


Preview ... Purifying Hope: Part I

Paul sent Timothy to encourage and fortify the faith of the Thessalonian believers. The good news that Timothy brought back regarding their development strengthens the apostle. He prays that he will be able to return to help the believers grow to completion. Specifically, he prays that they will grow in love and holiness and that they will be ready at the coming of Christ Jesus with His saints.



Paul's Concern - 1 Thessalonians 3:1 - OBSERVATIONS



3 Therefore, when we could no longer endure it, we thought it good to be left in Athens alone, ² and sent Timothy, our brother and minister of God, and our fellow laborer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you and encourage you concerning your faith, ³ that no one should be shaken by these afflictions; for you yourselves know that we are appointed to this.

--- 1 Thessalonians 3:1-3 ... NKJV

Paul's Concern - Left in Athens

- THEREFORE a link to the last thought of the last chapter.
 - Paul expressed how he longed to see them last thought
 - "Therefore" link to new thought
 - When we could no longer endure the waiting and longing we thought it would be good to stay in Athens and send Timothy to you. - new thought
- Paul and Silas remain in Athens (we)
 - Paul addressing the Areopagus ... Act 17:16-34
 - Altar inscription: TO THE UNKNOWN GOD
 - Opportunity to present the gospel Attentive audience until Paul mention the resurrection of the dead reactions included...
 - Some mocked
 - Some were polite ("we will hear you again on this matter")
 - Some believed

Ares (Mars): god of war

AREOPAGUS - "Ares Rock" ... aka Mars Hill
NW of the Acropolis in Athens

Ares was tried by the gods here for the murder of Poseidon's son Alirrothios

Paul's Concern - 1 Thessalonians 3:2-3 - OBSERVATIONS



3 Therefore, when we could no longer endure it, we thought it good to be left in Athens alone, ² and sent Timothy, our brother and minister of God, and our fellow laborer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you and encourage you concerning your faith, ³ that no one should be shaken by these afflictions; for you yourselves know that we are appointed to this.

--- 1 Thessalonians 3:1-3 ... NKJV

- Paul's Concern Timothy Sent
 - Paul and Silas send Timothy to the Thessalonians
 - Timothy's CREDENTIALS
 - OUR BROTHER (adelphos) brethren in Christ; believer
 - MINISTER OF GOD (diakonos) deacon; servant; table waiter
 - FELLOW LABORER IN THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST (synergos) companion in work; fellow worker
 - Timothy's MISSION
 - To ESTABLISH (strengthen) the Thessalonians.
 Exodus 17:8-26 ... Victory over the Amalekites Support
 - To ENCOURAGE (comfort) the faith of the believers.
 - PURPOSE: So that none of the Thessalonian believers would be SHAKEN BY THE AFFLICTIONS they were facing.

WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BE SHAKEN BY AFFLICTION?

Parable of the Sower and the Soils - Matthew 13:18-23

Paul's Concern - 1 Thessalonians 3:2-3 - OBSERVATIONS

- Paul's Concern Appointed for Affliction
 - How do the Thessalonians know that they were appointed for affliction?
 - Paul's teaching when he was with them (verse 4)
 - Paul's COMMISSION (Acts 9)

¹⁵ But the Lord said to him, "Go, for he is a chosen vessel of Mine to bear My name before Gentiles, kings, and the children of Israel. ¹⁶ For I will show him how many things he must suffer for My name's sake." --- Acts 9:15-16 ... NKJV

Our COMMISSION (Matthew 10:16-26)

²¹ "Now brother will deliver up brother to death, and a father *his* child; and children will rise up against parents and cause them to be put to death. ²² And you will be hated by all for My name's sake. But he who endures to the end will be saved. ²³ When they persecute you in this city, flee to another. For assuredly, I say to you, you will not have gone through the cities of Israel before the Son of Man comes.

HOW DOES THIS ALIGN WITH THE FALSE TEACHINGS OF THE "PROSPERITY GOSPEL" MOVEMENT?

Paul's Concern - 1 Thessalonians 3:4 - OBSERVATIONS





- Paul's Concern Tribulation Forewarned
 - Suffer tribulation
 - To oppress; distress; trouble; afflict by external means
 - Jesus warned us ... John 16:33

have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

- This is not the Great Tribulation here in this verse
 - Paul will address this topic in 2 Thessalonians chapter 2.

• Paul's Concern - For This Reason

- For this Reason What Reason?
 - Paul's concern for the Thessalonian believers had reached a point where he could no longer endure it
 - Because of this great concern for their faith, Paul sends Timothy to ascertain the state of the Thessalonian believers' faith.
 - In particular, Paul is worried that the tempter may have tempted the believers to depart from the faith
 - Paul was lamenting that if this in fact happened then the labor of his missionary team would have been in vain (useless or worthless).

HOW CONCERNED ARE YOU FOR OTHER BELIEVERS?

DO YOU HAVE GREAT CONCERN FOR THE FAITH OF OTHERS?

