THE IMPERATIVE OF LOVE

JOHN 14:1-6

14 “Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. ² In My Father’s house are many mansions; if *it were not so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. ³ And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, *there* you may be also.

Heaven: How do I get there?

- Heaven is a prepared place for prepared people
- Are you prepared to go? - Bible says you can know for certain
- What do I need to do in order to know for certain I am prepared?
- The answer is easy as A-B-C. ... A-Accept, B-Believe, C-Confess

- **CONFESS:**

- That you are a sinner, in need of God's forgiveness.
- Romans 3:23 ... for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

- **BELIEVE:**

- That Jesus is God's son, sent to die for (take away) your sins.
- Romans 6:23 ... For the wages of sin /is death, but the gift of God /is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
- Romans 5:8 ... But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.

- **ACCEPT:**

- Jesus' death and resurrection as the sacrifice for your sins, and relinquish control of your life.
- Romans 10:9 ... that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

Close in Prayer

- **Sinner's Prayer** .. *{Close our eyes, bow our heads and hearts}*
 - Father I thank-you for who you are, and for what you've done
 - I thank you for sending Jesus to seek and to save us
 - I thank you for sending the Holy Spirit to guide and keep us.
 - I pray now for those who do not know you as Savior and Lord
 - I pray that they would repeat the words of the following prayer - in their hearts
-
- *"Father God, I confess that I am a sinner in need of a Savior*
 - *I believe that You sent Jesus, Your son, to die for me on the cross*
 - *I believe that You raised Him from the dead*
 - *I accept Your offer of pardon for my sins - Your offer of salvation*
 - *I accept You as the Lord of my life - I relinquish control to the Holy Spirit*
 - *I pray that You will challenge me and change me to be more like Your Son and my Savior - Jesus the Christ ... In whose name I pray" --- AMEN*

- IF you've prayed that prayer for the 1st time THEN welcome to the Family of God
 - Heaven is now prepared for you ... Your Eternity is fixed ... Sealed for all time.
