
## Chapter Preview - Introduction



#### Preview

The Revelation now takes us on to its grand conclusion: the eternal state. We are introduced to a "new heaven" and a "new earth". Next, we see the "New Jerusalem" - the Bride of Christ. Finally, all the struggles of earth are over and the glory of God is with redeemed mankind. This is a brand new universe. It is "paradise restored!"





## Chapter Preview - Introduction



### Heaven As A Final Destination - Some Metrics

Although the lifestyles, values, and self-perceptions of most adults have undergone significant changes — and millions have embraced many elements of a postmodern worldview, the majority continues to believe that there is life after death, that everyone has a soul, and that Heaven and Hell probably do exist.

Yet, over 50 million Americans are uncertain about their personal fate: Nearly 3/3 of Americans believe they will go to Heaven. One in 4 admitted they have no idea what will happen after they die. Less that 1/2 of 1% expect to go to Hell upon their death. One in 20 believe they will come back as another life form (5%). The same proportion believe they will simply cease to exist.

## • New Heaven - New Earth

John sees ...

In John's day, the sea meant danger, storms, separation - he was on an island at the time!

- The new heaven
- The new earth ... The first earth passed away
- There is no more sea ... Not needed -

<sup>7</sup> But the heavens and the earth *which* are now preserved by the same word, are reserved for fire until the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. <sup>8</sup> But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. <sup>9</sup> The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. 10 But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night, in which the heavens will pass away with a great noise, and the elements will melt with fervent heat; both the earth and the works that are in it will be burned up. 11 Therefore, since all these things will be dissolved, what manner of persons ought you to be in holy conduct and godliness, 12 looking for and hastening the coming of the day of God, because of which the heavens will be dissolved, being on fire, and the elements will melt with fervent heat? 13 Nevertheless we, according to His promise, look for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells.

#### New Jerusalem - From God

- John sees the New Jerusalem ...
  - Coming down out of heaven from God
  - Prepared as a bride adorned for her husband
    - Wife prepared ... Revelation 19:6-8

<sup>6</sup> And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! <sup>7</sup> Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready." <sup>8</sup> And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. --- Revelation 19:6-8 ... NKJV

 Heaven is a prepared place (John 14) for a prepared people (John 3)

    - Implies there is crying before new heavens and earth
  - There shall be no more ...
    - death
    - sorrow
    - crying
    - pain

## Former Things

- The former things have passed way
  - No more crying in the new heavens and earth

    - This includes you as a new creation

#### The New Jerusalem - Revelation 21:9-11 - OBSERVATIONS



- The Bride The Lamb's Wife... Holy Jerusalem
  - One of Bowl Angels speaks with John
  - Tell him to come and he will show him
    - The Bride
    - The Lamb's Wife

True Church of Jesus Christ

- Carries John away in the Spirit (Time and Space)
  - To a great and high mountain
  - Shown the great city, the holy Jerusalem
    - Descending out of heaven from God
    - · Having the glory of God
    - Her light was like a most precious stone
    - Like a jasper stone Clear as crystal
- Contrast and Compare:
  - Holy Jerusalem with the Harlot Mystery Babylon a False bride (both a city and a woman)
  - The citizens are identified with the city Revelation 22:3, 6, 19

<sup>9</sup> Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife." 10 And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God, <sup>11</sup> having the glory of God. ## Great High Wall - With Twelve Gates

- The Great Holy City New Jerusalem has ...
  - A Great High Wall with Twelve Gates
  - Twelve Angels at the Gates (Assume 1 per Gate)
  - Names of the Twelve Tribes of Israel on the Gates
    - Three Gates on the East .... (Assume 1 Tribe per Gate)
    - Three Gates on the North ... (Assume 1 Tribe per Gate)
    - Three Gates on the South ... (Assume 1 Tribe per Gate)
    - Three Gates on the West ... (Assume 1 Tribe per Gate)

#### Twelve Tribes


- A perpetual reminder that "salvation is of the Jews."
- Access to the city is through Israel.
- Suggests the order of Israel's encampment around the Tabernacle in Numbers 2.
- Israel on the earth will enjoy the same relationship to the city that they did toward the wilderness tabernacle, and later, the temple (Song 8:5).
- Notice that Peter isn't guarding any of the Gates!



