The Fall of Babylon the Great - Revelation 18:1-2 - OBSERVATIONS

- **Another Angel** - From Heaven
 - John sees another angel come down from heaven
 - Angel has great authority
 - The earth is illuminated by his glory
 - Angel cries out with a loud voice
 - Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen
 - Mentioned twice - certainty and suddenness
Genesis 41:32; Isaiah 21:9; Revelation 14:8
 - Babylon has become a dwelling place for demons
 - Disembodied spirits are now dwelling in Babylon
 - Babylon has become a prison for every foul spirit
 - Every foul spirit is imprisoned there - unable to leave
 - Babylon has become a cage for every unclean and hated bird
 - Every unclean and hated bird is trapped there
 - Birds are a symbol of Satan and his minions
Matthew 13:4,19; Mark 4:4,15; Luke 8:5,12

18 After these things I saw another angel coming down from heaven, having great authority, and the earth was illuminated with his glory. ² And he cried mightily with a loud voice, saying, "Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and has become a dwelling place of demons, a prison for every foul spirit, and a cage for every unclean and hated bird!"

--- Revelation 18:1-2 ... NKJV

The fall of Babylon announced in 14:8 is now repeated as final and decisive.

The Fall of Babylon the Great - Revelation 18:3 - OBSERVATIONS

• **Babylon is Fallen** - The Reason

• **Why is Babylon Fallen?**

- Because all the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of the harlot's fornication
 - Spiritual unfaithfulness to God
 - She seduced the kings of the earth to abandon God with her
- The merchants of the earth have become rich through the abundance of the harlot's luxury
 - Greed is their creed
 - Greed has led them away from God into spiritual unfaithfulness - harlotry in God's eyes
 - Do we not see this in our culture today?

19 "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; **20** but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. **21** For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.

-- Matthew 6:19-21 ... NKJV [Lay Up Treasures in Heaven]

3 For all the nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth have become rich through the abundance of her luxury."

The wealth originally collected through the influence of the apostate church is taken over by the political system in the great tribulation.

Where are you accumulating your Treasures?

The Fall of Babylon the Great - Revelation 18:4-5 - OBSERVATIONS

- **Another Voice** - “Come out of her”
 - John hears another voice from heaven calling God’s people to flee the doomed city
 - Children of Israel urged to flee from the midst of Babylon ... [Jeremiah 50:8, 51:6](#)
 - Lot’s command to leave Sodom ... [Genesis 19:12-13](#)
 - We are commanded to be separate ([2 Cor 6:17-18](#))
 - **Why flee the city?** ... By fleeing the city ...
 1. They will not partake of her sins
 2. They will not have her plagues inflicted on them
 - Babylon’s sins are declared to reach to the heavens with the result that God remembers her iniquities

⁹ We would have healed Babylon, But she is not healed. Forsake her, and let us go everyone to his own country; For her judgment reaches to heaven and is lifted up to the skies. --- [Jeremiah 51:9 ... NKJV](#)

The Fall of Babylon the Great - Revelation 18:6 - OBSERVATIONS

• Double Double - Toil and Trouble

- The enormity of Babylon's sin now brings the enormity of God's judgment
 - God will exact full payment
 - The Law of Retribution - *lex talionis* [Latin]
 - Divine justice exacts the "eye for an eye" and the "tooth for a tooth"
 - Apart from **Christ's blood** you would need to pay for your sins! Praise God for His Grace and Mercy!!
- The voice that John hears demands that the law of retribution be doubled in payment of Babylon's hideous sins.
- She mixes a "cup" of sin that the nations will drink down to the full, so she is given a double cup of divine judgment to drink ... (Revelation 14:10).

10 he himself shall also drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out **full strength** into the cup of His indignation. He shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels and in the presence of the Lamb.

