Chapter Preview - Introduction



Preview

The invasion of Jerusalem by the Gentiles is accomplished by the rise of the two witnesses. The scene shifts to the earthly Jerusalem, which is the center stage of the coming conflict with the beast. The witnesses are martyred and then miraculously resurrected.





Before the end of the world, God will send powerful Moses-like and Elijah-like prophets to the ungodly world, which will silence the prophets, but only temporarily. The angelic blowing of the seventh trumpet will herald the consummation of all things.

The Two Witnesses - Revelation 11:1 - OBSERVATIONS



- The Two Witnesses Measure the Temple of God
 - John is given a reed and instructed to measure
 - The temple of God
 - The altar
 - Those who worship there
 - Measuring here means to claim possession of
 - Note the rebuilding of the temple is required for this verse to take place.
 - Temple naos = holy place
 - Not heiron = temple area as a whole
 - Reed rhabdos = staff, a rod of correction
 - Measurement indicates
 - Preamble to judgment ... Jeremiah 31:38-39; Zechariah 2
 - Preamble to destruction ... Lamentations 2:8;
 2 Kings 21:13; Isaiah 34:11; Amos 7:8
 - Measurement in preparation of the Lord's coming to dwell on the Earth

The Two Witnesses - Outer Court Not Measured

- Leave out ekballo = throw out, case out
- The Gentiles have taken over Jerusalem ...
 Luke 21:24 until Zechariah 14:3-4
- The holy city ... Jerusalem
 - No other so designated ... Nehemiah 11:1,18; Isaiah 52:1;
 Daniel 9:24; Matthew 4:5; 27:52-53

42 Months

This is the most documented period of time in the Bible, and more definitely marked for literal interpretation than that which limits the time of future judgment upon the earth preceding the Millennium. 

SOUTHERN CONJECTURE: Dome of the Rock is in the Outer Court, Temple to the south.

- The Two Witnesses Given Power for 1260 Days
 - Why Two Witnesses?
 - Jewish law required two to establish a fact ...
 Deuteronomy 17:6; Matthew 18:16
 - Sackcloth
 - Speaks of the law rather than grace
 - Repentance
 - 1260 Days
 - 3½ years
 - 42 months

- The Two Witnesses 2 Olive Trees, 2 Lampstands
 - Two anointed ones ... Zechariah 4:11-14

11 Then I answered and said to him, "What are these two olive trees —at the right of the lampstand and at its left?"


¹² And I further answered and said to him, "What *are these* two olive branches that *drip* into the receptacles of the two gold pipes from which the golden *oil* drains?"

The Two Witnesses - Fire Breathing

- Anyone who tries to harm God's two witnesses
- Must be killed with fire that proceeds out of their mouths - literally devours their enemies
- One of the clues to the identity of one of the witnesses - well look at this in the next verse.

 - Jews were expecting three ... John 1:20-21

¹⁹ Now this is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, "Who are you?" ²⁰ He confessed, and did not deny, but confessed, "I am not the Christ." ²¹ And they asked him, "What then? Are you Elijah?" He said, "I am not."

- The Witnesses Killed Beast Wars With Them
 - Two witnesses finish their testimony
 - God is in control here and in our lives!
 - Only when you are finished with your testimony will you be called home
 - · We are not earth dwellers
 - · We are sojourners
 - The beast now ascends out of the bottomless pit
 - The beast directs his attack on the two witnesses
 - The beast overcomes them ... [Matthew 16:18 ???]
 - The beast kills them

- The Witnesses Killed Lie Dead in the Street
 - The bodies of the witnesses lay in the street
 - In the great city ...
 - Called Sodom
 - Called Egypt
 - Where our Lord was crucified
 - What great city are we referring to here?
 - Vatican City
 - Babylon
 - New York
 - Carlsbad

The Two Witnesses - Revelation 11:9-10 - OBSERVATIONS



The Witnesses Killed - World Rejoices

- The witnesses' dead bodies are
 - Left in the street for 3½ days
 - 3 days in Jewish law to be legally dead
 - Lazarus ... 4 days
 - Jesus ... 3 days
 - Left for the whole world to see
 - This could only be fulfilled in our day
 - Satellite near real-time TV broadcasting
- The whole world celebrates
 - Rejoice over the death of the two witnesses
 - Make merry
 - Send gifts to one another
- Only celebration on the earth in all of Revelation
 - Satanic Christmas or "Anti-Christmas"

⁹ Then *those* from the peoples, tribes, tongues, and nations will see their dead bodies three-and-ahalf days, and not allow their dead bodies to be put into graves. ¹⁰ And those who dwell on the earth will rejoice over them, make merry, and send gifts to one another, because these two prophets tormented those who dwell on the earth.



