


#### Lesson Preview - Introduction



Preview ... Blessed Hope: Part II

The apostle Paul responds to a false message given to the Thessalonian believers, namely that the Day of the Lord's wrath of God - that is, the Great Tribulation period - has already started. Paul asserts that the Great Tribulation cannot begin until a special apostasy occurs and the man of lawlessness (the Antichrist) is revealed. The Antichrist will not arrive on the scene until the Restrainer no longer holds back his appearance.










#### The Local Deception - 2 Thessalonians 2:1 - OBSERVATIONS



2 Now, brethren, concerning the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ and our gathering together to Him, we ask you, <sup>2</sup> not to be soon shaken in mind or troubled, either by spirit or by word or by letter, as if from us, as though the day of Christ had come.
--- 2 Thessalonians 2:1-2... NKJV

The challenge in understanding this chapter comes from the fact that it is a supplement to what Paul has already taught them in words, and we don't know exactly what Paul said to the Thessalonians. Yet the ideas are clear enough if carefully pieced together.

- The Local Deception Rapture Reference
  - BRETHREN: Paul is addressing believers
  - In this chapter Paul addresses questions raised by his first letter, where he taught the Thessalonian believers about the catching away of the church to be with Jesus (1 Thessalonians 4:16-18)
  - CONTEXT: PREMILLENNIAL: PRE-TRIBULATION PERSPECTIVE

- The Local Deception Letter Forgery
  - Apparently, a misunderstanding of Paul's teaching had caused the Thessalonians to be shaken in mind and troubled.
    - Source of misunderstanding FORGED LETTER
  - Here Paul uses a strong wording,
    - A sudden jolt (SHAKEN IN MIND) and
    - A continuing state of upset (TROUBLED).
  - Their fears centered on the idea that the day of Christ had already come.
  - They were already in the Great Tribulation




It is important to notice that the Thessalonians would be shaken or troubled by the thought of being in the Great Tribulation only if they had been taught by Paul that they would escape that period through the rapture. Otherwise they would, in a sense, welcome the Great Tribulation as a necessary prelude to the Second Coming. But Paul had clearly taught them that they would escape God's judgment on this earth during the period known as the day of the Lord or the day of Christ (1 Thessalonians 4:14-18).

### The Local Deception - Letter Forgery

- DAY OF CHRIST: Incorrect translation
  - Kyrios (Lord) versus Christos (Christ)
  - Should be DAY OF THE LORD
    - The traditional Jewish expression for the day when God would intervene in history to destroy His enemies and establish His Kingdom (1000 years).
    - Joel, Zechariah, Isaiah, Amos, Ezekiel, Jeremiah, Malachi, Zephaniah, etc.
  - In that Day ... Time period not a literal day
    - Christ will rule with a rod of iron over the entire earth ...
       Psalm 2:9; Revelation 2:27
    - He will administer absolute justice ... Isaiah 11:1-9
    - Also, Isaiah 11:10-12; Zephaniah 3:14-20.
    - A significant aspect of the day of the Lord is the Great Tribulation described in Matthew 24:1-31.



- The Man of Sin Deception
  - Paul gives a warning against DECEPTION
    - How do we guard against deception?
      - By knowing the truth!
    - 32 And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free."
      --- John 8:32 .. NKJV
- <sup>6</sup> Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me. --- John 14:6 ... NKJV

- The Man of Sin Deception
  - THAT DAY: Refers to the time of the Great Tribulation
  - Before THAT DAY arrives what must happen
    - 1. THE FALLING AWAY ... THE APOSTASY
    - 2. THE MAN OF SIN IS REVEALED ... SON OF PERDITION (ANTICHRIST)

# DAY OF THE LORD - PRECEDENT EVENTS 1. The APOSTASY Must TAKE PLACE 2:3 2. The MAN OF SIN IS REVEALED 2:3 3. The TEMPLE Must Be REBUILT 2:4 4. The RESTRAINER Must Be REMOVED 2:7



