## First Year of Belshazzar king of Babylon

- Context
  - √ Nabonidus made Belshazzar co-regent in his 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - ✓ Daniel was ~67 years old
  - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar died 9 years earlier
  - ✓ Chapter 5 ended with the fall of Babylon ... Belshazzar's last year ... last day
  - √ Chapter 7 comes before chapter 5 chronologically



- Daniel had a dream and visions .. main facts
  - These visions will mirror
    - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar's dream of chapter 2
      - Multi-metal image
      - Representing 4 World Empires









<sup>2</sup> Daniel spoke, saying, "I saw in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven were stirring up the Great Sea. <sup>3</sup> And four great beasts came up from the sea, each different from the other.

- Daniel spoke, saying "I saw ..."
  - Notice the shift from 3<sup>rd</sup> person to 1<sup>st</sup> person singular
    - ✓ In the Historical section (chapters 1-6)... 3<sup>rd</sup> person, e.g., "Daniel..."
    - ✓ In the Visions section (chapters 7-12) .... 1st person, e.g., "I ..."

## Night Vision

- Daniel sees the vision at night
  - ✓ my vision ... no longer the dreams of Nebuchadnezzar his own dreams
- Four winds of heaven stirring up the Great Sea
  - ✓ Great Sea refers to the Mediterranean Sea
    - Numbers 34:6-7
    - Joshua 1:4; 9:1; 15:12, 47; 23:4
    - Ezekiel 47:10, 15, 20; 48:28
  - ✓ Idiomatically can refer to the "great sea" of humanity

**17** Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls came and talked with me, saying to me, "Come, I will show you the judgment of the great harlot who sits on many waters,



    - ✓ Different idioms
      - Chapter 2 ... Multi-Metal
        - » Gold .....Babylon
        - » Silver ..... Medo-Persia
        - » Brass ...... Greece
        - » Iron ..... Rome
      - Chapter 7 ... **Beasts** 
        - » Lion ..... Babylon
        - » Bear .....Medo-Persia
        - » Leopard .... Greece
        - » Fierce ...... Rome

- Four great beasts came up from the sea
  - Each beast is distinct .. Represents a different World Kingdom
    - ✓ Parallels the beast from the sea of John's vision in Revelation 13

"BELOVED" - JOHN:
- DANIEL:

10 Horned Beast -> Leopard -> Bear -> Lion Lion -> Bear -> Leopard -> 10 Horned Beast



- Notice that the beasts come up from the sea ... (interpretation 7:17 "earth")
  - ✓ The kingdom of God and the son of man come from the clouds of heaven

#### The first was like a lion

- Not a lion but "like" a lion with eagle's wings
- Lion => The kingdom of Babylon
  - √ The head of gold in Nebuchadnezzar's dream
  - ✓ Nebuchadnezzar referred to as a lion in Jeremiah 4:7



- ✓ Nebuchadnezzar's Zoanthropy Incident
- ✓ Temporary loss of kingdom and sanity
- Lifted up ...made to stand .. Heart given
  - ✓ Restoration of Nebuchadnezzar
  - ✓ Kingdom and sanity


- Second like a bear
  - Suddenly
    - ✓ Babylon fell in one night ... Chapter 5
  - Bear => The kingdom of Medo-Persia
    - ✓ Raised up on one side
      - Cyrus was part Mede and part Persian
        - » Mother- Mandane of Media
        - » Father- Cambyses I (King of Anshan or Persia)
      - Persian part of the Kingdom was dominant (by 550 BC only Persian)
    - ✓ Three ribs in its mouth between its teeth
      - Represent the three major Persian conquests
        - » Babylon
        - » Egypt
        - » Lydia







- Third like a leopard
  - Leopard => The kingdom of Greece
    - ✓ Leopard pounces on prey
      - Bear crushes
      - Lion devours
    - ✓ Four wings of a bird
      - Twice the number of wings as the lion
      - Speaks of speed Alexander the Great



- » In 11 years (after Marathon)
- » By age 29
- » Known for his battlefield strategies
- » Known for his ability to quickly react
- » Died at age 33
  - » June 323 BC

- Third like a leopard
  - Leopard => The kingdom of Greece
    - √ Four heads
      - Alexander dies Kingdom is divided
      - Four key generals fight for kingdom
        - » Killing both of Alexander's sons

General	Region
Cassander	Greece and Macedonia
Lysimachus	Asia Minor (Thrace and Bithynia)
Seleucus	Syria, Babylon (out to India)
Ptolemy	Egypt, Palestine, Arabia

All four heads (regions) slowly taken over by Rome ~281-30 BC

- Third like a leopard
  - Leopard => The kingdom of Greece
    - ✓ Dominion was given to it
      - Given by whom?

Alexander adored the high priest of Jerusalem, saying that he, at Dium in Macedonia, had seen a vision of God so habited, inviting him to go to Asia, and promising him success.

Josephus ('Antiquities,' xi. 6)

- The night vision continues ... Fourth Beast
  - Dreadful and Terrible, Exceedingly Strong
    - ✓ No animal or animal combination for comparison
  - Dreadful => The Roman Empire
    - ✓ Huge iron teeth
      - Iron legs of Nebuchadnezzar's dream
    - ✓ Devouring, breaking in pieces (teeth)
      - Testament to the fierceness of Rome
        - » Romans took pride in destruction
      - Daniel 2:40
      - Trampling the residue with its feet
        - » Feet and toes of iron & clay



<sup>40</sup> And the fourth kingdom shall be as strong as iron, inasmuch as iron breaks in pieces and shatters everything; and like iron that crushes, *that kingdom* will break in pieces and crush all the others.

- Daniel 2:40... NKJV

- The night vision continues ... Fourth Beast
  - Dreadful => The Roman Empire
    - ✓ Different from all the beasts before it
      - Different from all other kingdoms
      - More on this in the next lesson
        - » Interpretation of the vision

#### √ Ten horns

- Equivalent to the 10 toes
  - » Iron mixed with clay
  - » Daniel 2:41-42-
- Horns represent power
  - » Power of animal
  - » Idiomatic for Kings



41 Whereas you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron, the kingdom shall be divided; yet the strength of the iron shall be in it, just as you saw the iron mixed with ceramic clay. 42 And as the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of clay, so the kingdom shall be partly strong and partly fragile.

      - Identity ... antichrist
      - Daniel 7:11
      - Revelation 13:5-8
      - Daniel 7:19-26



    - ✓ Throne is a fiery flame ... judgment
      - Deuteronomy 4:24 ....... The Lord your God is a consuming fire, a jealous God
      - Hebrews 12:29 ...... For our God is a consuming fire.
      - 2 Thessalonians 1:8 ..... In a flaming fire taking vengeance ...
    - ✓ Its (throne) wheels a burning fire ...
      - Oriental thrones moved on wheels

#### The Great White Throne Judgment
