



#### Book of Jude

  - Beginning of the Church Age Acts of the Apostles
  - End of the Church Age Acts of the Apostates



- Jude is the only book devoted entirely to the great apostasy.

#### Jude - OVERVIEW



#### Book of Jude

• Apostasy (Greek - apostosia):

**Apostasy** is the formal disaffiliation from, or abandonment or renunciation of, a religion by a person. One who commits apostasy (or who **apostatizes**) is known as an **apostate**.








- FROM: Jude
  - Jude is Greek for Hebrew name Judas
  - Popular name in the time of Jesus
- Bondservant of Jesus Christ
  - Same word in Rev 1:1 "to show His servants..."
- Brother of James
  - James was head of the church in Jerusalem
  - Author of the Epistle of James
  - Both James and Jude were Jesus' step-brothers
  - Neither were among the 12 disciples
    - They did not believe at first ... John 7:5

<sup>5</sup> For even His brothers did not believe in Him. --- John 7:5 ... NKJV










- To: True Believers

  - Not getting the punishment we deserve




- Peace ... Directed inward






## Jude's Objective for the Epistle

- To exhort believers to contend earnestly for the faith!
  - Exhort (verb) = *Paraclete* (noun): comforter
- Faith: more inclusive, in this context, than just "salvation" or "gospel"
- Fight to keep the true faith that was once delivered to you








#### The Threat

- Why must we contend for the faith?
  - There are Tares among the Wheat Matthew 1:24-30
  - False Brethren have Stolen into the Church Galatians 2:4-5
  - · Saints are in Peril
    - 2 Corinthians 11:26
  - Latter Times: Doctrines of Demons
    - 1 Timothy 4:1,6








- Three Characteristics of Apostates
  - 1. Ungodly .... Cain
  - Perverters of Grace ... Balaam
  - 3. Denier of God's Appointed Leader ... Korah




- Israel ..... verse 5 Saved Men

THE CENTRAL THEME FOR ALL THREE EXAMPLES IS APOSTASY!

#### ISRAEL: THE LESSON

God **reserves the right to destroy** those that become guilty of certain forms of **unbelief**, or other sins to which unbelief leads.








## Angels that Sinned - Three Views

#	VIEW	DESCRIPTION
1	Unknowable	We are not intended to know any more than what is in this brief statement.
		The problem with this view is that it stands between verses 5 and 7: all three verses draw upon the familiar Old Testament truths.
2	Lucifer's Fall	Angels having to do with the fall of Lucifer Isaiah 14:12-17; Ezekiel 28:12-19
3	Nephilim	Genesis 6:1-4: LXX: <i>B'nai Elohim</i> = "Angels of God."  Mentioned four times in the OT (Job 1:6; 2:1; 38:7).








#### Nephilim

- Genesis 6 indicates that the "sons of God" (B'nai Elohim) took wives of the "daughters of men," which gave birth to the "Nephilim."
- What on earth was going on?
- The B'nai Elohim is a term that refers to angels. It occurs four times in the Old Testament and is rendered "Angels of God" in the ancient Septuagint translation.








#### Nephilim

- The intrusion of certain angels into the human family resulted in unnatural offspring termed Nephilim, which derives from the Hebrew naphal (to fall), or the Fallen Ones.
- The Greek Septuagint renders this term gigantes, which actually means "earthborn."
- This is often misunderstood to mean "giants"— which they also happen to have been.








- Angels that Sinned The Apostate Lesson
  - Scripture warns against meddling with the spirit world. [Mediums, séances, fortune tellers, etc.]
  - The punishment which overtook the angels that sinned emphasizes the serious nature of apostasy: beings of a higher order than ours have been hurled down into a dark place of confinement where they have remained for thousands of years.
  - God has not changed His attitude toward them;
     time has not mitigated the seriousness of their sin.
  - False teachers are pre-written into condemnation.







- Sodom & Gomorrah Third Example
  - The Dead Sea is 1286 ft below sea level.
  - It is the terminus of the Jordan River and is 40 miles long, 10 miles wide.
  - Its northern segment is very deep—1400 ft in places; the southern segment (10 miles long) is only 10-20 ft deep.
  - It now covers the "Valley of Siddim" (Genesis 14:3,8,10) in which five cities existed: Sodom, Gomorrah,
     Zoar, Admah, and Zeboim.
  - They were very prosperous; over one million tombs discovered.




- Sodom & Gomorrah Unsaved Men
  - What was going on spiritually in Sodom and Gomorrah?

Romans 1:18-32






- Sodom & Gomorrah Apostasy Lesson
  - Apostasy begins with intellectual doubts; it's certain to end with physical degradation.
  - Sodom and Gomorrah are mentioned in connection with apostasy, therefore they once had knowledge of the truth!
  - It was only 450 years since the Flood; Shem (Noah's son) still walked the earth, having 50 years left before him.








- Likewise also these dreamers
  - The three marks of these apostate dreamers
    - 1. Defile the Flesh
      - Walking after their own lusts 2 Peter 3:3
      - Renewed outbreak of ancient sins Romans 1:18-32
        - » They once knew God–failed to glorify Him–vain in their reasoning–hearts darkened.
        - » God gives them up to uncleanness, vile affections, a reprobate mind
    - 2. Reject Authority
    - 3. Speak Evil of Dignitaries





      - Every knee shall bend Philippians 2:9-11






      - Satan = "Accuser of the Brethren" Revelation 12:10

The ultimate dignitary is Our Lord Jesus Christ









# Michael vs Satan Over the Body of Moses

- A curious fact: It is almost impossible to find a sermon or article on this strange dispute between the chief of the holy angels and the chief of the wicked spirits.
- Railing judgment is important enough to merit further illustration!
  - Two mighty angels once disputed over the body of a creature of a lower order than they:
    - the angel who was faithful to his Creator said nothing against his evil opponent...
    - even though he himself was doing the work of God in obedience to a divine command, and...
    - even though the Devil who opposed him was seeking to thwart God's purposes!

# Michael vs Satan Over the Body of Moses

 There are over 500 Old Testament references to Moses - only one refers to his body.


<sup>5</sup> So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD. <sup>6</sup> And He buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, opposite Beth Peor; but no one knows his grave to this day. --- Deuteronomy 34:5-6 ... NKJV

# Why did God Himself bury Moses?

Why is the place of the sepulcher kept secret?
Why is Satan interested in the body of man...this man?
Why is Michael dispatched to oppose?

- One possible reason: God did not want the body of Moses to be worshipped.
- Can you think of any other reasons?









#### Like Creatures Without Reason

- One thought linking verses 8-10 is Railing against Dignitaries
- The archangel, although dealing with Satan himself, and possessing a more perfect knowledge than ours, dared not to speak in judgment.
- An apostate does not hesitate to speak out in condemnation concerning matters about which he does not know enough to make him a judge over others.
- The apostate limits himself to mere natural knowledge, rails at the truth, and finally perished eternally in his own corruption
