Genesis 1:1-4 - OBSERVATIONS



1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. ² The earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

³ Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. ⁴ And God saw the light, that *it was* good; and God divided the light from the darkness.

Old Testament Creation Text

- In the Beginning God Created...
- God is Creator of the Universe
 - The Heavens and the Earth
- Trinity Involved
 - Verse 1: God the Father
 - Verse 2: God the Holy Spirit
 - Verse 3: God the Son (the Word)






Gnosticism

- Greek word for "to know"
- Teaching had Two major features
- Salvation was found in a higher, spiritual knowledge. Those who entered into this knowledge were considered "enlightened ones".

Ordinary people, even Christians, did not have this knowledge. They had to get it through mystical ways.

Sound familiar ... "New Age",
"Christian Science"


Gnosticism

Spirit and flesh were thought of as separate entities. Spirit was good: flesh was bad.

The spirit was untouched by fleshly influences, no matter what the flesh did. Therefore, the flesh could sin at will if it desired, and the spirit was unaffected.

Therefore, a Gnostic could live a very immoral lifestyle and still claim to be a spiritual person.






GNOSTICISM - REVIEW



- Docetism ... a form of Gnosticism
 - Docetism was related to Gnosticism.
 - Greek word for "to seem"
 - Docetism taught that it was impossible for God, who was spirit (good), to take on a physical (bad) body, so they assert that Jesus did not have a real physical body, but only *seemed* to have a physical body.









 - Manifested == Revealed | Displayed
 - Revealed to who?
 - The Disciples (we)
 - Revealed how?
 - Seen
 - Bear Witness

 - Eternal Life is Jesus
 - He was with the Father
 - Was manifested to us (disciples)
 - Incarnation

- Eternal Life Manifested to Us
 - Jesus Revealed to the Believer
 - Real Christianity is a personal experience with the Lord Jesus Christ.
 - There is a deadly difference between church membership and salvation—
 - Knowing about Jesus and knowing
 Him are not the same.





Fellowship

- Greek word is Koinonia.
- More than coffee and a donut

Koinonia

fellowship; a close mutual relationship; participation; partnership; communion; fiduciary. Sharing something together.

- Fellowship
 - Fellowship is Two-Dimensional
 - Vertical
 - Our fellowship with the Father and Jesus
 - Horizontal
 - Our fellowship with other believers







Fellowship

- You can not join the family of God
 - John 1:10-13 ... you must receive Him
 - John 3:3 ... you must be born again

10 He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. 11 He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. 12 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: 13 who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. --- John 1:10-13 ... NKJV







- Joy is not Happiness.
 - Happiness is derived from external stimuli
 - Joy is experienced internally
 - The satiation of the Spirit
 - Flows from a right relationship with God
 - The true Joy of Reconciliation

The most joyous truth in our hearts is to know that Jesus Christ is our personal Savior, that our home is in heaven, and that we have a special reason for living.


Joy


