THE WHOLE ARMOR OF GOD

EPHESIANS 6:10-18

10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints— ... NKJV



Armor Elements & Spiritual Truth

ELEMENT	RESOURCE	REVIEW
Belt	Тпитн	All body armor hinges to the Belt; Jesus is the Truth; Holy Spirit of Truth
Breastplate	RIGHTEOUSNESS	Breastplate protects the heart - the seat of affections; God's righteousness is imputed;
Shoes	GOSPEL OF PEACE	Shoes protect the legs and feet; Shoes provide stability; Gospel of peace provides confidence in God's promises. Gospel of peace provides security in our reconciliation.
Shield	FAITH	Shield was the maneuverable part of the armor. Believer's Shield capable of quenching ALL the fiery darts. Shield can be used in unison.
Helmet	SALVATION	Helmet is fitted for the protection of the head and mind. Protection from the enemy's schemes (lies) is rooted in an understanding of Salvation itself. All three members of the Trinity contribute to your salvation.
Sword	THE SPIRIT	Sword may be used for both defensive and offensive purposes. The Sword is the Word of God. Effective sword handling require training and practice.



- After all the elements of Armor have been "put on" or "taken up"
 - The believer needs "marching orders"
- Prayer is the means of communications between the believing soldier and our High Commander - God Almighty
 - God is our commanding officer.
 - We receive our commands by...

Military Communications

- The earliest military communications were delivered by humans on foot or horse.
- Communications progressed to visual and audible signals, and then advanced into the electronic age.

Signals

- The first distinctive tactics of military communications were called "signals".
- Modern units specializing in these tactics are usually designated as "signal corps".


Type of Communication ... Duplex

Duplex

A duplex communication system is a point-to-point system composed of two connected parties or devices that can communicate with one another in both directions.

There are two types of duplex communication systems:

full-duplex and half-duplex.



- Type of Communication ... Duplex
 - Half-Duplex

In a **half-duplex** system, in contrast, each party can communicate to the other, but **not simultaneously**; the communication is one direction at a time. An example of a half-duplex device is a **walkie-talkie** two-way radio that has a "push-to-talk" button

- Type of Communication ... Duplex
 - Full-Duplex

In a **full duplex** system, both parties can communicate to the other **simultaneously**. An example of a full-duplex device is a **telephone**; the parties at both ends of a call can speak and be heard by the other party simultaneously.

- Type of Prayer Communication ... Duplex
 - Spiritual Application

The two parties involved in the communication are...

- 1) God
- 2) The Believer

The actual communication is our Prayer

- 1) Our speaking to God
- 2) God Speaking to Us







- The Attitude of Prayer ... praying always
 - Praying always does not mean that we fold our hands and spend all our time on our knees.
 - It means we should have an attitude or prayer throughout our day.



17 pray without ceasing,
-- 1 Thessalonians 5:17 ... NKJV

- The Attitude of Prayer ... praying always
 - Praying in the Spirit means ...
 - We do not recite meaningless prayers.
 - We depend on God' guidance for what we should pray for. ... Romans 5:26-27



²⁶ Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. ²⁷ Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit *is,* because He makes intercession for the saints according to *the will of* God. --- Romans 5:26-27 ... NKJV




- The Attitude of Prayer ... praying always


- The Scope of Prayer ... with all prayer and supplication
 - Prayer
 - Refers to **general** requests
 - Supplication
 - Refers to **specific** requests

⁶ Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;
⁷ and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

--- Philippians 4:6-7 ... NKJV

The Fervency of Prayer ... with all perseverance and supplication

- Fervency
 - Does not mean that we have to work ourselves up to a fever pitch every time we pray.
 - It refers to the principle of perseverance in our supplications.
 - Persistence ... Matthew 7:7-8
 - Continually Ask
 - Continually Seek
 - Continually Knock

7 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. 8 For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it will be opened.

--- Matthew 7:7-8 ... NKJV

The **present imperative** tense used for the verbs in these verses. This implies that the asking, seeking, and knocking are all described as **continuous actions**, and this implies that prayer to be effective should also be a continual habit, rather than an occasional plea.

- The Fervency of Prayer ... with all perseverance and supplication
 - Fervency ... An Example

Parable of the Persistent Widow

18 Then He spoke a parable to them, that men always ought to pray and not lose heart, ² saying: "There was in a certain city a judge who did not fear God nor regard man. ³ Now there was a widow in that city; and she came to him, saying, 'Get justice for me from my adversary.' ⁴ And he would not for a while; but afterward he said within himself, 'Though I do not fear God nor regard man, ⁵ yet because this widow troubles me I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me."

⁶ Then the Lord said, "Hear what the unjust judge said. ⁷ And shall God not avenge His own elect who cry out day and night to Him, though He bears long with them? ⁸ I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"