- The Man of Sin Deception
  - THE FALLING AWAY: apostasia [ä-po-stä-sē'-ä] apostasy
    - DELIBERATE abandonment of a formerly professed position or view; a DEFECTION; a REJECTION of a former allegiance.
    - Used to denote a political or military rebellion.
    - In the LXX: a rebellion against God ... Joshua 22:22.
    - In New Testament:

Acts 21:21; 1 Timothy 4:1;

2 Timothy 3:1-9; 4:3-4; Hebrews 3:12.

### The Man of Sin - Deception

- THE MAN OF SIN IS REVEALED:
  - Before the Great Tribulation can be identified with certainty, a particular person - known as the man of sin, must be revealed.
  - Paul's point is clear: "You are worried that we are in the Great Tribulation and that you missed the rapture. But you can know that we are not in the Great Tribulation, because we have not yet seen the man of sin revealed."
  - Who is this man of sin?
    - An individual who will come to great prominence in the very last days.
    - This was how it was understood in the earliest days of Christianity.

## • The Man of Sin - Deception

- THE SON OF PERDITION:
  - PERDITION means destruction; complete loss of well-being.
  - It is really the opposite of salvation.
  - To call him the SON OF PERDITION means his character is marked by this destruction.

"The phrase "son of perdition" essentially means the doomed one." ... Moffatt

#### **ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION**

Daniel 9:27; 11:31; 12:11 Matthew 24:15; Mark 13:14 • The Man of Sin - What does he do?

- Who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God or is worshipped:
  - The man of sin demands worship for himself that belongs to God only (Luke 4:8). This demand for worship is also described in Revelation 13:1-6.
  - ALL THAT IS CALLED GOD:
    - Every deity not just the God of Scripture
    - Anything that is worshipped even science
- So that he sits as God in the temple of God:
  - The man of sin's demand for worship will be so extreme, he will set himself up as God in the temple at Jerusalem, demanding this blasphemous worship from everyone. (Revelation 13:14-15 and Matthew 24:15, 21, 29-31)

This is a literal temple is clear from the text, and has been understood as such by even the earliest Christians.

*Naos*, inner Holy of Holies." Not *hieron*, temple complex.

- The Man of Sin What does he do?
  - Showing himself that he is God:
    - The man of sin is truly an Anti-Christ. Satan has planned the career of the man of sin to mirror the ministry of Jesus.
      - Both Jesus and the man of sin
        - Have a COMING (2 Thessalonians 2:1 and 2:9).
        - Have a REVEALING (2 Thessalonians 1:7 and 2:3).
        - Have a GOSPEL (2 Thessalonians 2:10-11).
        - Say that they alone SHOULD BE WORSHIPPED (2 Thessalonians 2:4).
        - Have support their claims with MIRACULOUS WORKS (2 Thessalonians 2:9).
    - Clearly, the man of sin is Satan's parody of the true Messiah. Yet in the end, the man of sin can only show himself that he is God.
    - The coming of Jesus and the judgment of God will make it clear that the man of sin is not God at all.



- The Man of Sin Remember
  - WHEN I WAS STILL WITH YOU I TOLD YOU THESE THINGS:
    - Paul was only with the Thessalonians a few weeks (Acts 17:1-10).
    - But Paul thought it important to teach these brand new Christians about Biblical prophecy, and he taught them in some detail.





- The Mystery of Sin The Restrainer
  - AND NOW YOU KNOW WHAT IS RESTRAINING:
    - For now, Satan and the man of sin are being restrained.
      - The principle of their working is now present
  - THE MYSTERY OF LAWLESSNESS IS ALREADY AT WORK.
    - THE: definite article
      - Highlights the definite aim of the devil is to overthrow the law of God and establish his own rule
      - Not merely disorder and violation of the law in general.
    - MYSTERY: Now divinely revealed
      - Paul uses the term in connection with revelation

Romans 16:26; 1 Corinthians 2:6-12; Ephesians 1:9; 3:3-5; Colossians 1:25-27

- LAWLESSNESS: asserting the absence of moral absolutes;
   right and wrong. ...Sound familiar?
- But at the right time, the Holy Spirit who now restrains their full revelation will be taken out of the way.