The Fall of Babylon the Great - Revelation 18:7-8 - OBSERVATIONS

• I Sit As Queen - I Am No Widow

- The same law of retribution is indicated in [verse 7](#)
- The standard of her judgment is compared to her luxurious living in which she was given to self-glorification ... *narcissistic - sound familiar?*
- Her willful sin against God is now to be rewarded with torment and sorrow.
- “I am no widow...”: Strange boast!
 - Israel, the widow of YHWH.
 - Widow, non-virgin, unacceptable bride of priest
[Leviticus 22:13](#)
 - Jerusalem referred to as a “widow”
[Lamentations 1:1; Isaiah 47](#)

⁷ In the measure that she glorified herself and lived luxuriously, in the same measure give her torment and sorrow; for she says in her heart, ‘I sit *as* queen, and am no widow, and will not see sorrow.’ ⁸ Therefore her plagues will come in one day—death and mourning and famine. And she will be utterly burned with fire, for strong *is* the Lord God who judges her.

The Fall of Babylon the Great - Revelation 18:7-8 - OBSERVATIONS

- **I Sit As Queen - I Am No Widow**
 - Babylon's wishful thinking is going to be rewarded by sudden destruction from the Lord - "in a single day"
 - Reminiscent of the Fall of Babylon in Daniel 5
 - Fell in the same hour that the finger traced its condemning words on the wall

On October 12, 539 BC, Cyrus' general captured Babylon without a battle. The Persians diverted the River Euphrates into a canal upriver so that the water level dropped "*to the height of the middle of a man's thigh*," which rendered the flood defenses useless and enabled the invaders to march through the river bed to enter by night. [Herodotus]

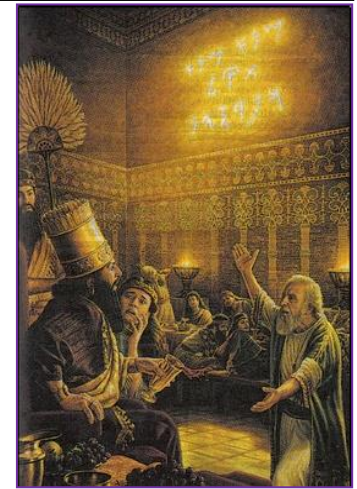

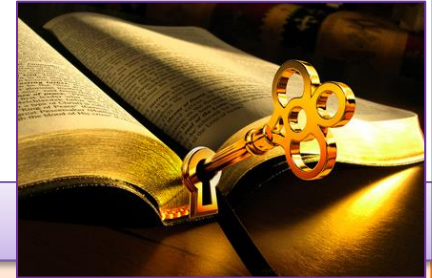

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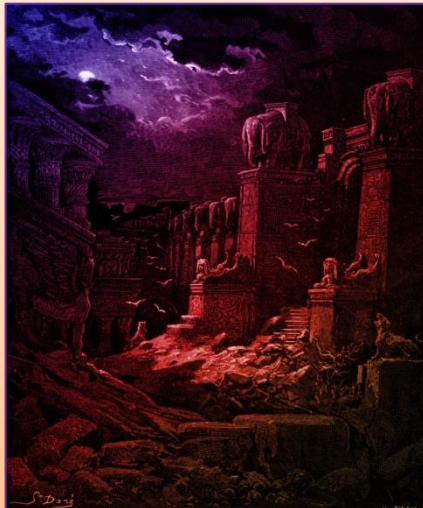


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The World Mourns Babylon's Fall - Revelation 18:9-10 - OBSERVATIONS

• The World Mourns - Kings of the Earth

- Three groups are singled out as mourning the fall of Babylon the Great and Mighty City

1. Kings of the earth verses 9-10
2. Merchants of the earth verses 11-16
3. Shipmasters & sailors verses 17-19

- The destruction of political and economic Babylon is lamented by her kingly lovers
- These kings are a wider designation than the ten kings of 17:12,16 who participated in the destruction of the harlot
- The kings of the earth weep and lament for the harlot
 - When they see the smoke of her burning
 - They stand at a distance for fear of her torment
 - *Nuclear fall-out???*
 - Saying
 - The great city Babylon has been judged in one hour

⁹ "The kings of the earth who committed fornication and lived luxuriously with her will weep and lament for her, when they see the smoke of her burning,¹⁰ standing at a distance for fear of her torment, saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour your judgment has come.'

