 - He sets the expectation for his "wise men" Chaldeans
 - He wants to know the dream
 - ✓ Notice the word dream here is singular
 - √ Targets a particular dream
 - ✓ Presumably his last dream


- Chaldeans Response to the Kings Opening Statement
 - Language Transition
 - ✓ From Hebrew to Aramaic
 - Starting with "O king, ..."
 - ✓ Text will remain in Aramaic until the end of Chapter 7
 - Then transition back to Hebrew.
 - Tell Us the Dream, and We Will Give the Interpretation
 - ✓ Given the dream, giving the interpretation would be easy for them.
 - ✓ This response worked with the father.
 - Standard practice.
 - ✓ Expecting this response to work for the son.

⁵ The king answered and said to the Chaldeans, "My decision is firm: if you do not make known the dream to me, and its interpretation, you shall be cut in pieces, and your houses shall be made an ash heap.

- Nebuchadnezzar Clarifies His Position
 - My Decision is Firm
 - ✓ King Nebuchadnezzar will not be swayed.
 - What is the Decision?
 - ✓ To make known both the dream and its interpretation.
 - ✓ Decision was a test of the skills and trustworthiness of his "wise men".
 - What are the Decision's Consequences?
 - ✓ You will be cut to pieces.
 - ✓ Your houses will be made an ash heap (dunghill KJV).
 - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar was an absolute monarch known for his ruthless acts.
 - Put eyes out of captured enemies. [2 Kings 25:1-7]
 - Known to roast his officers over an open flame for poor performance.

Daniel 2:6 - Observations



⁶ However, if you tell the dream and its interpretation, you shall receive from me gifts, rewards, and great honor. Therefore tell me the dream and its interpretation."

- Nebuchadnezzar Clarifies His Position
 - What is the Decision's Compensation?
 - ✓ Receive gifts.
 - ✓ Receive rewards.
 - ✓ Receive great honor.
 - Reiterates His Decision
 - ✓ Tell me the dream and its interpretation.

Daniel 2:7 - Observations



⁷They answered again and said, "Let the king tell his servants the dream, and we will give its interpretation."

Chaldeans Reiterate Their Position

- Hope to sway the King's firm decision
 - √ Tell me (King) the Dream
 - ✓ AND its Interpretation.
- Their position
 - ✓ Tell us (Chaldeans) the dream
 - ✓ THEN we (Chaldeans) will give its interpretation

Daniel 2:8 - Observations



⁸ The king answered and said, "I know for certain that you would gain time, because you see that my decision is firm:

- Nebuchadnezzar Will Not be Swayed
 - The king calls out the Chaldeans for stalling.
 - The king reiterates that his decision is firm.

Daniel 2:9 - Observations



⁹ if you do not make known the dream to me, *there is only* one **decree** for you! For you have agreed to **speak lying** and **corrupt words** before me till the time has changed. Therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that you can give me its interpretation."

- Nebuchadnezzar Threatens the Chaldeans
 - The King is getting heated not a good thing for the Chaldeans
 - What is the Conditional Decree? ... from verse 5
 - ✓ CONDITION:
 - IF Chaldeans do not make known the dream (not just interpretation)
 - ✓ DFCRFF
 - You will be cut to pieces.
 - Your houses will be made an ash heap (dunghill KJV).
 - The King's Justification for the Decree.
 - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar charges Chaldeans with
 - Speaking lying words
 - Speaking corrupting words

Daniel 2:9 - Observations



⁹ if you do not make known the dream to me, *there is only* one decree for you! For you have agreed to speak lying and corrupt words before me till the time has changed. Therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that you can give me its interpretation."

- Nebuchadnezzar Threatens the Chaldeans
 - The King's Verification Method.
 - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar version of "Trust but Verify"
 - Tell me the dream
 - SO I shall know that you can give me its interpretation
 - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar does not trust the Chaldeans
 - Suspects that if he tells them the dream
 - They will concoct an interpretation

Daniel 2:9 - Observations



⁹ if you do not make known the dream to me, *there is only* one decree for you! For you have agreed to speak lying and corrupt words before me till the time has changed. Therefore tell me the dream, and I shall know that you can give me its interpretation."

- Nebuchadnezzar's Test for the Chaldeans Tell me the Dream
 - I believe that he remembered his dream (some translations suggest otherwise)
 - AND that he feigned not remembering it in order to test the Chaldeans
 - AND that the Chaldeans knew or at least suspected this
 - ✓ IF Nebuchadnezzar did not remember the dream
 - ✓ THEN
 - Chaldeans could have just made one up then
 - Looking up the dream elements in their Sigmund Freud book on Dreams
 - They could created a cleaver interpretation
 - ✓ ELSE (Nebuchadnezzar did remember his dream)
 - Just making one up would
 - Reveal to the King their inabilities
 - They would FAIL the Verification Test
 - And this would lead to their destruction



10 The Chaldeans answered the king, and said, "There is not a man on earth who can tell the king's matter; therefore no king, lord, or ruler has *ever* asked such things of any magician, astrologer, or Chaldean.

Chaldeans Are Outraged

- What the King asks is impossible
 - ✓ There is not a man on earth who can do what the king is asking.
 - This much is true.
 - Later we will see Daniel support this claim
- No other King has ever made such a request
 - ✓ Precisely because the request is impossible.
 - ✓ A subtle swipe at the young King Nebuchadnezzar
 - Condescendingly saying in effect...
 - » "Maybe you do not know this since you are such a young ruler.
 You need to listen to us your older and more sage advisors."
 - » OR ...

"This is not how its done son."

