- Daniel is Grieved in his spirit and his body
  - The visions shook him to his core
  - He is deeply troubled by the fourth beast in particular
    - ✓ He could not describe this beast with an animal or animal combination idiom.
      - As he did with the other beasts
        - » Lion with Eagles wings ...... Babylon
        - » Bear ..... Persia
        - » Leopard with Four Wings ... Greece
    - √ In verses 16 and 19 he will ask for more information
  - What was it about this fourth beast that troubled Daniel so?
    - ✓ The destructive nature of this beast
      - Before Rome (some 200 years in the future here) the strategy of kings
        - » Conquer peoples, languages and nations
        - » Use the resource (people and treasures) available of those conquered
          - » Nebuchadnezzar, Cyrus the Great, Alexander the Great

- Daniel is Grieved in his spirit and his body
  - Body
    - ✓ Translated from the word for "sheath" ... like a sword holder
    - ✓ Container for the spirit and soul
  - Troubled
    - ✓ Like Nebuchadnezzar ... Daniel 2:1; Daniel 4:4-5

**2** Now in the second year of Nebuchadnezzar's reign, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams; and his spirit was *so* troubled that his sleep left him.

- Daniel asks for help
  - Asked him the truth of all this
    - √ Who is "him"?
      - "One of those who stood by"
      - One of the "thousand thousands that ministered" to God ... Verse 10
      - An angel
  - So he told me and made known to me the interpretation of these things
    - ✓ Daniel receives the interpretation from this angel
    - ✓ Previously Daniel was able to interpret Nebuchadnezzar's dreams and visions
      - Daniel chapter 2 ... Multi-metal image vision
      - Daniel chapter 4 ... Great tree image vision
    - ✓ Daniel is unable to interpret his own visions
      - Daniel chapter 7 ... Beasts from the sea vision
      - Daniel chapter 8 ... He Goat and the Ram vision



17 Those great beasts, which are four, are four kings which arise out of the earth.

- The beasts are four kings which arise out of the earth
  - The four kings are kingdoms or empires
  - Kings represent the kingdoms
    - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar ...... Babylon

Kings and Their Kingdoms

- ✓ Cyrus the Great ..... Persia
- ✓ Alexander the Great ... Greece
- ✓ Antichrist (little horn).... Final Earthly Kingdom (not final Kingdom on Earth)
- Arise out of the earth
  - ✓ Note that in verses 2-3 the beasts came **out the sea**
  - ✓ Here the beasts arise out of the earth
  - ✓ Sea idiom for sea of humanity

<sup>2</sup> Daniel spoke, saying, "I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea. <sup>3</sup> And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other.

- Daniel encourages his readers by keeping the end in mind
  - ✓ A good idea for us as well
  - √ When confronted with "Great Beasts" in our life
    - Let that trigger us to search the scriptures
    - Scriptures that speak of our relationship with Christ

      » John 14:1-31

      » John 15:1-27

      » John 17:20-26

      » Revelations 20-21

      Small Sample of Verses
- In particular that even though the Great Beasts arise out of the earth
- Daniel encourages the saints will receive / possess the forever kingdom

Saints ... Receive the Kingdom

- Pre-Millennial, Pre-Tribulation View
- Who are the Saints of the Most High?
  - ✓ All Saints
    - Old Testament Saints ... Believing Jews
    - New Testament Saints ... Church believers You and me
    - Tribulation Saints ... Those saved after the rapture (end of church age)
  - ✓ We are now living in the
    - "times of the Gentile" ......... Nebuchadnezzar to the "little horn" King
    - "fullness of the Gentiles" .... Church age (Pentecost to Rapture)
  - ✓ At the start of the Great Tribulation
    - Time of "Jacob's Trouble"
    - God will deal with the nation of Israel once more
    - Final seven years of Daniel's 490 year prophecy (chapter 9)

- Saints ... Receive the Kingdom
  - Receive the Kingdom
    - ✓ Received from whom?
      - Most High ... God!
    - ✓ Revelation 5:1-6
      - Compare with Daniel 7:13-14-

**5** And I saw in the right *hand* of Him who sat on the throne a scroll written inside and on the back, sealed with seven seals. <sup>2</sup> Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, "Who is worthy to open the scroll and to loose its seals?" <sup>3</sup> And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll, or to look at it. <sup>4</sup> So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it. <sup>5</sup> But one of the elders said to me, "Do not weep.   - Daniel did not have problems understanding the first three beasts
    - √ Why do you think that is?
  - Different from all the others



- Exceedingly dreadful
- Teeth of iron
- Nails of bronze
- Devoured
- Broke in pieces
- Trampled the residue
- 10 horns
- Little horn

#### Fourth Beast ... Daniel 7:7-8

<sup>7</sup> "After this I saw in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, dreadful and terrible, exceedingly strong. It had huge iron teeth; it was devouring, breaking in pieces, and trampling the residue with its feet. It was different from all the beasts that were before it, and it had ten horns. <sup>8</sup> I was considering the horns, and there was another horn, a little one, coming up among them, before whom three of the first horns were plucked out by the roots. And there, in this horn, were eyes like the eyes of a man, and a mouth speaking pompous words.