--- Revelation 18:9-10 ... NKJV

Ancient Babylon is to be rebuilt as the capital of the world empire in the great tribulation. [Isaiah 13-14](#) & [Jeremiah 50-51](#) indicate Babylon will be completely destroyed. These prophecies are yet to be fulfilled.

The World Mourns Babylon's Fall - Revelation 18:11-13 - OBSERVATIONS

- **The World Mourns** - Merchants of the Earth
 - The **Second** of the three groups
 - Babylon as a commercial power is evident from the lament of the world's merchants
 - Wailing over the loss of their trade with the city
 - Everything that indicated the wealth of the ancient world is itemized as the treasure of Babylon in her hour of destruction.
 - There are **28** items listed in [verses 12-13](#)
 - Literal not symbolic
 - Holy Spirit provides this list to avoid allegorizing

¹¹ "And the merchants of the earth will weep and mourn over her, for no one buys their merchandise anymore:
¹² merchandise of gold and silver, precious stones and pearls, fine linen and purple, silk and scarlet, every kind of citron wood, every kind of object of ivory, every kind of object of most precious wood, bronze, iron, and marble; ¹³ and cinnamon and incense, fragrant oil and frankincense, wine and oil, fine flour and wheat, cattle and sheep, horses and chariots, and bodies and souls of men.

--- Revelation 18:11-13 ... NKJV

The World Mourns Babylon's Fall - Revelation 18:14-16 - OBSERVATIONS

- **The World Mourns** - Merchants of the Earth
 - All the city's possessions are totally lost
 - The fruit that your soul longed for
 - The things which are rich
 - The things which are splendid
 - Like the kings who stood far off and watched the ascending smoke of Babylon's burning, so the merchants of the earth also fear to go near the city
 - The merchants who became rich by the great city, repeat the king's lament
 - Again highlighting the great wealth of the city
 - Clothed in fine linen
 - Clothed in purple
 - Clothed in scarlet
 - Adorned with gold
 - Adorned with precious stones
 - Adorned with pearls

¹⁴ The fruit that your soul longed for has gone from you, and all the things which are rich and splendid have gone from you, and you shall find them no more at all. ¹⁵ The merchants of these things, who became rich by her, will stand at a distance for fear of her torment, weeping and wailing, ¹⁶ and saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city that was clothed in fine linen, purple, and scarlet, and adorned with gold and precious stones and pearls!

--- Revelation 18:14-16 ... NKJV

The World Mourns Babylon's Fall - Revelation 18:17-19 - OBSERVATIONS

- **The World Mourns** - Shipmasters and Sailors
 - The Third of the three groups
 - Those in ships apparently standing off from shore on the sea witness the scene and join in the mourning for Babylon - *their partner in trade*
 - For the third time the mourning cry is heard
 - "Alas, alas ..."
 - Their mourning is not for the city but for the wealth derived from trade in shipping is now at an end.
 - Christ warned against coveting the wealth of this world
... Matthew 6:19-21

19 "Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy and where thieves break in and steal; **20** but lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. **21** For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. -- Matthew 6:19-21 ...NKJV

Are you coveting the wealth of this world?

17 For in one hour such great riches came to nothing.' Every shipmaster, all who travel by ship, sailors, and as many as trade on the sea, stood at a distance **18** and cried out when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, 'What *is* like this great city?' **19** "They threw dust on their heads and cried out, weeping and wailing, and saying, 'Alas, alas, that great city, in which all who had ships on the sea became rich by her wealth! For in one hour she is made desolate.'

--- Revelation 18:17-19 ... NKJV

The World Mourns Babylon's Fall - Revelation 18:20 - OBSERVATIONS

• **Rejoice** - God has Avenged You

- In contrast to the grief overtaking worldly rulers and merchants by the destruction of Babylon, those in heaven are called to rejoice at God's righteous judgment
- This is the 2nd time in the book of Revelation the command is given to rejoice. (1st Time: 12:12)

Echoed in [Jeremiah 51:56-64](#)

What do you rejoice over?

