



- Waters Prevailed 150 Days
 - Continual 5 months of rising waters on the earth
 - Purpose
 - ✓ Punishment ... Judgment
 - ✓ Purging Redemption
 - Noah and family were safe but not yet saved
 - Ends focus on judgment
 - Starts the transition to focus on redemption

God Remembered Noah

- "Remembered" Figure of Speech
 - ✓ God did not forget about Noah

18 But I will establish My covenant with you; and you shall go into the ark—you, your sons, your wife, and your sons' wives with you.

- √ God is remembering based on His Covenant with Noah (Genesis 6:18)
- ✓ God can be trusted to keep His covenants ... God never forgets
 - Believers can trust in the New Covenant in Christ's Blood (1 Corinthians 11:25)
- Transition
 - ✓ From Waters Rising To Waters Receding
 - ✓ From Focus on Judgment ... To Focus on Redemption
- God is in Control
 - ✓ God causes the waters to recede
 - Stopped the Fountains of the Deep (v. 2)
 - Stopped the Windows of Heaven (v. 2)
 - Restrained the Rain from Heaven (v. 2)

In the same manner *He* also *took* the cup after supper, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink *it*, in remembrance of Me."

God Made a Wind

- Shows God is in Control
- Shows God is taking Action
- All Creation Obeys His Commands
 - ✓ Even the winds (Matthew 8:26-27)

²⁶ But He said to them, "Why are you fearful, O you of little faith?" Then He arose and rebuked the winds and the sea, and there was a great calm. ²⁷ So the men marveled, saying, "Who can this be, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?"

- Same Hebrew word here for "wind" is "Spirit" in Genesis 1:1-2.
 - ✓ Note similarities with Genesis 1:1-2
 - Wind/Spirit hovering over the face of the waters
 - Water world to start forming and filling the earth (Creation & Re-Creation)
 - God is in control of the process

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.



² The fountains of the deep and the windows of heaven were also **stopped**, and the rain from heaven was **restrained**.

- Stopped ... Restrained
 - God is in Control
 - ✓ God causes the waters to recede
 - Stopped the Fountains of the Deep



Stopped the Windows of Heaven



- Restrained the Rain from Heaven



- Water Sources
 - ✓ Stopped Will not occur again ... Genesis 9:8-11
 - Fountains of the Deep



Windows of Heaven



- ✓ Restrained Held back for now
 - Rain from heaven



The Ark Rested

- The Ark rests on the seventh month.
 - √ 600th Year relative to Noah's age
 - ✓ Seventh month relative to civic Jewish calendar
- The Ark rests on the Sabbath month
 - ✓ God rested from His creation
 - Seventh day (Genesis 2:1-3)
 - ✓ We are commanded to rest
 - Sabbath day (Exodus 20:8)
- "Rest"
 - √ Sabbath day
 - ✓ Noah comfort


2 Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. ² And on the seventh day God ended His work which He had done, and He rested on the seventh day from all His work which He had done. ³ Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it, because in it He rested from all His work which God had created and made.

8 "Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.

- 7th Month 17th Day 7th Month is Nisan ... Civil Calendar [1st Month Religious Calendar ... (Ex 12:2)]
 - Jesus was crucified on the 14th of Nisan (Wednesday afternoon) Passover
 - Jesus was resurrected on the 17th of Nisan (Saturday evening) Resurrection

Mountains of Ararat

Mt Ararat, one of the tallest mountains in the middle east³, dominates the skyline at the junction of four nations. Many believe this was the resting place of Noah's Ark. The Armenians to the north revere the mountain as the origin of the Armenian people, or *Hay*, believing they are direct descendents of Noah's family. ¹

Currently, there is no remnant or photograph of Noah's Ark recognized as legitimate by the major creationist organizations such as AiG, ICR, CRS.

- Noah Sent Out a Raven and a Dove
 - Noah waits 40 days
 - Then opens the window of the ark which he had made
 - ✓ Reminds us of the faith of Noah who built the ark
 - ✓ Preparation for sending out the Raven and the Dove

- Noah Sent Out a Raven and a Dove
 - Both Sent out on a Mission
 - ✓ Gather intelligence
 - To see if the waters had receded from the face of the ground
 - We are sent out on a mission
 - ✓ Salt & Light (Matthew 5:13-16)
 - ✓ Taste & See (Psalm 34:8)

Oh, taste and see that the LORD is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him! 13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men.

14 "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Noah Sent Out a Raven and a Dove

Raven

- ✓ Single raven sent out
- ✓ Does not return to the Ark does not complete mission
- ✓ Characteristics
 - "Unclean" bird
 - Hardy bird unaffected by the cold
 - Feeds on carcasses of dead animals
 - Able to survive the receded flood conditions (mountain tops visible)

Noah Sent Out a Raven and a Dove

Dove

- ✓ Single dove sent out
- ✓ Returns to the Ark completes mission
- ✓ Characteristics
 - "Clean" bird
 - Flies low
 - Only lands on clean and dry places
 - » right bird for the mission

Dove Returned into the Ark

- 1st Dove fulfills its mission (Genesis 6:8)
 - ✓ Noah knows waters are receding
 - To what depth
 - » No resting place for the sole of her foot
 - » Mountain tops visible
 - » Tree tops & Ground not visible
- Noah receives the Dove
 - ✓ Picture of God drawing us back into the ark of salvation Jesus
 - ✓ Picture of God receiving us and drawing us to Himself
 - Put forth his hand
 - » God always make the first move
 - » We respond

2nd Dove

- 2nd Dove fulfills its mission (Genesis 6:8)
 - ✓ Noah knows the waters are receding.
- ⁸ He also sent out from himself a dove, to see if the waters had receded from the face of the ground.

- To what depth
 - » Returns with freshly plucked olive leaf
 - » Tree tops visible (in addition to mountain tops visible)
- Olive leaf
 - √ Symbol of peace
 - God's wrath against sin has been appeased in judgment
 - Believers judgment born by Christ on the cross
- Dove bearing olive leaf
 - ✓ Sign of the Holy Spirit
 - Brings a new creation in conforming us to the image of Christ
 - As new creations in Christ, we have the hope of Eternal Life

- 3rd Dove
 - 3rd Dove fulfills its mission (Genesis 6:8)
 - ✓ Noah knows the waters have receded
 - To what depth
 - » Did not return again
 - » Ground now appears
 - Notice the patience of Noah
 - ✓ Spent a lot of time waiting
 - ✓ We too should have patience
 - ✓ Wait upon the LORD (Isaiah 40:31)
 - Notice the 7 day waiting periods
 - ✓ Suggests that Noah was observing the Sabbath

⁸ He also sent out from himself a dove, to see if the waters had receded from the face of the ground.

But those who wait on the LORD
Shall renew their strength;
They shall mount up with wings like eagles,
They shall run and not be weary,
They shall walk and not faint.

Noah Removed the Covering of the Ark ... Earth was Dried

- Now confident that the waters were dried up
 - ✓ Noah removes the covering of the Ark
 - In order to see the ground
 - ✓ Confirms that the ground is dry
 - His Aerial Reconnaissance intelligence data was confirmed
 - Dove data was accurate
 - ✓ Notice Noah does not leave the Ark until instructed by God to do so
 - He waits another 2 months on the Ark
 - We should also not venture out
 - » Until we have been directed by the Holy Spirit to do so
 - » Trusting in God requires us to be patient and wait upon the LORD
 - » We need to rely on God's timing
