THE WHOLE ARMOR OF GOD

EPHESIANS 6:10-18

10 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. 11 Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. 12 For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. 13 Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. 14 Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, 15 and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; 16 above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. 17 And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; 18 praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints— ... NKJV



Armor Elements & Spiritual Truth

ELEMENT	RESOURCE	REVIEW
Belt	Тпитн	All body armor hinges to the Belt; Jesus is the Truth; Holy Spirit of Truth
Breastplate	RIGHTEOUSNESS	Breastplate protects the heart - the seat of affections; God's righteousness is imputed;
Shoes	GOSPEL OF PEACE	Shoes protect the legs and feet; Shoes provide stability; Gospel of peace provides confidence in God's promises. Gospel of peace provides security in our reconciliation.
Shield	FAITH	Shield was the maneuverable part of the armor. Believer's Shield capable of quenching ALL the fiery darts. Shield can be used in unison.
Helmet	SALVATION	Helmet is fitted for the protection of the head and mind. Protection from the enemy's schemes (lies) is rooted in an understanding of Salvation itself. All three members of the Trinity contribute to your salvation.
Sword	THE SPIRIT	COVERED IN THIS LESSON

Sword of the Spirit - Idiom Explained



17 and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God --- Ephesians 6:17B ... NKJV

- The Sword of the Spirit
 - The sword of the Spirit pictures an offensive and defensive use of the Bible in spiritual warfare!
- Purpose of taking the sword...
 - To counter enemy sword attacks and to harm or kill your enemy.



- A familiar idiom
 - Hebrews 4:12

12 For the word of God *is* living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

--- Hebrews 4:12 ... NKJV

Sword of the Spirit - Idiom Explained

Machaira - Greek sword

The Roman soldier sword was short and double bladed.

By it Rome conquered the world.

Blacksmiths hardened the blade of the sword by covering the red-hot iron with coal dust; the coal dust formed a hard carbon coating on the blade.

Sword handles could be made from iron, ivory, bone, or wood.



Sword of the Spirit - Idiom Explained



17 and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God --- Ephesians 6:17B ... NKJV

Machaira - Greek sword

Improvement over the larger single bladed *Gladius* - "two handed" sword.

Advantage of the shorted, double bladed sword in close up engagements.

The key was in the training and practice.

It is not obvious how to exploit the advantages of the sword without training and practice.

With proper training and practice, victory was almost certainly guaranteed.



 - By applying scripture to every doubt, temptation and discouragement hurled at us by the enemy.




- The Sword is used Offensively...

Word of God

The Bible uses **two** different words for the Word of God.

One is *logos*, which refers to the collection of words embodying the whole body of God's revealed truth - in this context ... the Bible.

The other word is *rhema*, the word used in this verse. Rhema often refers to specific, individual words.

When we get involved in spiritual combat, we do not appeal to the entire Bible; we use specific, relevant passages - specific words of God.


Logos

Ancient philosophers used the term in different ways.

The sophists used the term to mean discourse.

Aristotle applied the term to refer to "reasoned discourse" or "the argument" in the field of rhetoric.

The Stoic philosophers identified the term with the divine animating principle pervading the Universe.


Logos

The Gospel of John identifies the Logos, through which all things are made, as divine (*theos*).

The Gospel of John identifies **Jesus** as the incarnate Logos.

1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made.

14 And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. --- John 1:1-3,14 ... NKJV







Rhema

The Greek word *rhema* is useful to distinguish between two meanings of *word*.

While both *rhema* and *logos* are translated into the English *word*, in the original Greek there was a substantial distinction.





Logos & Rhema ... Septuagint Usage

The Septuagint translation of the Hebrew Bible into Greek uses the terms Rhema and Logos as equivalents and uses both for the Hebrew word Dabar, as the Word of God.


Logos & Rhema ... Modern Usage

Distinguishes Rhema from Logos in Christian Theology.

Logos is the "Word of God" Jesus Christ, the subject from Genesis to Revelation.

Rhema is the revealed word of God, as an utterance from God to the heart of the receiver via the Holy Spirit.

John 14:26



²⁶ But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all things that I said to you.



Logos & Rhema ... Modern Usage

Logos refers to Christ.

Rhema at times called "spoken word," referring to the revelation received by disciples when the Holy Spirit "speaks" to them.

Romans 10:17-18	"But it is in that way faith comes, from hearing, and that means hearing the word (rhematos) of Christ. Well then, I say, is it possible that they have not heard? Indeed they have: in the entire earth their voice stands out, their message (rhemata) reaches the whole world."
