




<sup>4</sup> Then they journeyed from Mount Hor by the Way of the Red Sea, to go around the land of Edom; and the soul of the people became very discouraged on the way. <sup>5</sup> And the people spoke against God and against Moses: "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For *there is* no food and no water, and our soul loathes this worthless bread." <sup>6</sup> So the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and many of the people of Israel died.

<sup>7</sup> Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, "We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD and against you; pray to the LORD that He take away the serpents from us." So Moses prayed for the people.



#### Two Snakes: The Caduceus of Hermes



The caduceus (\*\*); pron.: /keˈdjuːsiːəs/ or /kəˈdjuːʃəs/; from Greek κηρύκειον kērukeion "herald's staff" ) is the staff carried by Hermes in Greek mythology. The same staff was also borne by heralds in general, for example by Iris, the messenger of Hera. It is a short staff entwined by two serpents, sometimes surmounted by wings. In Roman iconography it was often depicted being carried in the left hand of Mercury, the messenger of the gods, guide of the dead and protector of merchants, shepherds, gamblers, liars, and thieves. #### Two Snakes: The Caduceus of Hermes



The caduceus is often used as a symbol of medicine and medical practice (especially in North America), although there has been historical confusion with the traditional medical symbol, the rod of Asclepius the Caduceus is still in use as a medical establishment symbol. The Rod of Asclepius has only a single snake and no wings, so is similar in form to the caduceus with its two snakes and often with wings.

It is relatively common, especially in the United States, to find the caduceus, with its two snakes and wings, used as a symbol of medicine instead of the correct Rod of Asclepius, with only a single snake. This usage is erroneous, popularised largely as a result of the adoption of the caduceus as its insignia by the U.S. Army Medical Corps in 1902 at the insistence of a single officer (though there are conflicting claims as to whether this was Capt. Frederick P. Reynolds or Col. John R. van Hoff). [20][21]

### One Snake: The Staff of Asclepius



In Greek mythology, the Rod of Asclepius (\$; sometimes also spelled Asklepios or Aesculapius), also known as the asklepian, [1] is a serpent-entwined rod wielded by the Greek god Asclepius, a deity associated with healing and medicine. The symbol has continued to be used in modern times, where it is associated with medicine and health care, yet frequently confused with the staff of the god Hermes, the caduceus. Theories have been proposed about the Greek origin of the symbol and its implications.

#### Ark Moved on the Surface

- Note progression of water
  - ✓ Verse 17 ... waters increased
  - √ Verse 18 ... water prevailed and greatly increased



- √ Verse 19 ... waters prevailed exceedingly
- Ark was a barge
  - √ No propulsion system
  - ✓ God is in control of Ark's movements
  - ✓ Dimensions of Ark
    - 300 cubits x 50 cubits (length x width)
    - 6:1 ratio ... optimal for stability

#### Waters

- Note progression of water

  - √ Verse 19 ... waters prevailed exceedingly





- All High Hills ... Mountains
  - ✓ All ... implies worldwide flood
  - ✓ Mountains ... implies worldwide flood
    - Antediluvian world geologically different than present world
    - Mountains not as high as today
    - Even today mean height of earth is below sea level
- Local versus Worldwide Flood
  - ✓ What do you think? ... Read Psalm 104 Creation Psalm






<sup>20</sup> The waters prevailed fifteen cubits upward, and the mountains were covered.

To estimate the stability of the Ark, one must first determine its draft. The draft is the height that the water comes to along the side of the vessel, measured from its bottom. Dr Morris' calculations assumed a draft of 15 cubits (22.5 feet), which was the depth of the Flood waters over the highest mountains

#### All Flesh Died

- Flesh on the earth

  - ✓ Includes Nephilim & Fallen Angles ("Sons of God")
- Note order listed is the same as creation order (Genesis 1)