<sup>20</sup> and the ten horns that *were* on its head, and the other *horn* which came up, before which three fell, namely, that horn which had eyes and a mouth which spoke pompous words, whose appearance *was* greater than his fellows.

#### Little Horn

- Separate from the ten horns eleventh horn
  - ✓ Starts out small ("little") diminutive power
  - ✓ Rises such that his appearance is greater than his fellows.
- Comes up from among the ten horns
  - ✓ Removes three horns from the original ten horns
  - ✓ Told originally... by the roots
    - By roots implies will not grow again
    - These three kings (leaders) will be removed
      - » Never to return (rise to power) again



<sup>20</sup> and the ten horns that *were* on its head, and the **other** *horn* which came up, before which **three fell**, namely, that **horn** which had **eyes** and a **mouth** which spoke pompous words, whose appearance *was* greater than his fellows.

#### Little Horn

- Pointless to speculate on who the antichrist (little horn) is
  - ✓ We do not know enough now to make a rational, reasonable revelation.
  - ✓ What we do know...
    - He will not arrive on the scene until the ten horns are established
    - The number of his name is 666
    - Possessed by Satan himself
      - » Part of unholy trinity
        - » Satan .....God the Father
        - » Antichrist ...... God the Son (Jesus Christ)
        - » False Prophet .... God the Holy Spirit
    - His nature is pure evil ... typified by others through history
      - » Antiochus Epiphanies ... we'll see more of him in later chapters
      - » Adolf Hitler

- Ancient of Days makes a judgment in favor of the saints
  - Until

Pre-Millennial, Pre-Tribulation View

- ✓ There is a time limit on the little horn prevailing against the Saints
- √ How long?
  - **42 Months** ... 3 ½ years ... 1260 days
  - Revelation 13:5
- · Ancient of Days makes a judgment
  - ✓ Court of Heaven renders it's decision
  - ✓ In favor of the saints

<sup>5</sup> And he was given a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months.

- Revelation 13:5 ... NKJV

GOD IS SOVEREIGN!

- Time came for Saints to possess the kingdom
  - ✓ God's decision goes in favor of the saints and against the Little Horn
  - ✓ At the end of the Great Tribulation
    - Little Horn (antichrist) and False Prophet thrown into lake of fire (Revelation 19:19-21)
    - Satan bound for 1000 years after which he will join them in the fire (Revelation 20:1-3)



<sup>23</sup> "Thus he said: 'The fourth beast shall be A fourth kingdom on earth, Which shall be different from all *other* kingdoms, And shall devour the whole earth, Trample it and break it in pieces.

- Fourth Beast is the fourth Kingdom on earth
  - Who is speaking here?
    - ✓ The angel from verse 16 continues with the interpretation
  - Different from the other kingdoms
    - ✓ Shall devour the whole earth
      - Other kingdoms were vast but limited in scope
      - This fourth kingdom will devour the whole earth
    - ✓ Shall Trample it (the whole earth)
    - ✓ Shall break it (the whole earth) in pieces



<sup>24</sup> The ten horns *are* ten kings *Who* shall arise from this kingdom. And another shall rise after them; He shall be different from the first *ones*, And shall subdue three kings.

- The ten horns ... plus one ... minus three
  - The ten horns are ten kings
    - ✓ Track with the ten toes in the Multi-metal image of chapter 2
  - The ten kings arise from this last kingdom
    - ✓ The Little Horn arises after the 10 kings
      - He shall be different from the first **10** kings
        - » How is the Little Horn different?
          - » He is indwelt by Satan himself
          - » He accepts what Jesus refused
            - » Wilderness Temptation of Christ ... Matthew 4; Mark 1
            - » All the kingdoms of the world for worship
              - » Jesus does not challenge Satan's ownership claim
              - » Jesus challenges and refuses Satan's proposition
      - He shall subdue three of these first 10 kings
      - This leaves 8 kings ... [10 + 1 3 = 8]

10 Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, "You shall worship the LORD your God, and Him only you shall serve."





  - The Great Tribulation
    - ✓ Matthew 24:21-22
    - ✓ Mark 13:14-23

- Shall intend to change times and laws
  - Notice the Little Horn intends to change times and law
    - ✓ He does not actually accomplish what he intends
    - √ Why does he fail?
      - He is attempting to overthrow God's authority
        - » God will not allow it


