

They are Given into Your Hand

Noah' Dominion ... Type of Christ's Dominion (Hebrews 2:6-9)

⁶ But one testified in a certain place, saying:
 "What is man that You are mindful of him,
 Or the son of man that You take care of him?
 ⁷ You have made him a little lower than the angels;
 You have crowned him with glory and honor,
 And set him over the works of Your hands.
 ⁸ You have put all things in subjection under his feet."

For in that He put all in subjection under him, He left nothing *that is* not put under him. But now we do not yet see all things put under him.

⁹ But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone.

- Noah & Sons
 - ✓ Every Moving Thing
 - ✓ Specific Permission to Eat Meat
- Moses & Jewish Law
 - ✓ Mosaic dietary restrictions
- Jesus & the Church (Under Grace)
 - √ Every Creature (1 Timothy 4:4-5) -
 - Peter's Vision (Acts 10:9-16)

29 And God said, "See, I have given you every herb *that* yields seed which *is* on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food.

You Shall Not Eat Flesh with its Life... Blood

- Hard Saying of Jesus (John 6:41-71)
 - ✓ Jesus claims ... "I am the bread which came down from heaven" (v. 41)
 - ✓ Jews murmur amongst themselves
 - ✓ Jesus claims ... "I am the living bread which came down from heaven. If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever; the bread I shall give is My flesh, which I shall give for the life of the world" (v. 51)
 - ✓ Jesus expands His claim ... "unless you eat of the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you" (v. 53)
 - ✓ Jesus continues ... "Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day." (v. 54)
 - ✓ Many of His disciples ... "This is a hard saying; who can understand it?" (v. 60)
 - ✓ "From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more." (v. 66)
 - √ Jesus asks His twelve ... "Do you also want to go away?" (v. 67)
 - ✓ Peter's reply... "To whom shall we go..." (vs. 68-69)

Blood

- Blood was the sign of mercy for Israel at the first Passover (Exodus 12:13)
- Blood sealed God's covenant with Israel (Exodus 24:8)
- Blood sanctified the altar (Exodus 29:12)
- Blood set aside the priests for service (Exodus 29:20)
- Blood made atonement for God's people (Exodus 30:10)
- Blood sealed the new covenant (Matthew 26:28)
- Blood justifies us (Romans 5:9)
- Through blood we have redemption (Ephesians 1:7)
- Through blood we have peace with God (Colossians 1:20)
- Blood cleanses us (Hebrews 9:14, 1 John 1:7)
- By blood we enter God's holy place (Hebrews 10:19)
- By blood we are sanctified (Hebrews 13:12)
- Blood enables us to overcome Satan (Revelation 12:11)
