EPHESIANS 6:10-18







"Wrestle"

- Greek ... pale
- Refers to ...
 - Struggling
 - Wrestling
 - Hand-to-hand fighting
- Palaestra noun \pa-'les-tra\
 - Derived from the Greek pale
 - Famous house of combat sports including wrestling
 - Wrestling was
 - A very bloody sport
 - Extremely violent
 - Often to the death
 - No holds barred

"Wrestle"

- By using the Greek word pale
 - Paul conveys the idea of a bitter struggle or intense conflict
 - Paul describes our warfare
 with the Devil and his minions
 as a combat sport similar to
 those fought in the ancient
 Palaestra.
 - There are no rules
 - Anything goes
 - You better be equipped
 - You better be alert
 - You better be prepared

"against"

- Greek *pros*
 - Refers to a forward position or a face-to-face encounter
 - Same word used in John 1:1 to describe the preincarnate relationship between the Father and Jesus.

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. --- John 1:1 ... NKJV

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was face-to-face with God, and the Word was God.


