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


Lesson Preview - Introduction



Preview ... Comforting Hope


PREMILLENNIAL

- Relates to the timing of the 2ND COMING OF JESUS
- Reference Point is the 1000 year reign of Christ
 - Before the 1000 years .. Premillennial
 - AFTER the 1000 years Postmillennial
 - No 1000 years AMILLENNIAL

Some today are PAN-MILLENNIAL...

Not really taking a position - just banking on everything "panning out" in the end.






COVENANT THEOLOGY

COVENANT THEOLOGY looks at the Scriptures through the grid of the covenant. COVENANT THEOLOGY defines two overriding covenants: the covenant of works (CW) and the covenant of grace (CG). A third covenant is sometimes mentioned; namely, the covenant of redemption (CR). The important thing to keep in mind is that all of the various covenants described in Scripture (e.g., the covenants made with Noah, Abraham, Moses, David and the New Covenant) are out workings of either the covenant of works or the covenant of grace.

- DISPENSATIONALISM is an evangelical futurist interpretive system for understanding the overall flow of the Bible. It sees Biblical history as deliberately divided by God into defined periods or ages to each of which God has allotted distinctive administrative principles.
- "DISPENSATION" (Greek: *oikonomia*): "An administration of affairs, a stewardship, a mode of dealing" (as "the Obama administration" or "Household management").
- Each age in the plan of God is thus administered in a certain way, and man is held responsible as a steward under God during that time.
- Each DISPENSATION is marked by a clear cycle.
 - God reveals Himself and His truth to humanity in a new way.
 - Humanity is held responsible to conform to that revelation.
 - Humanity rebels and fails the test.
 - God judges humanity and introduces a new period of probation under a new administration.





Lesson Preview - Introduction



- Before the MILLENNIAL kingdom,
 - Jesus would leave and go to heaven;
 - He would prepare a place for them in heaven;
 - He would come back to receive them unto Himself.
 - He would take them to glory before He set up His kingdom on the earth.

Note: It was a promise to the church that the Holy Spirit would take up residence in them and that a specific place was reserved for them! separate from their return to the Earth (Zechariah 12, 14:4-9).

- The early Christians were looking for some to be taken home without dying. The Thessalonians were not concerned about their salvation, nor that Christ would be coming for them. They knew that there were a number of resurrections.
 - They called their burial places koimeteria, dormitories; cemeteries.

If the LITERAL SENSE makes COMMON SENSE, seek no OTHER SENSE; or you'll end up with NONSENSE.



RESURRECTION AND THE SADDUCEES?

- Reunion Of The Saints Don't Be Ignorant
 - The Thessalonian believers were concerned for their fellow believers who had died in the Lord.
 - Apparently there was some concern that those believers who had died would miss the RAPTURE and associated victory and blessings of Jesus' return.
 - Paul addresses their concern and intends to provide comfort and hope as well.
 - Paul starts out with a declaration that he does not want the Thessalonians to be IGNORANT.
 - IGNORANT : agnoeō (äg-no-e'-ō): understand not
 - Basis for "AGNOSTIC" ... Latin: Ignoramus
 - Paul makes this plea in his other letters
 - Don't be IGNORANT about God's plan for Israel (Romans 11:25).
 - 2. Don't be IGNORANT about spiritual gifts (1 Corinthians 12:1).
 - 3. Don't be IGNORANT about suffering and trials in the Christian life (2 Corinthians 1:8).
 - Don't be IGNORANT about the RAPTURE and the second coming of Jesus (1 Thessalonians 4:13).

AS CHRISTIANS, WE MAY MOURN THE DEATH OF OTHER BELIEVERS; BUT NOT AS OTHERS WHO HAVE NO HOPE.

OUR SORROW IS LIKE THE SADNESS OF SEEING SOMEONE OFF ON A LONG TRIP, KNOWING YOU WILL SEE THEM AGAIN BUT NOT FOR A LONG TIME.

• Reunion Of The Saints - Don't Be Ignorant

- THOSE WHO HAVE FALLEN ASLEEP
 - This phrase is a euphemism for those who have died.
 - Even in our culture we use the idea of sleep to represent death, e.g. "eternal rest", "rest in peace", etc.
 - The "THOSE" here in this verse refers to believers.
 - It is the body that sleeps and not the soul.
 - The doctrine of soul sleep, *i.e.*, the soul goes to sleep at death, is an unscriptural viewpoint.
- Those who sleep in Jesus
 - These are believers whose spirits are now in the presence of Jesus (2 Corinthians 5:8) Philippians 1:21-24)
 - The bodies of these believers have the appearance of sleep in the grave.

⁸ We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord. ---2 Corinthians 5:8 ... NKJV

⁸ Finally, there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give to me on that Day, and not to me only but also to all who have loved His appearing. --2 Timothy 4:8

Reunion Of The Saints - Don't Be Ignorant

- How certain is your hope?
 - It depends upon your certainty concerning the death and resurrection of Christ. His resurrection is God's seal and evidence for ours.
 - We are confident because Jesus lives and our union with Him is stronger than death. (Romans 8:38-39)
 - Our resurrection hope is in Jesus.

