


Lesson Preview - Introduction



Preview ... Inspiring Hope

Paul, Silas and Timothy send greetings to the believers in Thessalonica. Paul refers to the position of the Thessalonians in God and Jesus Christ and desires both grace and peace for them. Paul stresses his thankfulness to God for the Thessalonians for turning to God from idols, for maintaining their faith in the face of severe affliction, and lastly for expectantly waiting for the second coming of Jesus Christ.









1 Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus

- Greetings To the Church of the Thessalonians
 - Epistle opens in the typical letter format of the time

FROM: Paul Silvanus and Timothy

TO: The believers in the Thessalonian church in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ

SALUTATION: Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

- PROFILE: Silvanus or Silas
 - Paul always refers to him as Silvanus (Roman)
 - Name means "god of the woods"
 - Luke always refers to him as Silas
 - A respected leader of the Jerusalem council (Acts 15:22)
 - A prophet (Acts 15:32)
 - A Roman citizen (Acts 16:37)
 - Fitting co-worker for Paul and Preacher (2 Corinthians 1:19)
 - Scribe for 1 Peter (1 Peter 5:12)

Greetings - 1 Thessalonians 1:1 - OBSERVATIONS



1 Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

--- 1 Thessalonians 1:1 ... NKJV

Notice Paul does not refer to himself as an apostle ...

Why do you think that is?

God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ ... On the same level ...

Co-equal

• Greetings - To the Church of the Thessalonians

- PROFILE: Timotheos (Greek) or Timothy
 - Name means "honoring God"
 - Half-Jewish; half Greek
 - Co-salutation in 5 of Paul's epistles
 - Protégé of Paul
- CHURCH: Ekklesia
 - Translated "church"
 - Means "Called out assembly"
 - Never a building!

A congregation of believers that God has called out of the world - set apart to serve Him.



- "In God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ."
 - Not Spatially But Positionally
 - Out of the World and into God!

1 Paul, Silvanus, and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ:
Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

--- 1 Thessalonians 1:1 ... NKJV

Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore *you* on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. ²¹ For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

-- 2 Corinthians 5:20-21 ... NKJV

Lord Jesus Christ

- Lord: kyrios a lord, master, sovereign
- Jesus: *lesous* a Savior, Joshua, Jesus
- Christ: Christos anointed one, Christ, Messiah

Grace

- charis favor, acceptance
- God's Riches At Christ's Expense

Peace

- eirene peace, tranquility
- shalom (Hebrew) peace, prosperity, well being
- Not just the absence of war
- A sense of inner tranquility and well-being from being reconciled to God through Christ





• Gratitude - Thanks to God

- "We" here refers to Paul, Silas and Timothy
- They express thanksgiving to God for the Thessalonian believers - directed to God
- The Thessalonian believers are remembered in the prayers of Paul, Silas and Timothy ... Corporate prayer
- From Paul's epistles we know that Paul had an extensive prayer list - believers that he prayed for



Do you think Paul was a busy person?

YET HE MADE PRAYER A PRIORITY!

What can we learn from Paul's example?

16 Rejoice always, 17 pray without ceasing, 18 in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

--- 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 ... NKJV

15 For all things *are* for your sakes, that grace, having spread through the many, may cause thanksgiving to abound to the glory of God.

--- 2 Corinthians 4:15 ... NKJV

for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God.

We all know 1 Corinthians 13.

- Gratitude The Grounds for Thanksgiving
 - · Remember without ceasing
 - Another way of saying "Never forgetting"
 - What is never forgotten?
 - The Thessalonian believers':

- Work of Faith
- Labor of Love
- Patience of Hope

Faith looks back to a Crucified Savior.

Love looks up to a Crowned Savior.

Hope looks forward to a Coming Savior

- Faith versus Works
 - Works replace with "fruit" ... The Fruit of Faith
- Labor of Love
 - Labor: kopos wearisome labor, toil to exhaustion
 - Love: agape love, unconditional love
- Patience of Hope
 - Patience: hypomone steadfastness, patiently waiting
 - Hope: elpis expectation, the object of hope, trust, confidence

• Gratitude - For Election by God

- Beloved Brethren
 - As Believers we are born into our relationship.
 - Born again we become sons of God ... John 1:11-12

¹¹ He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him. ¹² But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name: ¹³ who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. --- John 1:11-13 ... NKJV

HAVE YOU RECEIVED HIM?