## City Wall - Twelve Foundations

- The Wall of the City has
  - Twelve Foundations
  - On the Foundations were the Names of the Twelve Apostles of the Lamb (Assume 1 Apostle per Foundation)
  - Apostles are the Foundation Who are the 12?
  - Christ is the Chief Cornerstone.

Psalm 118:22; Matthew 21:42; Mark 12:10; Luke 20:17; Acts 4:11; 1 Peter 2:4-10

<sup>4</sup> Coming to Him *as to* a living stone, rejected indeed by men, but chosen by God *and* precious, <sup>5</sup> you also, as living stones, are being built up a spiritual house, a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. <sup>6</sup> Therefore it is also contained in the Scripture, "Behold, I lay in Zion A chief cornerstone, elect, precious, And he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame." <sup>7</sup> Therefore, to you who believe, *He is* precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone," <sup>8</sup> and "A stone of stumbling And a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed. <sup>9</sup> But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; <sup>10</sup> who once *were* not a people but *are* now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

#### The New Jerusalem - Revelation 21:15-17 - OBSERVATIONS



- Golden Reed To Measure the City
  - John see the angel speaking to him has a gold reed
  - To measure
    - The City
    - The City's Gates
    - The City's Wall
  - The city is laid out as a square
    - Length: 12,000 furlongs
    - Breadth: 12,000 furlongs
    - Height: 12,000 furlongs
  - The wall
    - Height: 144 cubits

John was told to measure the old city (Rev 11).

Angel now measures the new city.

Is city a cube? Or a Pyramid?



1 furlong = 600 feet; 1 mile = 5280 feet City = (12,000 furlongs x 600 feet) / 5280 City = 1364 miles

**1** cubit = **18** inches; **1** foot = **12** inches

**Wall** =  $(18 \times 144) / 12 = 216$  Feet

<sup>15</sup> And he who talked with me had a gold reed to measure the city, its gates, and its wall. 16 The city is laid out as a square; its length is as great as its breadth. And he measured the city with the reed: twelve thousand furlongs. Its length, breadth, and height are equal. <sup>17</sup> Then he measured its wall: one hundred *and* forty-four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of an angel.







#### The New Jerusalem - Revelation 21:21 - OBSERVATIONS



- Construction Of The Gates & the City Street
  - The City's Twelve Gates
    - Twelve Pearls ... One Pearl per Gate
  - The City's Street was Pure Gold
    - Like transparent glass
  - Pearls are not "kosher"
    - Parable of the Pearl of Great Price ... Matthew 13:45-46
    - They come from the sea not the land
    - They grow in response to an external irritation
    - They grow by accretion
    - They are removed from their place of growth to become an item of adornment

21 The twelve gates were twelve pearls: each individual gate was of one pearl. And the street of the city was pure gold, like transparent glass.

### Glory of the New Jerusalem - Revelation 21:22-25 - OBSERVATIONS



- City Has No Temple
  - John observes ...
    - There is no Temple in the city ... because
      - The Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its Temple.
    - The City has no Need of the Sun or Moon ... because
      - The Glory of God Illuminates it.
      - The Lamb is its light
    - The nations of the saved walk in its light (Lamb)
    - Kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it
       -- apparently there will be kings on the new earth
    - The Gates will never be shut ... because
      - There is no night there
      - · The Lamb is the protector of the city
      - During John's day city's would close their gates at night for the protection of the city

<sup>22</sup> But I saw no temple in it, for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are its temple. <sup>23</sup> The city had no need of the sun or of the moon to shine in it, for the glory of God illuminated it. The Lamb *is* its light. <sup>24</sup> And the nations of those who are saved shall walk in its light, and the kings of the earth bring their glory and honor into it. <sup>25</sup> Its gates shall not be shut at all by day (there shall be no night there).

### Glory of the New Jerusalem - Revelation 21:26-27 - OBSERVATIONS



- Residents of the City The Saved Only
  - The Kings bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it
  - Those who are excluded from the city include ...
    - Anything that defiles
    - Anything that causes an abomination
    - Anything that causes a lie
  - Those excluded include ...
    - The unsaved
    - The fallen angels
    - The dead Nephilim (demons)
  - The residents of the city are only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.


ARE YOU IN THE LAMB'S BOOK OF LIFE?

<sup>26</sup> And they shall bring the glory and the honor of the nations into it. <sup>27</sup> But there shall by no means enter it anything that defiles, or causes an abomination or a lie, but only those who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.