²⁰ But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* has become the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. ²¹ For since by man *came* death, by Man also *came* the resurrection of the dead. ²² For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. ²³ But each one in his own order: Christ the first fruits, afterward those *who are* Christ's at His coming. --- 1 Corinthians 15:20-23 ... NKJV





PROPER CHRISTIAN ANTICIPATION INCLUDES THE IMMINENT RETURN OF CHRIST.

Coming Of The Lord - The Rapture

- BY THE WORD OF THE LORD
 - Paul emphasized that this was an authoritative command, though we do not know whether Paul received it by direct revelation or if it was an unrecorded saying of Jesus.
 - One way or another, this came from Jesus and did not originate with Paul.
- WILL BY NO MEANS PRECEDE
 - Those who died in Christ would not be at a disadvantage when the Lord returns.

"The living will have no advantage over those fallen asleep; they will not meet the returning Christ ahead of the dead, nor will they have any precedence in the blessedness at His coming."

ARE YOU ALIVE AND REMAINING IN CHRIST?

Coming Of The Lord - The Rapture



- Notice the dead in Christ rise 1st, followed by we who are ALIVE and REMAIN
 - Not just ALIVE, but ALIVE and REMAIN
 - Believers in Christ, expecting His return (remaining in Him)

WE DO NOT NEED TO WORRY ABOUT OUR LOVED ONES WHO HAVE DIED IN THE LORD

- Coming Of The Lord The Rapture
 - The question WAS NOT:
 - Is the Lord coming?
 - Are we going to be with Him?
 - The question WAS:
 - What is going to happen to our loved ones who have preceded us in death?
 - The answer is:
 - The dead in Christ will be raised first.
 - Just before we who are alive and remain.
 - All believers will go to see the Lord.







WE WILL MEET THE LORD IN THE AIR - SIGNIFYING THE VICTORY OVER THE CURRENT RULER OF THE AIR - SATAN.

-EPHESIANS 2:2-

- Caught Up Together Comfort One Another
 - CAUGHT UP harpazō (här-pä'-zō): to seize; snatch away
 - In the ancient *Greek*, the phrase to meet was used as a technical term to describe the official welcoming of honored guests.
 - This passage is the basis for the New Testament doctrine
 of the RAPTURE, the catching away of believers to be with
 Jesus. The word RAPTURE is not in the ancient Greek text,
 but comes from the Latin Vulgate, which translates the
 phrase CAUGHT UP with rapturus, from which we get our
 English word RAPTURE.
 - Paul's statement, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, is both dramatic and fantastic. He speaks of believers flying upward, CAUGHT UP ... IN THE CLOUDS TO MEET THE LORD IN THE AIR.
 - We wouldn't believe this unless the Bible told us it were so, not any more than we would believe that God who became a Baby, that He did miracles, that He died on a cross and He lives in us.



17 Then we who are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we shall always be with the Lord. 18 Therefore comfort one another with these words.

Supporters of the different "CAUGHT UP" positions believe their position is supported by Scripture.

There are good Christian scholars in each of the camps We should not divide over this issue.

Caught Up Together - Comfort One Another

- CAUGHT UP harpazō (här-pä'-zō): to seize; snatch away
 - Paul's language here is so straightforward and free from figurative speech that there is no missing his intent.
 - Paul's plain language leaves no doubt regarding the certainty of this event.
 - However, the timing of this event in the chronology of God's prophetic plan is a matter of significant debate among Christians.
 - The debate about this CATCHING AWAY centers on where it fits in with this final seven-year period, popularly known as the Great Tribulation (Matthew 24:21... Olivet Discourse).
- The PRE-TRIBULATION rapture position believes believers are CAUGHT UP BEFORE this final seven-year period.
- The MID-TRIBULATION rapture position believes believers are CAUGHT UP IN THE MIDST of this final seven-year period.
- The PRE-WRATH rapture position believes believers are CAUGHT UP at SOME TIME IN THE SECOND HALF of this final seven-year period.
- The POST-TRIBULATION rapture position believes believers are CAUGHT UP AT THE END of this final seven-year period.



- Caught Up Together Comfort One Another
 - CAUGHT UP harpazō (här-pä'-zō): to seize; snatch away
 - The manner in which Jesus will gather us to Himself is impressive. But the main point is that whatever the state of the believer (dead or alive) at the Lord's coming, they will ALWAYS BE WITH THE LORD.
 - This is the great reward of heaven to be with Jesus.
 - Death can't break our unity with Jesus or with other believers. (Romans 8:38-39)









DO YOU FIND THE COMING OF JESUS AT ANY MOMENT COMFORTING?

- Caught Up Together Comfort One Another
 - CAUGHT UP harpazō (här-pä'-zō): to seize; snatch away
 - THEREFORE COMFORT ONE ANOTHER
 - Paul did not instruct the Thessalonian believers to TAKE COMFORT, but to GIVE COMFORT.
 - In the way God works, we always receive COMFORT as we give COMFORT.
 - The truth of the return of Jesus for His people, and the eternal union of Jesus and His people is to be a source of COMFORT for believers.
 - This concluding statement of Paul only makes sense if the CATCHING AWAY of the previous verses actually delivers believers from an impending danger.
 - If the CATCHING AWAY only brings humanity to God for judgment, there is little comfort in these words.