- Election
 - Our election is by God
 - Not by our works

⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; *it is* the gift of God, ⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast. ¹⁰ For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them. --- Ephesians 2:8-10 ... NKJV

• Gratitude - For Election by God





- Election
 - Love and Election are Connected ... 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14

¹³ But we are bound to give thanks to God always for you, brethren beloved by the Lord, because God from the beginning chose you for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and belief in the truth, ¹⁴ to which He called you by our gospel, for the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. --- 2 Thessalonians 2:13-14 ... NKJV

- God has chosen you before the foundations of the world
- You are His plan A God does not have plan B's

⁴ just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love,

--- Ephesians 1:4 ... NKJV

Election protects us from thinking of **salvation** as dependent on human whims and roots it squarely in the **will of God**. Left to ourselves, we do not wish to leave our state of untroubled sinfulness.





- Gospel Power Not In Word Only
 - The Gospel was transmitted to the Thessalonians in
 - Word: Jesus is the Word
 - Power: The Father is the Power
 - The Holy Spirit: Trinity Member
 - Much assurance: In the Character
 - Of Paul, Silas & Timothy

Gospel came by the God in the form of the Trinity and faithful witnesses

What is the Gospel?

15 Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, ² by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you—unless you believed in vain. ³ For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, ⁴ and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures, ⁵ and that He was seen by Cephas, then by the twelve. ⁶ After that He was seen by over five hundred brethren at once, of whom the greater part remain to the present, but some have fallen asleep. ⁷ After that He was seen by James, then by all the apostles. ⁸ Then last of all He was seen by me also, as by one born out of due time.

--- 1 Corinthians 15:1-8 ... NKJV

Gospel Power - 1 Thessalonians 1:6 - OBSERVATIONS



For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake.

6 And you became followers of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit,
7 so that you became examples to all in Macedonia and Achaia who believe.

--- 1 Thessalonians 1:5-7 ... NKJV

Gospel Power - Eternal Perspective

- Follower of us
 - Committed to the teaching Paul, Silas & Timothy
 - Committed to following the Lord Jesus Christ
- Received the word
 - In much affliction in the face of severe persecution
 - With joy of the Holy Spirit *supernatural joy*

outward *man* is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. ¹⁷ For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding *and* eternal weight of glory, ¹⁸ while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal. --- 2 Corinthians 4:16-18 ... NKJV

Do you have an eternal perspective? Even when afflicted?

Gospel Power - Example to Others

- The example of the Thessalonian believers spread to all believers in ...
 - Achaia Roman Province in Southern Greece
 - MacedoniaRoman Province in Northern Greece
- Example

typos:

the mark left by a blow, as when a die strikes an image on a coin; an impress, mark, a model pattern, a moral pattern

Gospel Power - 1 Thessalonians 1:8 - OBSERVATIONS



8 For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place. Your faith toward God has gone out, so that we do not need to say anything.

Sounded forth

-- 1 Thessalonians 1:8 ... NKJV

execheo:

To make to sound forth Derived from echos - a loud noise

- Gospel Power Spread Abroad
 - Gospel was not restricted to Macedonia and Achaia but spread throughout the Roman Empire.
 - Strategic location of Thessalonica





Gospel Power - 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 - OBSERVATIONS



⁹ For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, 10 and to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead, even Jesus who delivers us from the wrath to come.

--- 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10 ... NKJV

Gospel Power - True Conversion


- Turned from Idols
 - A radical change
 - What is an idol?

WHAT ARE YOUR IDOLS?

- Anything that comes between you and God
- True Conversion involves

Paradigm

- 1. Turn Salvation event
- 2. Serve Sanctification process
- 3. Wait Glorification event and process
- Second coming of Christ : Parousia
 - Mentioned at the end of every chapter
- Wrath to come
 - Wrath is the holy revulsion of God against that which is a contradiction of His holiness
 - Jesus delivers us completely out of the reach of future judgment - Jesus as Blessed Hope!