The Chaldeans know they are in trouble

Daniel 2:11 - Observations



¹¹ It is a difficult thing that the king requests, and there is no other who can tell it to the king except the gods, whose dwelling is not with flesh."


- Chaldeans Continue Try to Justify Their Position
 - Went from impossible to "difficult thing"
 - No man can satisfy the king's request only the gods
 - √ 1st part of their statement about no man is correct
 - Daniel will state this as well
 - √ 2nd part of their statement about the gods do not dwell with man
 - Hint of Jesus' incarnation which was still in the future here
 - » Jesus does come to dwell among us
 - ✓ Attempt to save their own skins.
 - Wait a Minute ... I can imagine Nebuchadnezzar's response
 - ✓ Aren't you supposed to be in contact with the gods?
 - They may not dwell with men, but you are the ones who supposedly communicate with them
 - ✓ So why can't you satisfy my request?
 - Communicate with the gods and ask them to reveal my dream
 - IF you are not able to do so THEN I must conclude that you are frauds

Nebuchadnezzar is Outraged

- Nebuchadnezzar becomes incensed
 - ✓ The King was angry and very furious
- Chaldeans Failed the Test
 - ✓ Since the "wise men" cannot tell Nebuchadnezzar his dream
 - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar concludes that the Chaldeans are Charlatans
 - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar will make good on his earlier threats ... from verse 5
 - You will be cut to pieces.
 - Your houses will be made an ash heap (dunghill KJV).
 - ✓ Notice how impulsive Nebuchadnezzar is...
 - He gave the command to destroy all the "wise men" of Babylon
 - This rash decision will not help with the interpretation of his dream
 - Can be characterized as a "temper tantrum" that put all the "wise men" on death row.



¹³ So the decree went out, and they began killing the wise *men*; and they sought Daniel and his companions, to kill *them*.

- Let the Executions Begin
 - The decree went out
 - They began killing the wise men
 - Daniel and his companions were caught in the dragnet
 - ✓ Daniel and his companions were a part of the "wise men" by job description
 - ✓ Daniel and his companions were now on Death Row
 - Again scholars are divided on the exact timing of this event
 - ✓ Was it while Daniel and his companions were in training?
 - ✓ Was is just after Daniel and his companions completed their training?
 - In either case
 - ✓ Daniel and his companions were targeted for execution

Daniel 2:14 - Observations



14 Then with counsel and wisdom Daniel answered Arioch, the captain of the king's guard, who had gone out to kill the wise *men* of Babylon;

- Daniel Speaks with the Captain of the King's Guard Arioch
 - Arioch is the captain of the kings guard.
 - Arioch is the captain of the execution guard.
 - Arioch confronts Daniel apparently to kill him.
 - Daniel's interaction with Arioch is characterized as
 - ✓ With Counsel
 - ✓ With Wisdom
 - ✓ The opposite of Nebuchadnezzar's reaction to the Chaldeans failed test
 - Not explicitly stated but strongly implied ...
 - ✓ Daniel's counsel and wisdom is from God.
 - ✓ Daniel finds favor with Arioch.
 - God is in-control of the situation.
 - ✓ Under-current throughout the Book of Daniel

Arioch means
"Royal" or "Fierce Lion"
in Hebrew

Daniel 2:15 - Observations



¹⁵ he answered and said to Arioch the king's captain, "Why is the decree from the king so urgent?" Then Arioch made the decision known to Daniel.

- Daniel Questions the King's Captain Arioch
 - Daniel asks, why the rush to execution, why such a rash decision.
 - Arioch fills Daniel in on ...
 - ✓ What transpired between Nebuchadnezzar and the Chaldeans.
 - ✓ How Nebuchadnezzar lost his cool
 - ✓ Obviously Daniel was not present during the exchange.

Daniel 2:16 - Observations



¹⁶ So Daniel went in and asked the king to give him time, that he might tell the king the interpretation.

Daniel Speaks with Nebuchadnezzar

- Daniel finds favor with the King
 - ✓ Could have been executed on the spot
 - ✓ Suggests that Daniel has already had some interaction with the King
 - One of the arguments use to support the position that Daniel and his companions have already graduated from their "Nebu U training"
- Daniel requests more time
 - ✓ To satisfy the king's request to make known the dream and its interpretation.
 - ✓ Again Daniel finds favor
 - Chaldeans had just been scolded by Nebuchadnezzar for this same tactic (stalling for time)
- God is in-control -Sovereignty of God
 - ✓ Undergirding all the accounts in the Book of Daniel

Daniel Calls a Prayer Meeting at His House

- Daniel's fist act is to inform his companions
 - ✓ make known the decision known to Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah
- Daniel has a Plan
 - ✓ To seek mercies from the God of heaven concerning this secret
 - ✓ Secret? ... Nebuchadnezzar's Dream and Its Interpretation
- The Purpose of Daniel's Plan
 - ✓ That Daniel and his companions might not perish with the rest of the wise men
 of Babylon

VOTICE

- ✓ Here Daniel is praying for the results not the means to those results.
- ✓ Later is verse 23 we see that Daniel did ask for the revelation of the secret.
- ✓ Daniel is praying for the Sovereign hand of God to protect him and his friends.

Daniel 2:19 - Observations



¹⁹ Then the secret was revealed to Daniel in a night vision. So Daniel blessed the God of heaven.

God Answers Daniels Prayer

- The secret was revealed to Daniel
 - ✓ It was revealed to Daniel not to his companions
 - √ It was revealed in a night vision
 - ✓ God's means of sparing the lives of Daniel and his companions was to reveal the dream and its interpretation
 - God could have used other means
 - Can you suggest any?
- As a result of the answer to Daniel's prayer (Secret Revealed)
 - ✓ Daniel blessed the God of Heaven.
