


Lesson Preview - Introduction



Preview ... Blessed Hope: Part III

Paul encourages the believers at Thessalonica to remember God's choice of them through the sanctification of the Holy Spirit obtaining the glory of the Lord Jesus Christ. In addition, Paul urges the Thessalonians to stand firm on proper teaching. He then prays that the Lord Jesus Christ Himself and God the Father will comfort their hearts and establish them in every good word and work. These verses have been called "a system of theology in miniature"; a comprehensive statement of God's saving purposes.



- Chosen for Salvation Bound to Give Thanks
 - But we are bound to give thanks
 - Paul echoes his conviction from 2 Thessalonians 1:3, that
 - he was bound (obligated; in debt) to thank God for His work in the Thessalonian believers,
 - in light of the greatness of that work.

³ We are bound to thank God always for you, brethren, as it is fitting, because your faith grows exceedingly, and the love of every one of you all abounds toward each other,

Chosen for Salvation - Brethren

- Brethren Beloved By the Lord
 - Paul is addressing believers BRETHREN.
 - Paul is first thankful that they are BELOVED BY THE LORD.
 - God's love for us is the primary motivation for all His work in and through us.
- BECAUSE GOD FROM THE BEGINNING CHOSE YOU FOR SALVATION
 - Paul also praises the sovereign choice of God in bringing them to salvation.
 - God's choice was FROM THE BEGINNING.
 - Before they chose God, He CHOSE them, and He chose them FOR SALVATION THROUGH SANCTIFICATION.

Our salvation did not originate in human choice. God willed our salvation long before we ever came into existence (Ephesians 1:3-6). This divine choice was based on divine love and divine determination.

SANCTIFICATION IS A PROCESS!

- Chosen for Salvation Sanctification
 - SALVATION THROUGH SANCTIFICATION
 - The two go together.
 - Those who claim to be chosen but lack evidence of sanctification (separation from the world and unto God) are on shaky ground.
 - We can't see if a person is chosen, but we can see if they are sanctified.



PAST: JUSTIFICATION - Saved from the PENALTY of Sin

PRESENT: SANCTIFICATION - Saved from the Power of Sin

FUTURE: GLORIFICATION - Saved from the PRESENCE of Sin

HOW DO WE KNOW THE HOLY SPIRIT LOVES US?

- Chosen for Salvation Spirit and Truth
 - BY THE **SPIRIT** AND BELIEF IN THE TRUTH
 - God's work of SANCTIFICATION uses two great forces,
 - 1. THE SPIRIT and
 - 2. the BELIEF IN THE TRUTH.
 - The Spirit of God and the word of God are essential to our SALVATION THROUGH SANCTIFICATION.

THE WORK OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

⁷ Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you. ⁸ And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment: ⁹ of sin, because they do not believe in Me; ¹⁰ of righteousness, because I go to My Father and you see Me no more; ¹¹ of judgment, because the ruler of this world is judged.

--- John 16:7-11 ... NKJV

- Chosen for Salvation Obtaining the Glory
 - To which He called you by our gospel
 - The call for this salvation comes through the GOSPEL,
 - The GOSPEL Paul preached
 - GOSPEL: good news

² Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. - 1 John 3:2

- 1 Corinthians 1:23 ... we preach Christ crucified
- 1 Corinthians 15:1-4 ... death, burial, resurrection
- The GOSPEL that will enable us to obtain the glory of Jesus.
 - THE GREAT EXCHANGE ... 2 Corinthians 5:21

²¹ For He made Him who knew no sin *to be* sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.