- The Mystery of Sin The Restrainer
  - THE MYSTERY OF LAWLESSNESS IS ALREADY AT WORK.
    - WORK: The active operation of some supernatural power.
      - While the individual has not yet been revealed, the spirit that will dominate his career is already operative.
  - ONLY HE WHO NOW RESTRAINS WILL DO SO UNTIL HE ...
    - Until: There is a time limit on the present restraint
      - The Day of the Lord CANNOT HAPPEN while the church is still in the world.
    - HE: The One restraining.

## • The Mystery of Sin - The Restrainer

- Is Taken out of the way:
  - The Holy Spirit will not leave the earth during the Great Tribulation (Day of the Lord).
  - The Holy Spirit will be present on the earth during the Great Tribulation because many are saved, sealed, and serve God during this period (Revelation 7:3-14 and 14:1-5)
    - This can't happen without the ministry of the Holy Spirit.
  - The Holy Spirit is taken out of the way, not removed.

#### Where is the Holy Spirit now?

"The special presence of the Spirit as the indweller of saints will terminate abruptly at the *parousia* as it began abruptly at Pentecost. Once the body of Christ has been caught away to heaven, the Spirit's ministry will revert back to what he did for believers during the Old Testament period."



- The Mystery of Sin The Lawless One
  - AND THEN THE LAWLESS ONE WILL BE REVEALED:
    - Paul states TWO certain facts, in verse 8, about the man of sin, here called the lawless one.
      - FIRST, it is certain that the lawless one will be revealed when the Holy Spirit removes His restraint.
      - SECOND, it is certain that the lawless one will be destroyed by the mere brightness of Jesus at His coming. (Matthew 17)





- The Mystery of Sin Sequence of Events
  - AND THEN THE LAWLESS ONE WILL BE REVEALED:
    - AND THEN: Emphatically assets that the career of the lawless one will run its course FOLLOWING THE REMOVAL of the Restrainer. Yet, his final doom is also affirmed.

- The Mystery of Sin Coming According to Satan
  - THE COMING OF THE LAWLESS ONE IS ACCORDING TO THE WORKING OF SATAN:
    - The antichrist will come with POWER, with SIGNS and with LYING WONDERS. ... Comprehensive description of MIRACLES.
      - If someone has spiritual power, signs, or wonders, those are not enough to prove they are from God.
      - Just because its supernatural does not mean its God.
      - All of this is according to the working of Satan, as described in Revelation 13:13-17.

#### **COMPREHENSIVE DESCRIPTION OF MIRACLES**

**Power:** Denotes the cause of the miracle - the inherent power producing it.

**SIGNS:** Point to the significance lying behind the miracles.

**WONDERS**: Indicates the abnormal nature and astonishment they produce.



## The Mystery of Sin - Deception

- IN THEM THAT PERISH:
  - Their cause for perishing lies within themselves
  - Their rejection of God's provision ... John 3:19

19 And this is the condemnation, that the LIGHT has come into the world, and men loved DARKNESS rather than LIGHT, because their deeds were evil.

--- John 3:19 ... NKJV

## The Mystery of Sin - Strong Delusion

- GOD WILL SEND THEM STRONG DELUSION:
  - God uses their choice of evil as the very instrument to punish their sin.
  - They were first deluded, which was their sin; then God sends them STRONG DELUSION, which is their punishment.

    Proverbs 5:22

His own iniquities entrap the wicked *man*, And he is caught in the cords of his sin.

- --- Proverbs 5:22 ... NKJV
- In the end, the Antichrist is only God's messenger.

#### THAT THEY SHOULD BELIEVE THE LIE:

- Specifically, God sends them THE LIE.
- This isn't just any LIE, but the LIE, the LIE that has enthralled the human race since Adam.
- This is the LIE that God is not God and we can be gods.




## The Mystery of Sin - Condemned