• **Who is commanded to rejoice?**

- Heaven Represents Tribulation Saints
- Holy apostles Represents New Testament Saints
- Holy prophets Represents Old Testament Saints

• **Why are they commanded to rejoice?**

- Because God has avenged them
- Babylon had slain the saints,
Now God slays Babylon

20 "Rejoice over her, O heaven, and *you* holy apostles and prophets, for God has avenged you on her!"

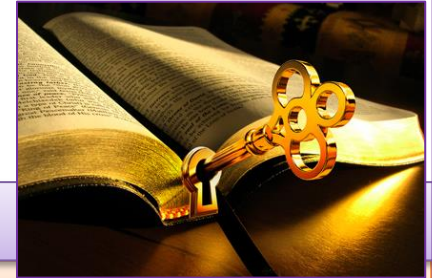

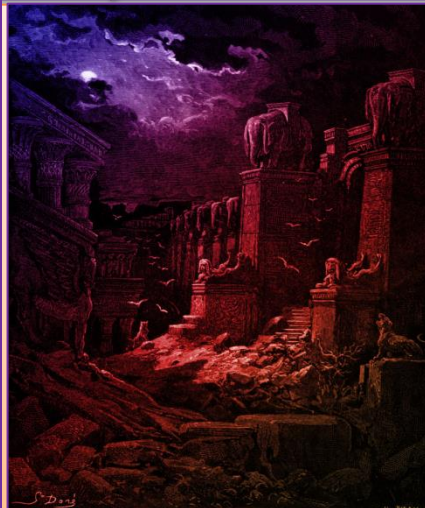

• **Babylon Thrown Down** - With Violence

- John sees a mighty angel throw a huge stone into the sea as he says ...
- Thus with violence the great city Babylon ...
 - Shall be thrown down *Sudden*
 - Shall not be found anymore ... *Complete Destruction*
- A similar instance is found in [Jeremiah 51:61-64](#)
 - Prince Seraiah who accompanies Zedekiah into Babylon is instructed after reading the book of Jeremiah to tie a stone to it and throw it into the midst of the Euphrates.

⁶¹ And Jeremiah said to Seraiah, "When you arrive in Babylon and see it, and read all these words, ⁶² then you shall say, 'O LORD, You have spoken against this place to cut it off, so that none shall remain in it, neither man nor beast, but it shall be desolate forever.' ⁶³ Now it shall be, when you have finished reading this book, *that* you shall tie a stone to it and throw it out into the Euphrates. ⁶⁴ Then you shall say, 'Thus Babylon shall sink and not rise from the catastrophe that I will bring upon her. And they shall be weary.'" -- [Jeremiah 51:61-64 ... NKJV](#)

²¹ Then a mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone and threw *it* into the sea, saying, "Thus with violence the great city Babylon shall be thrown down, and shall not be found anymore. ²² The sound of harpists, musicians, flutists, and trumpeters shall not be heard in you anymore. No craftsman of any craft shall be found in you anymore, and the sound of a millstone shall not be heard in you anymore.

--- [Revelation 18:21-22 ... NKJV](#)

Destruction of Babylon!

Finality of Babylon's Fall - Revelation 18:23-24 - OBSERVATIONS

- **Destruction of Babylon** - Never to Return
 - These two verses provide another brief summary of the extent of Babylon's sins and greatness.
 - Her merchants were the great men of the earth.
 - All nations were deceived by Babylon's sorceries.
 - Also mentioned is the ...
 - Blood of the prophets
 - Blood of the saints
 - All who were slain on the earth

²³ The light of a lamp shall not shine in you anymore, and the voice of bridegroom and bride shall not be heard in you anymore. For your merchants were the great men of the earth, for by your sorcery all the nations were deceived. ²⁴ And in her was found the blood of prophets and saints, and of all who were slain on the earth."