The Two Witnesses - Revelation 11:11-12 - OBSERVATIONS



- The Witnesses Resurrected Stand Up
 - After the 3½ days God breathes life into them
 - Reminiscent of God breathing life into Adam
 - Reminiscent of valley of dry bones
 - The dead witnesses' rise to their feet
 - Great fear fell on all who saw them
 - Fox New exclusive
 - God calls them up to heaven in a cloud
 - Slow rise in a cloud
 - Like ascension
 - Not like Rapture twinkling of an eye

GOD IS IN CONTROL OF ALL THE EVENTS
TRANSPIRING ON THE EARTH

11 Now after the threeand-a-half days the breath of life from God entered them, and they stood on their feet, and great fear fell on those who saw them. 12 And they heard a loud voice from heaven saying to them, "Come up here." And they ascended to heaven in a cloud, and their enemies saw them.

The Two Witnesses - Revelation 11:13 - OBSERVATIONS



- The Witnesses Resurrected Great Earthquake
 - In the same hour the witnesses are ascended
 - There is a great earthquake
 - A great earthquake occurred when the 6th seal was opened ... Revelation 6:12
 - A greater one when the 7th bowl is poured out ...
 Revelation16:18-20
 - The greatest fault line on the earth runs east of Jerusalem down the Jordan called the Great Rift Valley, running underneath the Dead Sea into Africa.
 - 1/10 of the city is destroyed
 - 7000 people are killed
 - The rest were afraid and gave glory to God of heaven



The Two Witnesses - Revelation 11:14 - OBSERVATIONS



- The Witnesses Resurrected 2nd Woe Passes
 - The 2nd woe is past The 3rd woe is coming quickly
 - This ends the parenthetical section between 6th 7th trumpets.
 - Opens up the Seven Personalities in Chapters 12 & 13.
 - All this was part of the "2nd Woe!"
 - The 3rd Woe (the 7th Trumpet Judgment) will bring the final Seven Bowl Judgments.

Seventh Trumpet - Trumpet Sounds

- The 7th angel sounds the 7th Trumpet
- The choir breaks out into Handel's Messiah
 - "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ and He shall reign forever and ever!"
- In the Greek the word (basileia) translated Kingdoms
- Is actually singular Kingdom
- Should read ...
 - "The kingdom of this world have become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ and He shall reign forever and ever!"
- Satan currently has the world under his control ...
 Matthew 4:8-9; 12:26; John 12:31; 14:30; 16:11
- This is an announcement of victory.
 - Satan had offered a shortcut ... Matthew 4:8-9
 - Jesus did it the way the Father wanted it done.

- Seventh Trumpet 24 Elders React
 - The Twenty-four elders react as before
 - Fall on their faces and worship God
 - This should be our reaction as well
 - The kingdom has a new King His name is Jesus
 - Long live the King Forever and ever

- Seventh Trumpet God is Worshiped
 - Twenty-four elders acclamation of praise (17-18)
 - Christ reigns supremely ... Verse 17
 - He judges righteously ... Verse 18
 - He rewards graciously ... Verse 18
 - Elders worshipped the Creator ... Revelation 4:10-11
 - Elders worshipped the Redeemer ... Revelation 5:9-14
 - Here, the emphasis is on the Conqueror and King.

¹⁷ saying:

"We give You thanks, O Lord God Almighty, The One who is and who was and who is to come, Because You have taken Your great power and reigned. ¹⁸ The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, And the time of the dead, that they should be judged, And that You should reward Your servants the prophets and the saints, And those who fear Your name, small and great, And should destroy those who destroy the earth."




Seventh Trumpet - Temple Opened in Heaven

- The temple of God is now opened in heaven
- The ark of the covenant is seen in the temple
 - The "original" Ark has always been there.
 - The one on the earth was but a replica (Hebrews 9:23).
 - It is the view of some that the Mercy Seat will be the very throne that Christ will reign from.
