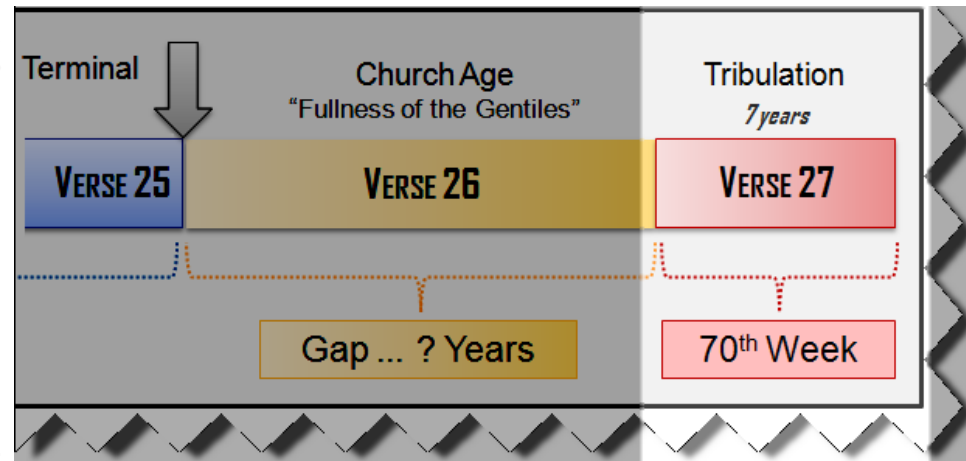

## ■ The 70<sup>th</sup> Week - Tribulation Week

### • Confirm a covenant with many

- ✓ "Many" is idiom for Israel
- ✓ Confirm a Covenant
  - Does not say "sign a covenant"
  - Confirm here could mean
    - » Sign & confirm a new covenant or
    - » Confirm an existing covenant

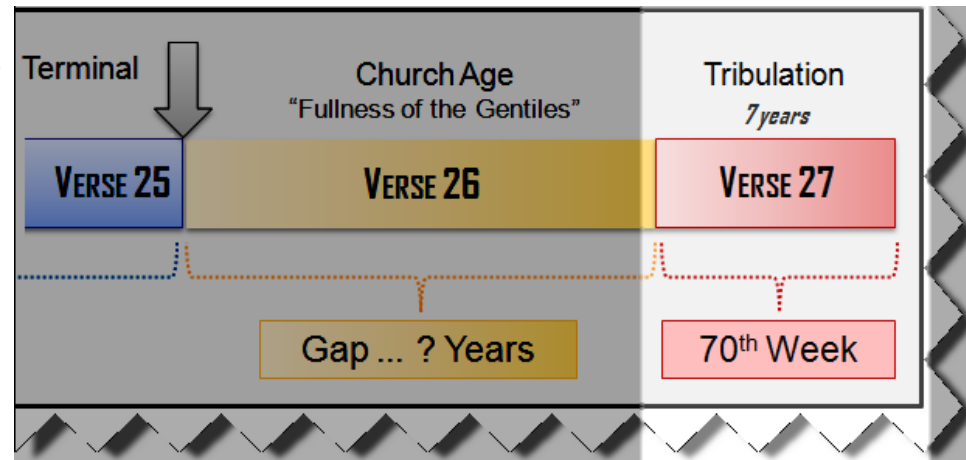

## ■ The 70<sup>th</sup> Week - Tribulation Week

- Middle of the week
  - ✓ 3 ½ years
- He shall bring an end ...

✓ Who is the "he" here?

- The Antichrist
  - » Against Christ
  - » Actually means in place of Christ
- Antiochus IV Epiphanes (175-164 BC)
  - » Type of the Antichrist to come
  - » Brought an end to the sacrifice and offerings
  - » Offered a pig on God's Holy alter
  - » Raised an idol to Zeus (Jupiter) in the Holy of Holies

## ■ The 70<sup>th</sup> Week - Tribulation Week

### • ... end to sacrifice and offering

#### ✓ Where do offerings take place?

- In the Temple
- Temple will be rebuilt
- At the latest mid-tribulation week

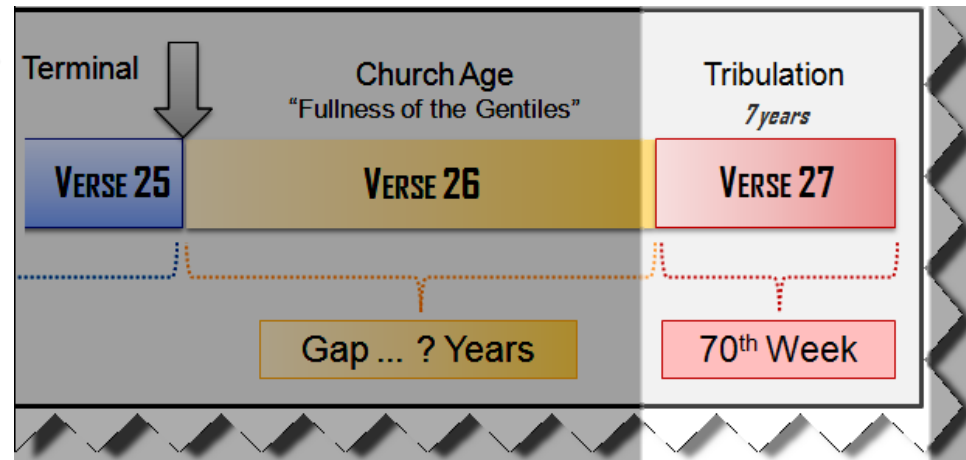
### • ... abominations ... makes desolate

#### ✓ At the time of this vision

- Antiochus IV Epiphanes is still future
- The Antichrist is still future

#### ✓ At the time of the Olivet Discourse

- Antiochus IV Epiphanes is past
- The Antichrist is still future



## Olivet Discourse