--- Revelation 18:23-24 ... NKJV

The Doom of Babylon - SUMMARY


- **The Doom of Babylon - Fall Versus Destruction**
 - The great prophecies concerning the city of Babylon in [Isaiah 13-14](#) and [Jeremiah 50-51](#) have never been fulfilled.
 - In [Isaiah 13-14](#), the destruction of Babylon is predicted.
 - In vigorous terms, Isaiah describes how Babylon will be destroyed and then will never again be inhabited.
 - This identifies the time of the destruction as that particular period known as the “Day of The Lord” that is mentioned throughout the scripture and is associated with the final day of God’s vengeance.
[Joel 2:10; Malachi 4:5; Daniel 12:1; Matthew 24:21-22](#)
 - When God destroys Babylon, He will destroy all the evil in the world.

The Doom of Babylon - SUMMARY

• The Doom of Babylon - Fall Versus Destruction

- **Fall of Babylon** in 539 BC (Daniel 5)
 - **Cyrus** boasts "Without a battle"
 - Became Alexander's capital
 - Atrophied over the centuries
 - Saddam Hussein was rebuilding - *Presently on hold.*
- **Destruction of Babylon** (Isaiah 13-14; Jeremiah 50-51)
 - "Never to be inhabited"
 - "Building materials never reused"
 - "Like Sodom and Gomorrah"
- **"Mystery Babylon"** (Revelation 17-18)

What: Clay cylinder, 22.5cm by 10cm, inscribed with arguably the world's first known human rights charter	Antiquity: 539BC, when Persian emperor Cyrus conquered Babylon	Contents: Freedom of worship for all, call for repatriation of deportees	Home: London Museum
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This cylinder, discovered by Hormuzd Rassam in the 19th century, can presently be seen in the British Museum in London.

"...without any battle, he entered the town, sparing any calamity; ... I returned to sacred cities on the other side of the Tigris, the sanctuaries of which have been ruins for a long time... and established for them permanent sanctuaries. I also gathered all their former inhabitants and returned to them their habitations."

The Woman in the Ephah - ZECHARIAH 5:5-11

• The Woman in the Ephah - Woman Called Wickedness

- Ephah containing a Woman called “Wickedness.”

She is sealed in with a talent of lead.

Carried by two women with wings of a stork between the earth and heaven... “To build it a house in the land of Shinar: and it shall be established, and set there upon her own base.”



- The strange vision in [Zechariah 5](#) suggests that there will be an appropriate time when the commercial and religious power center of the Planet Earth will, once again, migrate back to its original site of the literal city of Babylon.
- Note that the “ephah” and the “talent” were the standard commercial measures of volume and weight, respectively. Ephah~1 bushel (35 liters): Talent~100 lbs.
- The two carriers had the “wings of a stork” which is an unclean bird.
- The captive woman called “wickedness” may be a reference to the harlot of [Revelation 17 and 18](#).
- The broadly overlooked possibility is that there will yet be a global power shift from Rome.

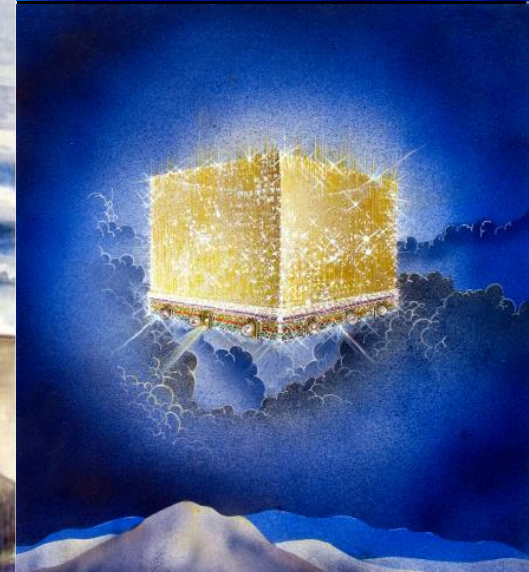