²¹ For to me, to live *is* Christ, and to die *is* gain. ²² But if *I* live on in the flesh, this *will mean* fruit from *my* labor; yet what I shall choose I cannot tell. ²³ For I am hard-pressed between the two, having a desire to depart and be with Christ, *which is* far better. ²⁴ Nevertheless to remain in the flesh *is* more needful for you. --- Philippians 1:21-24 ... NKJV

- Paul's Concern For This Reason
 - The Tempter here is a reference to Satan






Paul's Comfort - 1 Thessalonians 3:6 - OBSERVATIONS



⁶ But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and brought us good news of your faith and love, and that you always have good remembrance of us, greatly desiring to see us, as we also to see you— 7 therefore, brethren, in all our affliction and distress we were comforted concerning you by your faith. 8 For now we live, if you stand fast in the I ord.

--- 1 Thessalonians 3:6-8 ... NKJV

- Paul's Comfort Timothy Returns
 - Timothy returns to Paul and Silas with good news regarding the Thessalonian believers.
 - Thessalonian Report Card
 - FAITH remained strong
 - Love remained strong
 - REMEMBRANCE: Fond memories of Paul and his team
 - ANTICIPATION: Longing to see Paul and Silas once again

Paul's Comfort - 1 Thessalonians 3:7 - OBSERVATIONS



⁶ But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and brought us good news of your faith and love, and that you always have good remembrance of us, greatly desiring to see us, as we also to see you— ⁷ therefore, brethren, in all our affliction and distress we were comforted concerning you by your faith. 8 For now we live, if you stand fast in the Lord.

--- 1 Thessalonians 3:6-8 ... NKJV

- Paul's Comfort By Your Faith
 - THEREFORE
 - Links the good news from previous verse
 - With the comfort in this verse
 - This is the fourth time in this chapter that Paul references the Thessalonians' faith
 - Even in Paul and Silas' affliction and distress, they
 were comforted with the good report of the
 Thessalonians' faith conveyed to them by Timothy.

Paul's Comfort - 1 Thessalonians 3:8 - OBSERVATIONS



⁶ But now that Timothy has come to us from you, and brought us good news of your faith and love, and that you always have good remembrance of us, greatly desiring to see us, as we also to see you— ⁷ therefore, brethren, in all our affliction and distress we were comforted concerning you by your faith. 8 For now we live, if you stand fast in the I ord.

--- 1 Thessalonians 3:6-8 ... NKJV

• Paul's Comfort - Stand in the Lord

- Paul concludes this thought with a declaration that he and his team now live since the Thessalonians believers are standing fast in the Lord.
 - They were enduring the persecution and afflictions.
 - They were remaining strong in their faith.

²⁷ Only let your conduct be worthy of the gospel of Christ, so that whether I come and see you or am absent, I may hear of your affairs, that you stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel, --- Philippians 1:27 ... NKJV

PAUL WAS CONSUMED WITH THE SPIRITUAL WELFARE OF OTHER BELIEVERS.

CAN YOU SAY THE SAME?

WE ARE TO COMFORT ONE ANOTHER - NOT COMPETE WITH ONE ANOTHER!

Paul's Comfort - 1 Thessalonians 3:9-10 - OBSERVATIONS



⁹ For what thanks can we render to God for you, for all the joy with which we rejoice for your sake before our God, ¹⁰ night and day praying exceedingly that we may see your face and perfect what is lacking in your faith?

--- 1 Thessalonians 3:9-10 ... NKJV

- Paul's Comfort Thanksgiving
 - Paul is overwhelmed with inexpressible joy.
 - What thanks can we render to God for you?
 - Paul is prayerfully rejoicing for the Thessalonians
 - We rejoice for your sake before our God
 - Paul is praying for an opportunity to see the Thessalonian believers once again, face-to-face
 - Night and day praying exceedingly continuously, abundantly
 - That we may see your face
 - And perfect (complete) what is lacking in your faith



⁶ being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete *it* until the day of Jesus Christ;

--- Philippians 1:6 ... NKJV





Paul's 2nd Coming Prayer - 1 Thessalonians 3:11 - OBSERVATIONS



11 Now may our God and Father Himself, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way to you. 12 And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, just as we do to you, ¹³ so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.

-- 1 Thessalonians 3:11-13 ... NKJV

- 2nd Coming Prayer Directed Path
 - Notice Paul always presents God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ as co-equal members of the trinity (along with the Holy Spirit).
 - Any one who denies this is not a Christian (an essential doctrine of the Christian faith).

²² Who is a liar but he who denies that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist who denies the Father and the Son. ²³ Whoever denies the Son does not have the Father either; he who acknowledges the Son has the Father also. ---1 John 2:22-23 ... NKJV

- Paul understands it is God who directs our paths.
- ⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths. --- Proverbs 3:5-6 ... NKJV
- Paul prays that God will make a way to Thessalonica for him and his team.

Paul's 2nd Coming Prayer - 1 Thessalonians 3:12 - OBSERVATIONS



11 Now may our God and Father Himself, and our Lord Jesus Christ, direct our way to you. 12 And may the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, just as we do to you, ¹³ so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ with all His saints.

-- 1 Thessalonians 3:11-13 ... NKJV

- 2nd Coming Prayer Increase and Abound in Love
 - Paul prays that the Lord (Holy Spirit) will make the Thessalonian believers ...
 - Increase in (AGAPE) LOVE to one another and to all growth
 - Abound in (AGAPE) LOVE to one another and to all overflow
 - Paul adds, "just as we do to you"

PAUL NEVER ASKED OTHERS TO DO WHAT HE WAS NOT WILLING TO DO!





We love, because He loved!



 - Establish the believers hearts