Stand Fast - Traditions

- THEREFORE, BRETHREN, STAND FAST
 - THEREFORE WHAT IS IT THERE FOR?
 - Paul is encouraging the Thessalonian believers to consider what he has written up to this point.
 - Paul has given them compelling reasons why they must
 STAND FAST and not be moved. Same admonition for us!
 - STAND FAST because of...
 - THE CURRENT DISTRESS; the persecutions and tribulations ...
 2 Thessalonians 1:4.
 - THE COMING JUDGMENT OF THIS WORLD; in flaming fire taking vengeance ... 2 Thessalonians 1:8.
 - THE STRENGTH OF COMING DECEPTION; all power, signs, and lying wonders ... 2 Thessalonians 2:9.
 - OUR GLORIOUS DESTINY; the glory of our Lord Jesus ...
 2 Thessalonians 2:14.









- Stand Fast Traditions
 - STAND FAST AND HOLD THE TRADITIONS
 - The command to STAND FAST tells us WHAT they must STAND FAST upon.
 - They must keep standing on God's word,
 - Delivered both by
 - 1. The authoritative word of the apostles (BY WORD)
 - The letters of the apostles (OUR EPISTLE).









• Stand Fast - Traditions

- STAND FAST AND HOLD THE TRADITIONS
 - Scripture recognizes that TRADITIONS can be a dangerous feature of religious systems (Matthew 15:2-3) or the TRADITIONS of man (Colossians 2:8).
 - However, Paul has in mind the apostolic traditions preserved for us in the record of the New Testament.

TRADITIONS	παράδοσις
paradosis	pä-rä'-do-sēs
A giving over which is done by word of mouth or in writing:	

A giving over which is done by word of mouth or in writing; tradition by instruction, narrative, precept, etc.

ONLY THE ANCHOR OF GOD'S WORD ENABLES US TO STAND FAST UNDER THE WEIGHT OF OUR PRESENT TRIBULATION, AND THE WEIGHT OF OUR COMING GLORY.



Prayer of Comfort - 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17 - OBSERVATIONS




Jesus Christ Himself, and our God and Father, who has loved us and given us everlasting consolation and good hope by grace, 17 comfort your hearts and establish you in every good word and work.

--- 2 Thessalonians 2:16-17... NKJV



- Prayer of Comfort The Deity of Christ
 - Our Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and Our God and Father
 - Paul refers to Jesus and the Father as co-equals in
 - Giving us EVERLASTING CONSOLATION
 - Giving us GOOD HOPE BY GRACE
 - Comforting our HEARTS
 - Establishing us in EVERY GOOD WORD AND WORK
 - Paul is making the case for the deity of Jesus
 - Reminiscent of Creation ... John 1, Genesis 1



• Prayer of Comfort - God's Love

- WHO HAS LOVED US
 - Before asking God to do something specific for the Thessalonians (v17),
 - Paul remembered all that God had done for them (v16).
 - God LOVED them
 - God gave them EVERLASTING CONSOLATION
 - God gave them GOOD HOPE BY GRACE.

When we pray we should remember God's PAST FAITHFULNESS and PRESENT BLESSING.

His FAITHFULNESS in the PAST is a PROMISE of His FAITHFULNESS for the FUTURE.

• Prayer of Comfort - Establish You

- **COMFORT** YOUR HEARTS AND **ESTABLISH** YOU
 - Paul asked God to DO TWO THINGS in the Thessalonian believers.
 - FIRST, he wanted God to COMFORT their HEARTS.
 - SECOND, he asked God to ESTABLISH them IN EVERY GOOD WORD AND WORK.
 - This prayer for comfort and continued testimony and work for Jesus is fitting in light of the special needs of believers under pressure.

"I believe in an established Church, not established by acts of Parliament but stablished by the purpose and by the presence of God in the midst of it." ... Spurgeon



- IN EVERY GOOD WORD AND WORK
 - Every Good Word AND Work.
 - Not just some but ALL (EVERY).
 - Not just one or the other but BOTH.
 - Our actions must align with our words (testimony).
 James 1: 22
 - Who is responsible for ESTABLISHING YOU IN EVERY GOOD WORD AND WORK?
 - Aren't you glad it is not you!

¹² Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; ¹³ for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for *His* good pleasure.

-- Philippian 2:12-13 ... NKJV


